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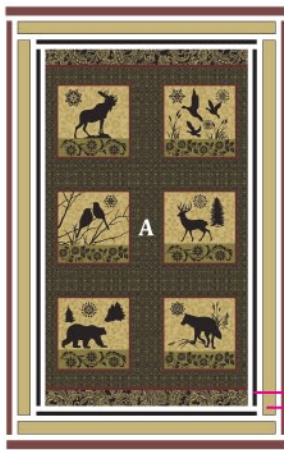

	<b>C</b> Mini Geo 4465-11 Black/Red	1/2YD	(2) 1-1/2" x 45-1/2" strips. (2) 2" x 30-1/2" strips. (2) 1-1/2" x 64-1/2" strips. (2) 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" strips.
	<b>D</b> Edelweiss 4462-99 Black	1/2YD	(12) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles. (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips.
	<b>E</b> Edelweiss 4462-44 Green	2/3YD	(26) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.
	<b>F</b> Snowflakes 4463-99 Black	1YD	(14) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles. (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.
	<b>G</b> Holly 4466-33 Gold	1/4YD	(2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips.
	<b>H</b> Mini Geo 4465-44 Black/Olive	1/4YD	(2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips.
	<b>I</b> Edelweiss 4462-33 Gold	1/4YD	(2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips.
	<b>J</b> Paisley 4461-99 Black	2YDs	(2) 4-1/2" x 66-1/2" strips (LOF). (2) 4-1/2" x 52-1/2" strips (LOF).
	<b>K</b> Linen 988-99 Licorice	1/4YD	(2) 1" x 40-1/2" strips. (2) 1" x 24-1/2" strips.

### PANEL ASSEMBLY

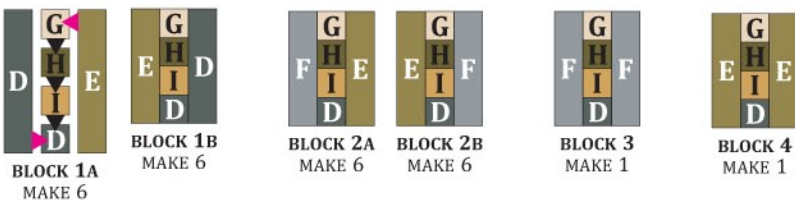
Trim panel **A** so that it measures 23-1/2" x 40-1/2".

1. Add **K** strips to sides of **A** panel, then to top and bottom.
2. Add **B** strips to sides of **AK** panel unit, then to top and bottom.
3. Add **C** 1-1/2" x 45-1/2" (may have to be pieced) strips to sides of **ABK** panel unit, then add **C** 2" x 30-1/2" strips to top and bottom. See diagram on left for reference.

**BLOCK ASSEMBLY:** Block finished size 6" x 8".

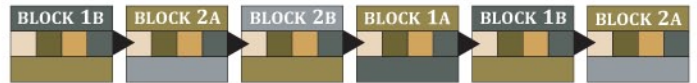
**4. RECTANGLE BLOCKS:** To make 6" x 8" rectangles use **D, E, F, G, H** and **I** fabrics to piece strips and squares. Follow instructions and diagrams below to make **RECTANGLE BLOCKS** or use your own style. Make 26.

Begin by sewing **G-H-I-D** squares together. Make 26. Then add **D, E** or **F** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips to sides of **GHID** unit, follow diagrams below.

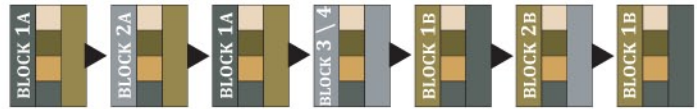


**Note:** For following steps refer to quilt photo for proper positioning of **RECTANGLE BLOCKS**.

**5.** Sew (6) **RECTANGLE BLOCKS** together as shown below. Make 2 units. Then sew units to each side of panel center.



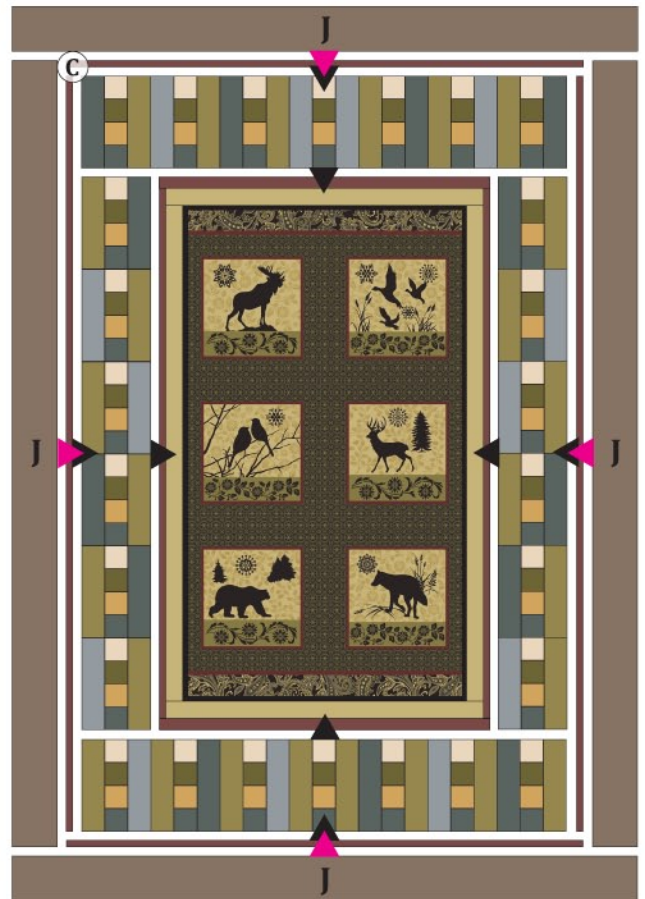
**6.** Sew (7) **RECTANGLE BLOCKS** together as shown in example below. Make 2 units. Then sew units to top and bottom of panel center. **Note:** **BLOCK 3** is for top and **BLOCK 4** for bottom.



### BORDER ASSEMBLY

**7. INNER BORDER:** Add 1-1/2" **C** strips to sides of quilt center. (strips will have to be pieced). Then add **C** strips to top and bottom of quilt center (strips may have to be pieced).

**8. OUTER BORDER:** Add **J** strips to sides of quilt center, then top and bottom. See quilt diagram below.



FINISHED SIZE: 52" x 75"

### FINISHING

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Assemble the quilt sandwich by placing the backing, batting and top together in layers and baste or pin with safety pins. Machine quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind in the usual manner.
