WOF = Width offabric $\mid F Q=$ Fat Quarter $\mid$ *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated

1 yd (8) $1-1 / 2^{" x}$ WOF strips*, subcut; Inner Border
(2) $1-1 / 2$ " x $62-1 / 2$ " strips
(2) $1-1 / 2$ " x $80-1 / 2$ " strips
(8) $2-1 / 4$ " x WOF strips*; Binding

B INTO THE FOREST $8717-45$ Aqua/Lt Gray 1 yd $\quad$ (8) $3-1 / 2$ " x WOF strips*, subcut; Outer Border
(2) $3-1 / 2$ " x $68-1 / 2$ " strips
(2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $82-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips

## BLOCK 1 ASSEMBLY

1 Sew (1) G 3-1/2" square to each side of (1) O 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip. Make 24.
2 Sew (1) O 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to each side of (1)J 8-1/2" square. Make 12.
3 Sew units together in rows as shown to complete Block 1A. Square to 14-1/2". Make 2.


4 Sew the following blocks together using the remaining GOG units, as shown. Square to 14-1/2". Make 2 each .

## BLOCK 2 ASSEMBLY

5 Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) G 3-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) P 3-1/2" x 14-1/2" strip. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal G corner triangle. Repeat with another G 3-1/2" square on opposite corner of P strip to complete Block 2. Make 14.


SEW ON DRAWN LINE


TRIM 1/4" AWAY FROM SEWN LINE


OPEN AND PRESS


REPEAT STEPS ON EACH CORNER BLOCK 2
(MAKE 14)

## BLOCK 3 ASSEMBLY

6 Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) G 3-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) F 6-1/2" x 14-1/2" strip. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal G corner triangle. Repeat with another G 3-1/2" square on opposite corner of F rectangle, then (2) H 3-1/2" squares to complete Block 3A. Make 6.

## QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

7 Sew blocks in rows, as shown.
8 Sew rows together, as shown.

## BORDER ASSEMBLY

Measure width and length of the quilt top to ensure border sizes, below are our cutting sizes.

9 INNER BORDER: Sew (1) A 1-1/2" x (80-1/2) strip to each side of quilt center.

10 INNER BORDER: Sew (1) A 1-1/2" x ( $62-1 / 2$ ) strip to top and bottom of quilt center.

11 OUTER BORDER: Sew (1) B 3-1/2" x (82-1/2) strip to each side of quilt center.

12 OUTER BORDER: Sew (1) B 3-1/2" $x(68-1 / 2)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt center.

## FINISHING

Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
