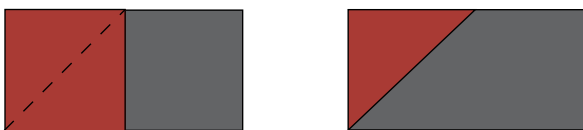
* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY
WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC

BLOCK ASSEMBLY *PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.*

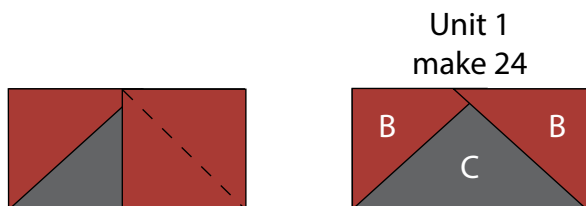
Note: The arrows in the diagrams represent the fabric direction.

UNIT 1

1. Place (1) **B** 4-1/2" square on the left side of (1) **C** 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

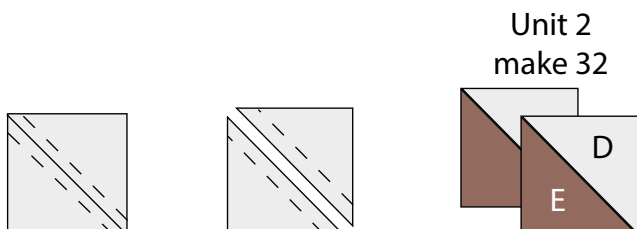


2. Place another **B** 4-1/2" square on the right side of the **C** 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) **Unit 1** strip. Repeat to make (24) **Unit 1** strips total.



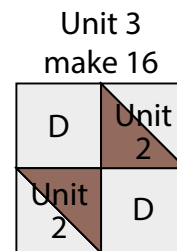
UNIT 2

3. Place (1) **D** 2-7/8" square on top of (1) **E** 2-7/8" square, right side together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line to make two half-square triangles. Trim blocks to measure 2-1/2" to make (2) **Unit 2** squares. Repeat to make (32) **Unit 2** squares total.



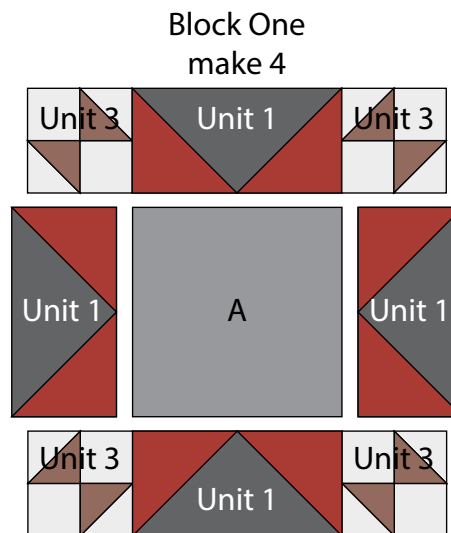
UNIT 3

4. Sew (1) **Unit 2** square to the left side of (1) **D** 2-1/2" square to make (1) **Bottom Unit Strip**. Pay attention to the unit orientation. Sew (1) **D** 2-1/2" square to the left side of (1) **Unit 2** square to make (1) **Top Unit Strip**. Pay attention to the unit orientation. Sew the **Top Unit Strip** to the top of the **Bottom Unit Strip** to make (1) **Unit 3** square. Repeat to make (16) **Unit 3** squares total.



BLOCK ONE

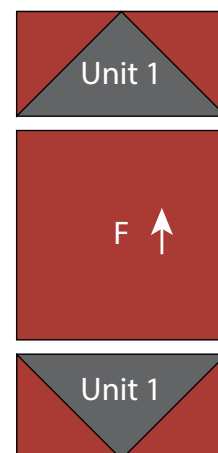
5. Sew (1) **Unit 1** strip to each side of (1) **A** 8-1/2" square. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Sew (1) **Unit 3** square to each side of (1) **Unit 1** strip to make (1) **Top Block Strip**. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Repeat to make (1) **Bottom Block Strip**. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Sew the **Top Block Strip** and the **Bottom Block Strip** to the **A** 8-1/2" square to make (1) **Block One** square. Pay attention to the strip orientations. Repeat to make (4) **Block One** squares total.



Block Two

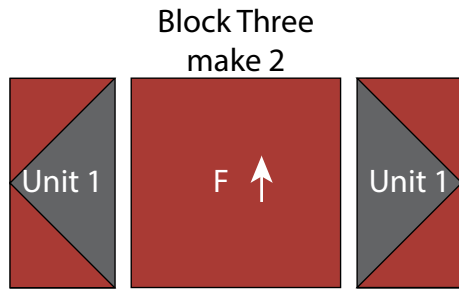
6. Sew (1) **Unit 1** strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) **F** 8-1/2" square to make (1) **Block Two** strip. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Repeat to make a second **Block Two** strip.

