BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.
8. Sew (1) G 3-1/2" $X\left(54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side then sew (1) G 3-1/2" $X\left(51-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom.

FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3"
larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. Quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

## UNIT ASSEMBLY: Refer to UNIT DIAGRAM

1. UNIT 1: Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of (1) G 10" square and place right sides together with (1) A $10^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on both sides of drawn line, then cut on drawn line. Press HST units open with seam allowance towards A fabric. Square to 9-1/2", make (8) UNIT 1.
2. UNIT 2: Repeat step 1 using (1) G 10" square and (1) B $10^{\prime \prime}$ square, make (4) UNIT 2 3. UNIT 3: Repeat step 1 using (1) G 10" square and (1) E 10" square, make (4) UNIT 3.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS and blocks outlined in RED on QUILT DIAGRAM for proper fabric placement.
4. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side all 5 " squares. Place squares on corners of units and squares as shown in chart, sew on diagonal lines and press. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Make (4) of each block.

5. BLOCKS 7, 8, and 9: Draw diagonal lines on wrong sides of all 5" squares. Place squares on top and bottom of $5^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles as shown in chart, sew on lines and press. Trim excess fabric on back to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, then sew left and right units together.
