	Noble Medallion 0352712B <i>Black Multi</i>	1/2 YD	(2) 6-1/4" x WOF strips. (14) Template 1.
	Gate Texture 0353146B <i>Olive</i>	1/4 YD	(3) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (12) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips and (12) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips.
	Gate Texture 0353158B <i>Indigo</i>	2 YDS	(14) Template I keeping straight sides on straight of grain, and adding 1/2" to each straight side. (2) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (12) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips and (12) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips. (2) 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips and (2) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips. (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

	Ombre Spray 0353026B <i>Rose</i>	1/8 YD	(2) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (12) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" strips. (12) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips.

Template Plastic: Trace Templates 1 and I and B onto template plastic and cut out. Add 1/2" to straight sides of Template I to allow trimming of sewn block.

Wheel Blocks: Sew a Template 1 of F to sides of Template 1 fabrics G, J and C, in that order. You now have a semi circle. Sew a Template B, using a curved seam, making the inner circle. Now sew a Template I to make the outer ring of the circle. Measuring from the center out, trim these blocks to 10-1/2" square. Make 14. Set aside.

Log Cabin Blocks: Sew (2) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" K strips to sides of 2-1/2" D squares. Sew 2 longer 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" K strips to the top and bottom of the block. Continuing in the same manner, sew the shorter 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" I strips to sides of block. Sew longer 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" I strips to the top and bottom. Repeat using short 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" F strips to sides and 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips to the top and bottom. Lastly, sew 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" H strips to the sides and 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" H strips to the top and bottom of block. Make 6.

Geisha Girl Blocks: Decide which fussy cut blocks will be top and bottom blocks in the center row. On the top block, sew a 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" I strip to the top left side of the 9-1/2" E square, as it sits on point. Sew a 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" I strip to the top right side of the block. On the bottom Geisha block, sew a 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" I strip to the bottom right side and a 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" I strip to the bottom left side. Set aside all Geisha blocks. (2 Geisha blocks will be untouched)

Quilt Top Assembly: Following the photo as a guide, lay out all blocks and side setting triangles on a design wall, and begin by sewing units together at the top left corner of the quilt into rows. Make sure all wheel blocks are rotated to match the photo as you go.

Row 1: Sew 2 side setting A triangles together on short sides.

Row 2: Side setting triangle, wheel block with center to right, wheel block with center down, side setting triangle.

Row 3: Side setting triangle, wheel block center to right, wheel block center pointing up, log cabin block, top Geisha block, side setting triangle.

Row 4: Side setting triangle, wheel block, center to right, wheel block with center down, log cabin block, large Geisha block, log cabin block, wheel block, center down, side setting triangle.

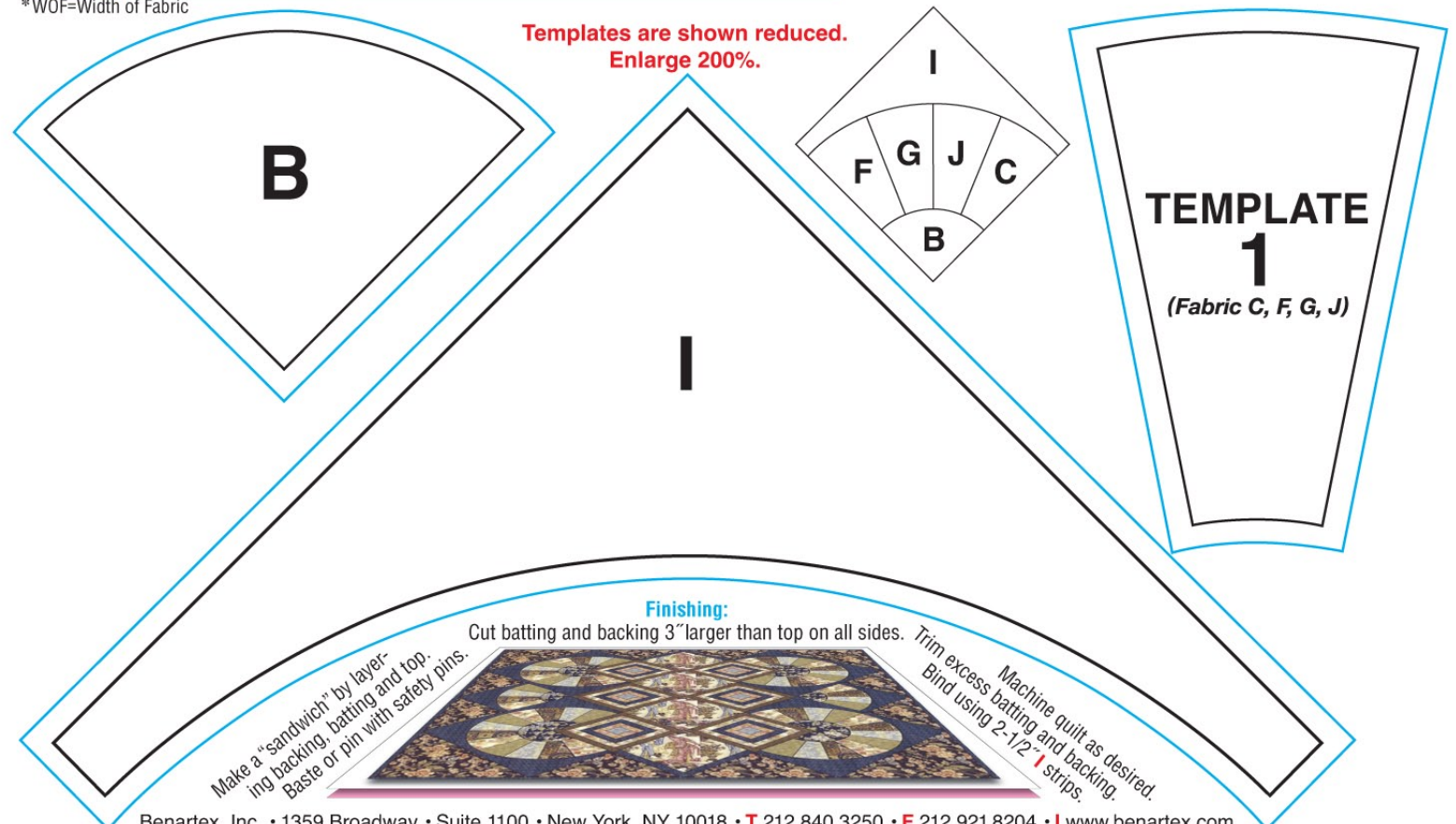
Row 5: Side setting triangle, wheel block, center up, log cabin block, large Geisha block, log cabin block, wheel block center up, wheel block center left, side setting triangle.

Row 6: Side setting triangle, bottom geisha block, log cabin block, wheel block center down, wheel block center left, side setting triangle.

Row 7: Side setting triangle, wheel block center up, wheel block center left, side setting triangle.

Row 8: Side setting triangle, to side setting triangle joined on short sides. After all rows are completed, sew the together in order until quilt top is complete.

Make a "sandwich" by layering backing, batting and top. Baste or pin with safety pins.

Finishing:
Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides.

Trim excess batting and backing.
Bind using 2-1/2" I strips.
Machine quilt as desired.