BLOCK THREE

7. Sew (1) **Unit 1** strip to each side of (1) **F** 8-1/2" square to make (1) **Block Three** strip. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Repeat to make a second **Block Three** strip.



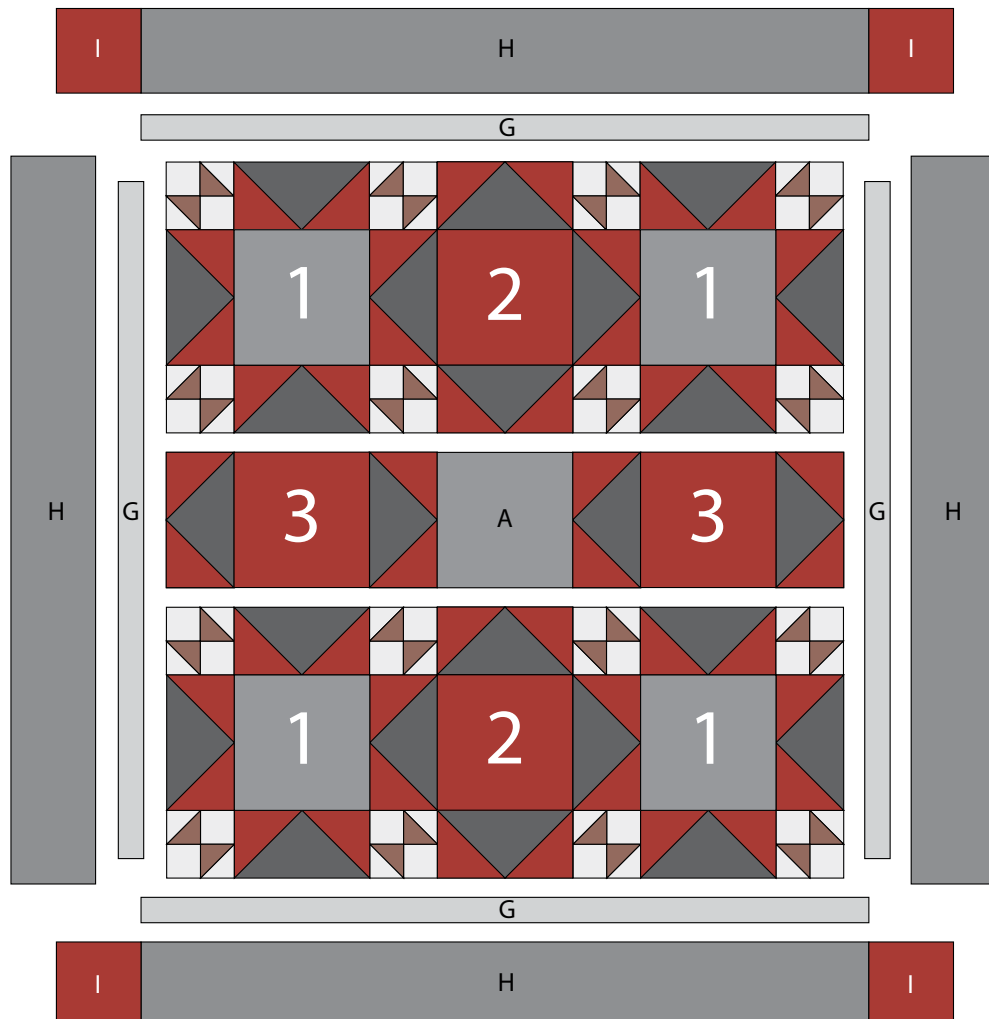
QUILT ASSEMBLY

8. Sew together (2) **Block One** squares and (1) **Block Two** strip, alternating them, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.

9. Sew together (2) **Block Three** strips and (1) **A** 8-1/2" square, alternating them, to make Row Two.

10. Sew the rows together, in numerical order, to make the Center Block.

QUILT DIAGRAM



BORDER ASSEMBLY *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE G AND H BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

11. Sew (1) **G** 2" x (40-1/2") strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) **G** 2" x (43-1/2") strips to the top and bottom of Center Block.

12. Sew (1) **H** 5-1/2" x (43-1/2") strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) **I** 5-1/2" square to each end of (1) **H** 5-1/2" x (43-1/2") to make (1) **Top Border** strip. Repeat to make (1) **Bottom Border** strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED SIZE: 53" x 53"
