

FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. Quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS for proper fabric placement and rotation.

BLOCK 1: Square to 12-1/2", make (5)

1. Sew (1) C1 strip to right side of B1, sewing from top to bottom, stopping 2 " from end of $\mathbf{B 1}$ (this partial seam will be closed later. Sew (1) C1 to top, then sew (1) C1 to left side. Sew (1) C1 to bottom, then finish the partial seam on right side.

BLOCK 2: Square to 12-1/2", make (4)
2. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of a (1) D1 square. Place $\mathbf{D} 1$ square in upper left corner of (1) F1 square and sew on diagonal line. Press d open towards $\mathbf{f}$ corner. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat using D1 square on remaining corners.


## SASHING ASSEMBLY:

5. Sew (3) G1 strips and (4) A1 squares together as shown in QUILT DIAGRAM, make (4).

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper block placement and rotation.
6. Sew following together into horizontal rows, then sew rows and sashing rows together as show in quilt diagram.

R0WS 1 \&3: G1 - BLOCK 1 - G1 - BLOCK 2 - G1 - BLOCK 1- G1
ROW 2: G1 - BLOCK 2 - G1 - BLOCK 1 - G1 - BLOCK 2- G1
BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.
7. Sew (1) E 2-1/2" X (44-1/2") strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) E 2-1/2" X (48 $\left.-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.
8. Sew (1) A 4-1/2" $\mathrm{X}\left(48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) A 4-1/2" X (56 $\left.-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.
