




FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

Note: If this Benartex pattern is included in a kit, any questions about the kit should be addressed to the vendor from whom you bought it.

Finished Quilt Size: 47" W x 72"L

### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY:**

**1. BLOCK 1:** Using the **F** and **G** 13 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles, create **BLOCKS 1** and **2** by applying A and B fabric applique hearts to the tops of rectangles.

# **APPLIQUÉ INSTRUCTIONS:**

Trace template onto fusible web paper. Peel paper backing off untraced side and press to the back of designated fabric. Position traced fabric on blocks using the diagrams as guides. Press to fuse following manufacturer's directions.

## **QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY:**

2. Using **BLOCKS 1** and **2** along with **E** and **D** 10 ½" x 2 ½" sashing strips, create 2 units shown below.



### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

3. Assemble quilt in 6 rows as shown in Quilt Diagram using the FGF and GFG Units.

#### **BORDER ASSEMBLY**

MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.

**4. BORDER STRIPS:** Sew (1) **D**  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $43\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the top and (1) to the bottom of (1) **C**  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $43\frac{1}{2}$ " strip. *Make 2*.



**5.** Sew **BORDER STRIPS** to the top and bottom of Quilt Center. Then sew (1) **D** 72 ½" x 2 ½" Border strip to each side of Quilt Center.
