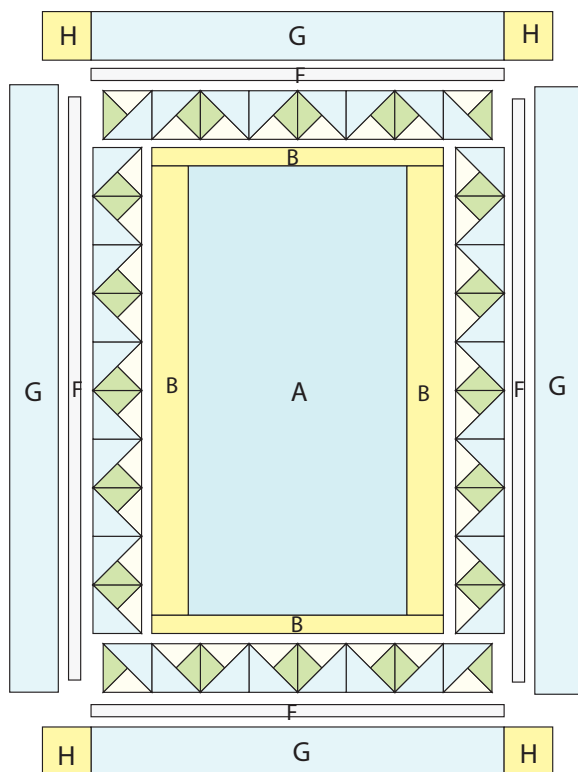

	<b>A</b> Breezy Baby Panel 8206-03 <i>Sunshine</i>	1 panel	(1) 18-1/2" x 37-1/2" strip, FUSSY CUT	
	<b>B</b> Lullaby Dot 8210-04 <i>Citron</i>	1/2 yd	(2) 4" x 37-1/2" WOF (2) 2-1/2" x 25-1/2" WOF	
	<b>C</b> Chirp Chirp 8207-05 <i>Aqua</i>	1/2 yd	(3) 4-7/8" x WOF, sub-cut (18) 4-7/8" x 4-7/8". Cut the squares across one diagonal to make (36) triangles.	
	<b>D</b> Dreamy Swirl 8211-04 <i>Jade</i>	1/3 yd	(2) 5-1/4" x WOF, sub-cut (9) 5-1/4" x 5-1/4". Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (36) triangles.	
	<b>E</b> Lullaby Plaid 8212-11 <i>Silver Gray</i>	1/3 yd	(2) 5-1/4" x WOF, sub-cut (9) 5-1/4" x 5-1/4". Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (36) triangles.	
	<b>F</b> Dreamy Swirl 8211-11 <i>Gray</i>	1/3 yd	(5) 1-1/2" x WOF*	
	<b>G</b> Baby Bear 8208-04 <i>Green</i>	1-1/2 yds	(2) 4-1/2" x 50-1/2" LOF (2) 4-1/2" x 34-1/2" WOF, piece as needed	
	<b>H</b> Up Up & Away 8209-03 <i>Yellow</i>	1/4 yd	(1) 4-1/2" x WOF, sub-cut (4) 4-1/2" x 4-1/2"	
	<b>I</b> Lullaby Dot 8210-05 <i>Aqua/Turquoise</i>	1/2 yd	(6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, BINDING	

\*SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY  
WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC

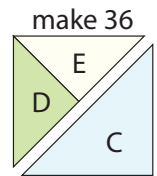
#### QUILT DIAGRAM



BLOCK ASSEMBLY *PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.*

#### BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) **D** triangle, (1) **E** triangle and (1) **C** triangle together to make (1) **DEC** block (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (36) **DEC** blocks total.



2. Sew (1) 4" x 37-1/2" **B** strip to each side of the 18-1/2" x 37-1/2" **A** strip. Sew (1) 2-1/2" x 25-1/2" **B** strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A** strip. Trim the block to measure 24-1/2" x 40-1/2" to make the **Center Block**.

#### QUILT ASSEMBLY

3. Sew (10) **DEC** blocks together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the **Center Block**. *Note: Pay attention to the orientation of the DEC blocks.*

4. Sew (8) **DEC** blocks together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**. *Note: Pay attention to the orientation of the DEC blocks to make the quilt top.*

BORDER ASSEMBLY *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE F AND G BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

5. Sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" x (48-1/2") strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" x (34-1/2") strips to the top and bottom of quilt top.

6. Sew (1) **G** 4-1/2" x (50-1/2") strip to each sides of the quilt top. Sew (1) 4-1/2" **H** square to each end of (1) 4-1/2" (34-1/2") **G** strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

**FINISHING** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

**FINISHED SIZE: 42" X 58"**
