




For following steps watch direction of **FLYING GEESE UNITS**.

	A Daisy Diva 2590-34 Gold/Turquoise 2590-52 Blue/Pink 2590-72 Khaki/Pink	1 YD	(4) 6-1/2" squares. *(7) 3-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut into (2) 3-1/2" x 62-1/2" strips. (2) 3-1/2" x 68-1/2" strips.
	B Sponge 2595-84 Turquoise 2595-07 Cream 2595-26 Rose Petal	1-3/8 YD	(10) 5-1/2" squares, cut once diagonally to yield (20) HST. (32) 4-3/4" squares. (7) 2-1/2" x WOF for binding.
	C Sunburst 2593-33 Gold 2593-24 Fuchsia 2593-10 Berry	3/4 YD	(20) 4-3/4" x 9" rectangles.
	D Damask Trellis 2591-34 Gold/Turquoise 2591-52 Blue/Pink 2591-72 Khaki/Pink	1-1/8 YD	(8) 5-1/2" squares, cut in half diagonally once to yield (16) HST. *(11) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut into (6) 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" strips. (4) 2-1/2" x 58-1/2" strips. (2) 2-1/2" x 62-1/2" strips.
	E Bubbles 2594-84 Turquoise 2594-50 Blue 2594-72 Khaki Rose	1-1/4 YD	(16) 4-3/4" x 9" rectangles. (5) 7-1/4" squares, cut twice diagonally to yield (20) QST. (10) 7" squares, cut once diagonally to yield (20) HST.
	F Posey Vine 2592-47 Olive 2592-52 Blue/Pink 2592-78 Brown	1 YD	(5) 6-1/2" squares. (40) 4-3/4" squares.
	G Sunburst 2593-43 Olive Gold 2593-20 Pink 2593-10 Berry	2/3 YD	(4) 7-1/4" squares, cut twice diagonally to yield (16) QST. (8) 7" squares, cut once diagonally to yield (16) HST.




Block Assembly Quilt consists of two main blocks, squared at 18".

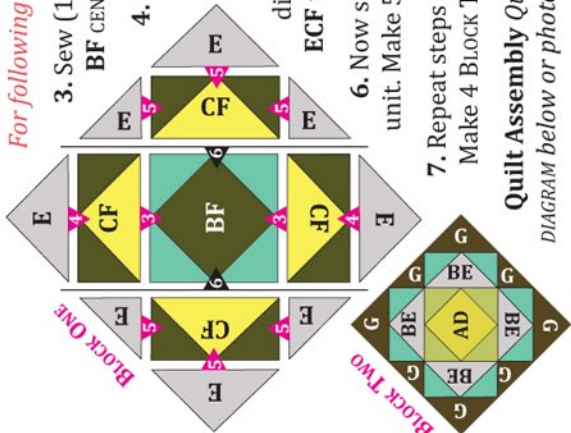

1. FLYING GEESE UNITS:
1d. MAKE 20 **1e. MAKE 16**
 Take a **F** 4-3/4" square and fold diagonally and press with iron or draw diagonal line on the wrong side (1a.). Next place **F** square on left hand side of (1) **C** 4-3/4" x 9" rectangle, right sides together and sew on diagonal line (1b.). Press open towards top left corner. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4" (1c.). Repeat for right hand corner (1d.). Repeat steps to make **BE** FLYING GEESE UNITS (1e.)

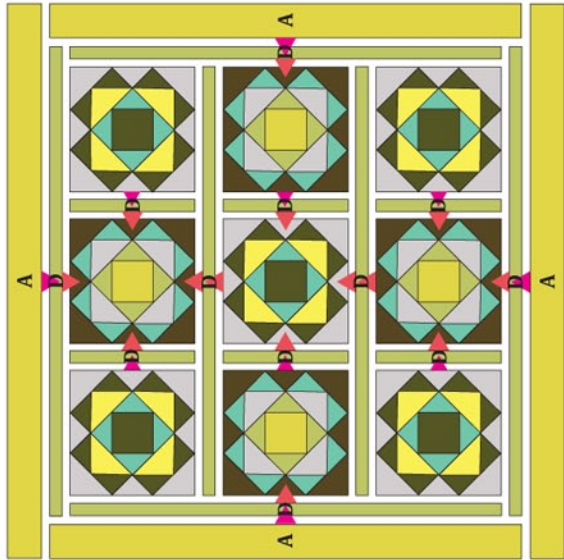
2. CENTER UNIT: Sew (1) **B** half-square triangle to each side of (1) **F** 6-1/2" square, see diagram (2a.). Repeat step using **D** and **A** fabrics (2b.)

Row 1 & 3: Sew together **Block One - D - Block Two - D - Block One**
Row 2: Sew together **Block Two - D - Block One - D - Block Two**
9. Next add (1) **D** 2-1/2" x 58-1/2" sashing strip to bottom of Rows 1 & 2. Trim to fit. Then sew Row 1 to Row 2 and so forth.

Sashing and Border
10. SASHING: Add (1) **D** 2-1/2" x 58-1/2" strip to sides of quilt top. Then add (1) **D** 2-1/2" x 62-1/2" strip to top and bottom of quilt top



FINISHED SIZE: 68" SQUARE

- Sew (1) **CF** FLYING GEESE unit to top and bottom of (1) **BF** CENTER UNIT.
- Next add (1) **E** 7" HST to top and bottom of **CF-BF** unit. Set aside.
- Take (2) **E** QST and sew to sides of (1) **CF** FLYING GEESE unit, see diagram on left for proper direction of **CF** units. Next add (1) **E** HST to top of **ECF** unit. Make 10 **E-CEF** units.
- Now sew (1) **E-CEF** unit to sides of (1) **CF-BF** center unit. Make 5 **Block OneS**.
- Repeat steps to make **Block Two**, as shown on diagram. Make 4 **Block Twos**.

Quilt Assembly Quilt consists of three horizontal rows. Follow **QUILT DIAGRAM** below or photo, for proper placement of blocks and **D** strips.

- Row 1 & 3: Sew together **Block One - D - Block Two - D - Block One**
- Row 2: Sew together **Block Two - D - Block One - D - Block Two**
- Next add (1) **D** 2-1/2" x 58-1/2" sashing strip to bottom of Rows 1 & 2. Trim to fit. Then sew Row 1 to Row 2 and so forth.
- Sashing and Border**
- SASHING:** Add (1) **D** 2-1/2" x 58-1/2" strip to sides of quilt top. Then add (1) **D** 2-1/2" x 62-1/2" strip to top and bottom of quilt top

- BORDER:** Sew (1) **A** 3-1/2" x 62-1/2" strip to sides of quilt top. Then sew (1) **A** 3-1/2" x 68-1/2" strip to top and bottom of quilt top.

Finishing Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Assemble the quilt sandwich by placing the backing, batting and top together in layers and baste or pin with safety pins. Machine quilt as desired. When quilting is done, trim excess batting and backing. Bind in the usual manner.
