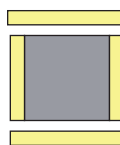
	<b>A</b> Flower Box 4809-44 Green	1 panel	(12) 6-1/2" squares (Fussy Cut).
	<b>B</b> Petal Pushers 8230-33 Yellow	2/3 yd	(1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (24) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips. (1) 8-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (24) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips.
	<b>C</b> Wall Flowers 8227-12 Black	1-2/3 yds	(4) 14" x LOF strips, sub-cut (48) 2-1/2" x 14" strips, each centered on the flower stripe (Fussy Cut).
	<b>D</b> Tulips 8226-33 Yellow/Pink	1/4 yd	(1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
	<b>E</b> Daisy Dreams 8231-09 White	1 yd	(9) 1-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (34) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips. (9) 1-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (34) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips.
	<b>F</b> Tulips 8226-66 Purple/Fuchsia	1/4 yd	(1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
	<b>G</b> Pansy Persuasion 8229-12 Black	1/4 yd	(1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
	<b>H</b> Iris 8225-66 Purple/Fuchsia	1/3 yd	(1) 10-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (1) 6-1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles. Cut (2) 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" WOF rectangles from the remaining fabric.
	<b>I</b> Daisy Dreams 8231-12 Black	1/4 yd	(1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
	<b>J</b> Tulips 8226-10 Red/Pink	1/4 yd	(1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
	<b>K</b> Fleurish 5619-40 Lime	1-1/4 yds	(2) 8-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (6) 8-1/2" squares. (4) 3-1/2" x WOF strips.* (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips.*
	<b>L</b> Fleurish 5619-66 Violet	2/3 yd	(7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, BINDING.

\* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY  
WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC

BLOCK ASSEMBLY *PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" x 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.*

**BLOCKS**

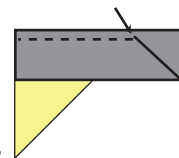
1. Sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **A** 6-1/2" square. Sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A** square to make (1) **A Block**.



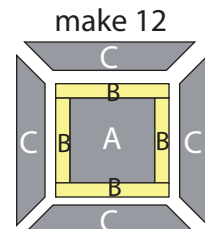
2. Center (1) **C** 2-1/2" x 14" strip on one side of (1) **A** block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the **A Block** and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

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3. Repeat Step 2 to sew (1) **C** 2-1/2" x 14" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A Block**, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the **A Block** on a diagonal, wrong sides together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides.



4. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in the figure), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make (1) **AC Block**.



5. Repeat Steps 1-4 to make (12) **AC Blocks** total.

6. Sew (1) **E** 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **D** 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip. Sew (1) **E** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **D** strip to make (1) **D Block**. Repeat to make (3) **D Blocks** total.

7. Repeat Step 6 using (3) **F** 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles, (3) **G** 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles, (3) **H** 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles, (3) **I** 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles, (2) **J** 6-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles and (28) **E** 1-1/2" x 10-1/2 strips and (28) **E** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips to make (14) assorted blocks.

**QUILT ASSEMBLY**

8. Refer to the Quilt Diagram to sew the blocks together to make the quilt top.

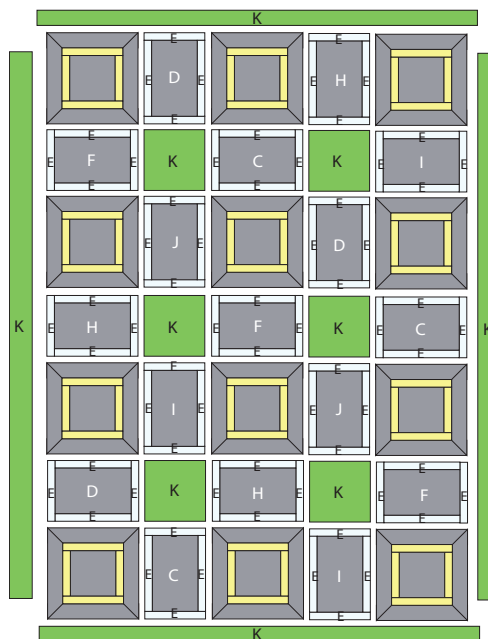
BORDER ASSEMBLY *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE K BORDER SIZE, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

9. Sew (1) **K** 3-1/2" x (72-1/2") strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) **K** 2-1/2" x (58-1/2") strips to the top and bottom of quilt top.

**FINISHING** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
