

QUILT DIAGRAM




FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 41" W X 59" L

BLOCK ASSEMBLY Refer to quilt photo for block piecing.

Note: **A** Panel squares with orange border use \mathbf{F} and \mathbf{C} border strips. A Panel squares with blue border use G and E border strips.

- **1. BLOCK ONE:** Sew (1) **F** 2" x 6-1/2" strip to each side of (1) A square (orange border). Repeat for top and bottom using **F** 2" x 9-1/2" strips. Next add (1) **C** 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip to each side of **AF** block. Repeat for top and bottom using C 1-1/2" x 11-1/2" strips. Square block to 11-1/2" (1.).
- 2. Repeat step 1to make (5) A PANEL (orange border) BLOCK ONES. Set aside.
- 3. BLOCK Two: Repeat step 1 using A PANEL (blue border) squares and G strips for inner border and E strips for outer border, make 4. (3.). Set aside.






(1.) MAKE 5 BLOCK ONES

- 4. Sew (1) C 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **B** 3-1/2" x 11-1/2" rectangle. Next sew (1) **B** 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle to ends of BC unit, see below.
- **5.** Add (1) **D** 1-1/2" x 33-1/2" strip to top and bottom of BC unit. Note pattern direction of B strips.

6. Take (2) D 1-1/2" x 33-1/2" strips and (2) B 3-1/2" x 33-1/2" strips. Add (1) D strip to top of (1) B strip and (1) D strip to bottom of remaining B strip. Make (1) of each BD Row. Note pattern direction of B strips.



- 7. QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM to make quilt top. Quilt consists of (3) BLOCK Rows, (2) BCD Rows and (2) BD ROWS.
- 8. BORDER ASSEMBLY: Sew (1) D 1-1/2" x 33-1/2" strip to top and bottom of quilt top. Next sew (3) D 1-1/2 x WOF strips together via short ends to make one long strip. Subcut (2) strips at 53-1/2" and sew one to each side of quilt top.
- **9.** Sew (3) **G** 2" x WOF strips together via short ends. Subcut long strip to (2) 53-1/2" strips and sew to each side of quilt top. Next add (1) G 2" x 38-1/2" strip to top and bottom of quilt top.
- 10. Sew (5) H 2" x WOF strips together via short ends. Subcut long strip to (2) 56-1/2" strips and sew one to each side of quilt top. From remaining strip cut (2) 41-1/2" strips and sew one to top and bottom of quilt top.

Finishing: Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. Machine quilt as desired. When quilting is done, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
