Choo! Choo! You can almost hear the whistle as these cool little trains run along their colorful tracks. A great new modern colorstory makes this wallhanging look fresh and new.

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

QUILT DIAGRAM



BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY


1. Sew (1) 3-1/2" x WOF I strip to each side of (1) 3-1/2" x WOF G strip to make (1) IGI strip set. Repeat to make six IGI strip sets total.

2. Cut the **IGI** strip sets into (31) 6-1/2" x 9-1/2" **IGI** strips.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

3. Sew (3) **IGI** strips, (2) 9-1/2" **A** square, (1) 9-1/2" **B** square and (1) 9-1/2" **C** square together

to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Nine.



- **4.** Sew (4) **IGI** strips, (2) 6-1/2" **E** squares and (1) 6-1/2" **F** square together to make **Row Two**. Repeat to make **Row Six**.
- **5.** Sew (3) **IGI** strips, (2) 9-1/2" **D** square, (1) 9-1/2" **C** square and (1) 9-1/2" **B** square together to make **Row Three**. Repeat to make **Row Seven**.
- **6.** Sew (4) **IGI** strips, (2) 6-1/2" **F** squares and (1) 6-1/2" **E** square together to make **Row Four**. Repeat to make **Row Eight**.
- **7.** Sew (3) **IGI** strips, (2) 9-1/2" **D** square and (2) 9-1/2" **A** squares together to make **Row Five**.
- **8.** Sew the (9) rows together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.

BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE I BORDER SIZE, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.

9. Sew (1) I 3" x (69-1/2") strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) I 3" x (59-1/2") strips to the top and bottom of quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED SIZE: 59" X 74"
