D		Fern Field 3518-49 Deep Olive	3/8 YD	(2) 2-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips (pieced); (2) 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips for spacers.
E		Woodland Blooms 3517-68 Aubergine	1-2/3 YDS	(2) 4-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips lengthwise. (2) 4-1/2" x 58-1/2" strips lengthwise for border.

BLOCK CORNERS

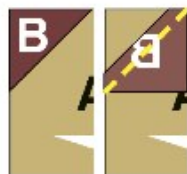
From 2 panels A, cut out 24 squares to 6-1/2". Make A-B units as shown at right.



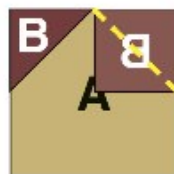
Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of B square.



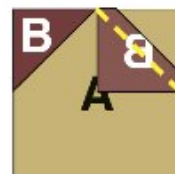
Place B square in upper left corner of A square, right sides together.



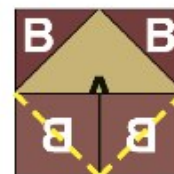
Sew on the line. Fold B back to corner. Open and trim under fabric 1/4" from sewn fold.



Repeating 1st step, place another B square in upper right corner, right sides together.



Sew on the line. Fold B back to corner. Open and trim under fabric 1/4" from sewn fold.



Using same techniques, add two B squares to bottom left and right corners of A square.



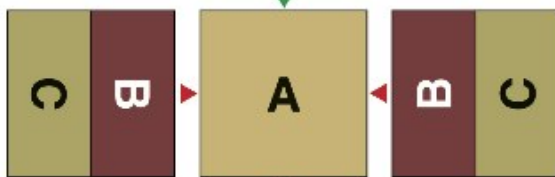
Make 24 A-B units.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

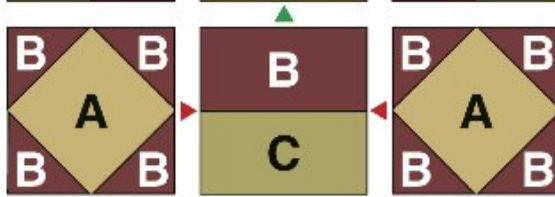
Make (4) B-C units. Note each unit's orientation when assembling block.



Assemble each of the three rows first.



Then sew the three rows together.



Make six of these block units. Then sew together.

IMPORTANT:

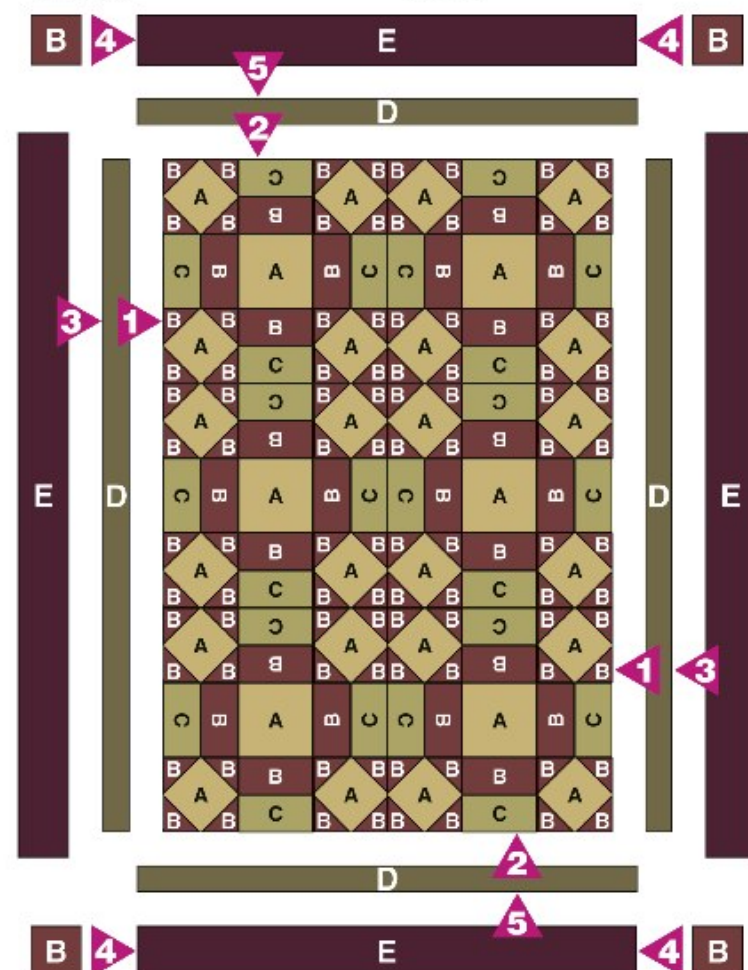
Watch direction of floral prints—refer to quilt photo.

SPACERS, BORDERS AND CORNERSTONES

- Sew pieced D strips to each side of quilt top.
- Sew 40-1/2" D strips to top and bottom of quilt top.

- Sew 4-1/2" x 58-1/2" E strips to each side of quilt top.

- Sew 4-1/2" B cornerstones to each side of the remaining two E strips.
- Sew these units to top and bottom of the quilt.



FINISHING

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than quilt top on all sides. Make a quilt sandwich by layering backing, batting and quilt top as illustrated. Baste or pin with safety pins. Machine quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing. Bind in usual manner.
