<b>A</b> Color Weave <i>Cloud - 6068-13</i>	3/8 yd	(5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips – sub cut (12) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips (12) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips
<b>B</b> Soft Stripe <i>Pink - 8081-01</i> <i>Blue - 8081-05</i>	3/8 yd	(5) 2 1/4" x WOF* – binding
<b>C</b> Bunch of Bunnies <i>Pink - 8401-01</i> <i>Blue - 8401-05</i>	1/2 yd	(2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips – sub cut (4) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips (4) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strips – sub cut (4) 6 1/2" squares
<b>D</b> Bunny Plaid <i>Pink - 8402-01</i> <i>Blue - 8402-05</i>	1/2 yd	(2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips – sub cut (4) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips (4) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strips – sub cut (4) 6 1/2" squares
<b>E</b> Tossed Carrots <i>Pink - 8403-01</i> <i>Blue - 8403-07</i>	7/8 yd	(10) 2 1/2" x WOF strips – sub cut (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips - border (3) 2 1/2" x 34 1/2" strips (8) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips
<b>F</b> Tossed Carrots <i>Pink - 8403-11</i> <i>Blue - 8403-05</i>	3/8 yd	(5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips – border
<b>G</b> Baby Bunnies <i>Pink - 8404-01</i> <i>Blue - 8404-05</i>	1/2 yd	(2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips – sub cut (4) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips (4) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strips – sub cut (4) 6 1/2" squares

\* Sew strips together via short ends

WOF = Width of Fabric

# SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

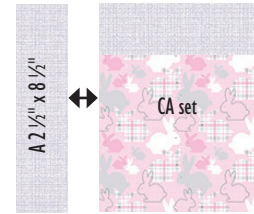
Directions are done using the pink version.

## BLOCK 1, MAKE 4

1. Sew (1) A 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" strip to the top of (1) C 6 1/2" square – CA set



2. Sew (1) A 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strip to the left side of CA set to make CAA set



3. Sew (1) C 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strip to the top of the CAA set to make CAAC set



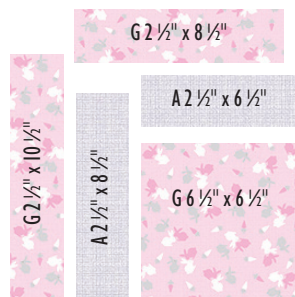
4. Sew (1) C 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strip to the left side of the CAAC set to make Block #1



## BLOCK 2, MAKE 4

Repeat steps 1-4 using:

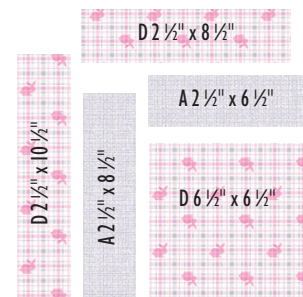
- G 6 1/2" square
- A 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" strip
- A 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strip
- G 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strip
- G 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips



## BLOCK 3, MAKE 4

Repeat steps 1-4 using:

- D 6 1/2" square
- A 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" strip
- A 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strip
- D 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strip
- D 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips



Square all blocks to 10 1/2"

## QUILT ASSEMBLY:

5. Layout 4 rows of 3 blocks and (2) Lattice E  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Use 1 of each block per row. Refer to diagram for placement of blocks. Sew blocks together to make 4 rows.

6. Sew (1) E  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $34\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the bottom of rows 1, 2, and 3.

7. Sew rows together in order to make quilt center.

### BORDER E:

8. Sew (2) E  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips together at one end. Sew to the left side of the quilt center. Press and trim even with quilt top and bottom.

9. Sew (1) E  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip and remaining E  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip from Step 8 together at one end. Sew to the right side of the quilt center. Press and trim even with quilt top and bottom.

10. Sew (1) E  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip to top and bottom of quilt center. Press and trim even with quilt sides.

### BORDER F:

11. Repeat steps 8 and 9 using F  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

12. Sew (1) F  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $42\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the top and bottom of quilt center. Press and trim even with quilt sides.

## FINISHING

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
