
























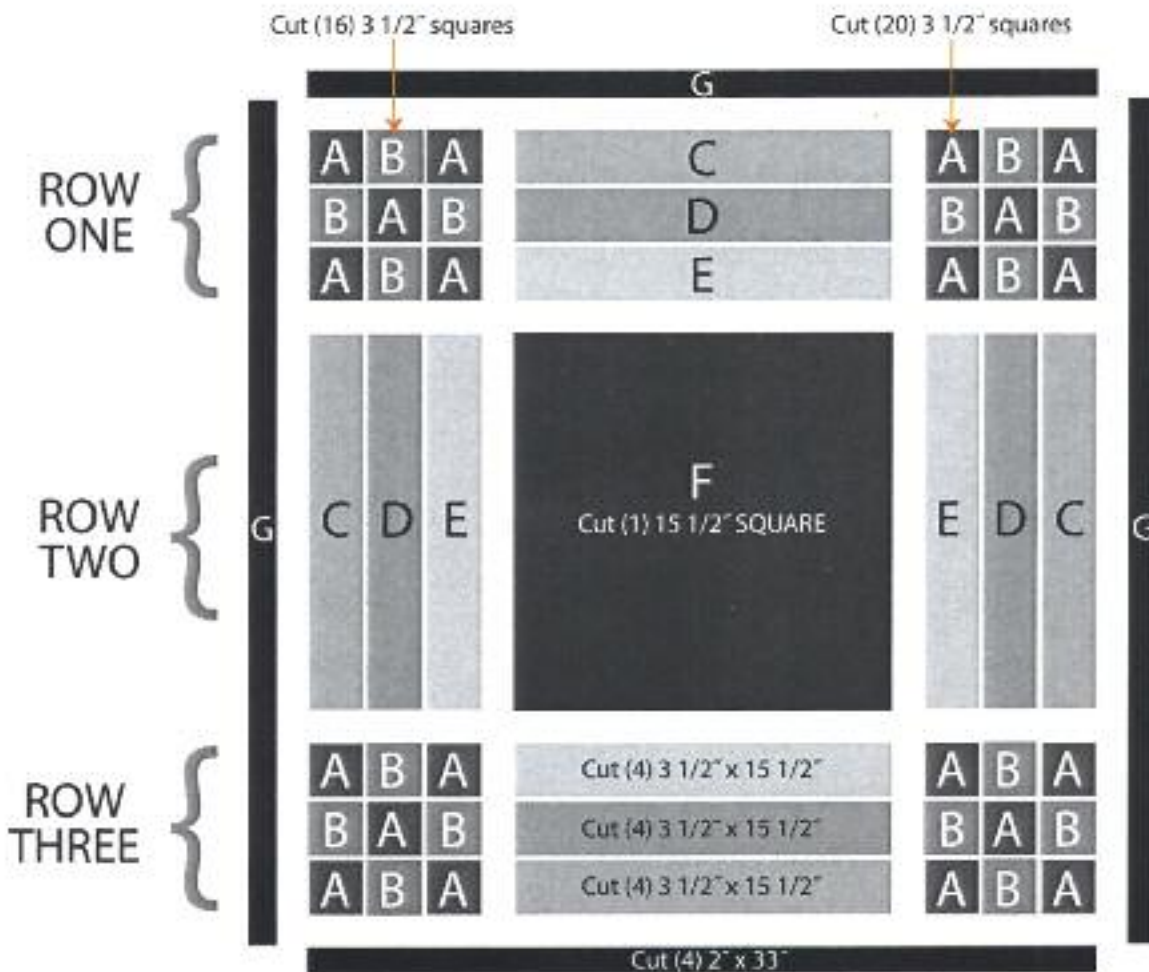


FIESTA QUILT

MAKE IN 3 DIFFERENT COLORWAYS: RED, BLUE, OR GREEN!
FABRIC REQUIREMENTS: 1 FAT QUARTER IN EACH COLOR.

D	 1084-23 Golden Peach	 1084-50 Aqua Blue	 1084-45 Moss Teal	
E	 1087-32 Marigold	 1087-54 Turquoise	 1088-45 Verde Blue	 (4) 3 1/2" x 15 1/2" strips

G	 1087-88 Red	 1087-54 Turquoise	 1088-45 Verde Blue	 (4) 2 1/2" x 33" strips NOTE: CUT FQ INTO (7) 2 1/2" X 18" STRIPS, JOIN TOGETHER, CUT (4) 33" STRIPS FOR BORDER.



ASSEMBLY & PIECING

- Using 3 1/2" squares of fabrics **A** and **B**, assemble (4) nine patch blocks alternating fabrics as shown in diagram.
- Sew together **CDE** strips (refer to diagram and photo) to create 4 strip units. Watch direction of the stripe.
- Sew strip set **CDE** to left side of 15 1/2" square **F**, sew another **EDC** to right side of center square **F**.
- Sew nine patch blocks to the left and right of remaining **CDE** units.
- Join Rows **One**, **Two**, and **Three**.
- Add border **G** to top and bottom, and remaining strips to sides.

Top is now complete. Cut batting and backing 2" larger than top on all sides. The backing will have to be pieced. Assemble the quilt "sandwich" by placing the backing, batting, and top together in layers and baste or pin with safety pins. Machine quilt as desired and in all seams. When machine quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind in the usual manner.
