C	Midnight Garden Wisteria 1993-49 <i>Dark Multi</i>	1 YD	(5) 6-1/4" squares. (5) 4-1/2" x WOF strips; BORDER 2. <i>sew strips via short ends, see BORDER ASSEMBLY steps.</i>
D	Naturescapes Reflections 4716-99 <i>Suns and Shadows</i>	1/8 YD	(16) 2-1/2" squares.
E	Naturescapes Geology 4718-33 <i>Gold</i>	2/3 YD	(5) 1-1/2" x WOF strips; BORDER 1. <i>sew strips via short ends, see BORDER ASSEMBLY steps.</i> FOR SASHING STRIPS REFER TO STEP 3. (8) 1-1/2" x WOF strips; SASHING.
F	Naturescapes Geology 4718-50 <i>Steel</i>	1/3 YD	(16) 2-1/2" squares. (16) 2-7/8" squares, cut once diagonally to make (32) HST.
G	Naturescapes Geology 4718-55 <i>Night Clouds</i>	7/8 YD	(20) 2-1/2" squares. (16) 2-7/8" squares, cut once diagonally to make (32) HST. (4) 4-1/2" squares. (6) 2-1/4" x WOF strips; BINDING.
H	Naturescapes Geology 4718-70 <i>Oasis</i>	1/2 YD	(2) 15-1/2" squares, cut twice diagonally to make (8) QSTs. (2) 8" squares, cut once diagonally to make (4) HST.
I	Naturescapes Geology 4718-77 <i>Dune</i>	1/4 YD	(20) 2-7/8" squares, cut once diagonally to make (40) HST.

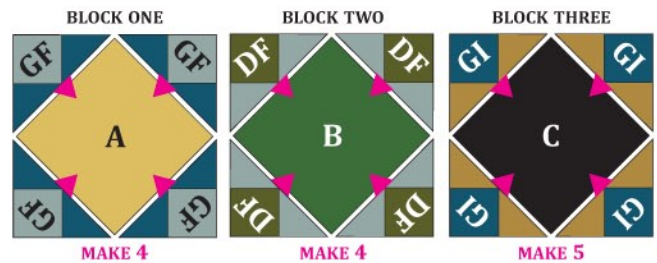
HST/QST=HALF/QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLE | WOF=WIDTH OF FABRIC

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. TRIANGLE UNITS: Sew (2) **G** 2-7/8" HST to sides of (1) **F** 2-1/2" square. Make 16 **FG**, 16 **DF** and 20 **GI** TRIANGLE UNITS. Refer to diagrams below.



2. BLOCKS 1-3: Sew (4) **FG** TRIANGLE UNITS to sides of (1) **A** 6-1/4" square. Square block to 8-1/2". Make 4 BLOCK ONES. Repeat step 2. to make 4 BLOCK TWOS and 5 BLOCK THREES. Refer to diagrams below.



3. SASHING STRIPS Cut **E** strips as follows:

STRIP ONE: (18) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips.

FOR STRIPS 2-4 TRIM A 45 DEGREE CORNER OFF OF EACH END.



STRIP TWO: (2) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips.

STRIP THREE: (2) 1-1/2" x 28-1/2" strips.

STRIP FOUR: Sew together (3) **E** 1-1/2" x WOF strips via short ends. Subcut strip into (2) 1-1/2" x 46-1/2" strips.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

4. Quilt top consists of 7 diagonal rows of BLOCKS 1-3, SASHING STRIPS ONE, **H** 15-1/2" QSTs and **H** 8" HSTs. Refer to *QUILT DIAGRAM* to assemble quilt top.

5. Then sew Row 1 to Row 2 and so forth, using SASHING STRIPS TWO-FOUR.

BORDER ASSEMBLY Measure quilt top to ensure border sizes. Included below are our cut sizes. When sewing borders, ease the excess in to make the quilt match the border size. This will ensure a smooth squared quilt.

6. BORDER ONE: Sew (1) **E** 1-1/2" x (42-1/2") strip to each side of quilt top. Then sew (1) **E** 1-1/2" x (44-1/2") to top and bottom of quilt top.

7. BORDER TWO: From long **C** strip subcut (4) strips at 4-1/2" x (44-1/2"). Sew (1) to each side of quilt top. Next add (1) **G** 4-1/2" square to each end of the remaining **C** strips and sew to top and bottom of quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin with safety pins. Machine quilt as desired. When quilting is done, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED SIZE: 52" SQUARE.
