(7) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips, BINDING.

* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC
BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4"SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2"X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.


## Blocks

1. Sew (1) B $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of (1) A $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew (1) B 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the $\mathbf{A}$ square to make (1) $\mathbf{A}$ Block.
2. Center (1) C $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14$ " strip on one side of (1) A block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4$ " from the top edge of the A Block and stop a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
3. Repeat Step 2 to sew (1) C $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the $\mathbf{A}$ Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the A Block on a diagonal, wrong sides together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides.
4. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in the figure), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make (1) AC

## Block.



## 5. Repeat Steps 1-4 to make (12) AC Blocks total.

6. Sew (1) E 1-1/2" $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of (1) D $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Sew (1) E 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the $\mathbf{D}$ strip to make (1)
D Block. Repeat to make (3) D Blocks total.
7. Repeat Step 6 using (3) F 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles, (3) G 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles, (3) H 6-1/2" $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, (3) I 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles, (2) J 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles and (28) E 1-1/2" x 10-1/2 strips and (28) E 1-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to make (14) assorted blocks.

## Quilt Assembly

8. Refer to the Quilt Diagram to sew the blocks together to make the quilt top.
BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE K BORDER SIZE, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.
9. Sew (1) K 3-1/2" x (72-1/2") strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) K 2-1/2" x (58-1/2") strips to the top and bottom of quilt top.
FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
