



Finished size: 36" square

In this quilt, the visually active fabric called *Hills & Valley* combines into a dynamic background punctuated by squares in four colorways of *Scribbles*. It is a perfect project for beginners who want to explore the potential of complex fabrics but will satisfy quilters of all

Made with fabrics from the collection
levels in need of a quick project. It is big enough to be a small wall hanging or baby quilt, but can be the starting point for a much bigger quilt by adding more blocks.

## **CUTTING:**

This quilt is made from nine 12" square finished blocks, each comprised of 4 bars. Each bar is composed of a 3"finished square and a 9"x 3" finished rectangle.

From Hills & Valleys, cut 36 Rectangles:

- (18) 9-1/2" x 3-1/2" Rectangles following the stripes lengthwise (shown right).
- (18) 9-1/2" x 3-1/2" Rectangles following the stripes crosswise (shown far right).

From each of four Scribbles colorways, cut (9) 3-1/2" Squares for a total of 36 Squares.

## PIECING SEQUENCE:

Piecing the Bar Sew (1) 3-1/2" Scribble Square to (1) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" Hills & Valleys Rectangle to make (1) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" Bar. Continue sewing all 36 Scribbles Squares randomly to 36 Hills & Valleys Rectangles. Make 36 Bar Sets.

1 The quilt is comprised of two different blocks pieced from the same bars but in two

different arrangements. Sew four bars together into a 12-1/2" square unfinished block in the following order for **Block A** (5x)and Block B (4x).

NOTE: Each block has two bars with Hills & Valleys cut vertically and alternating with two bars of


Hills & Valleys cut horizontally.





Piecing the Block

Piece five Block As and four Block Bs.






Scribbles Bottom + Lengthwise Hills & Valleys Scribbles Top + Crosswise Hills & Valleys



## **QUILT ASSEMBLY:**

Sew the (5) Block A and (4) Block B together into a nine-patch, following the diagram below. (Please note rotation of blocks.)



NOTE: Scribbles Squares always meet diagonally when assembling the blocks, but never touch each other side to side.

## FINISHING THE OUILT:

- Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Make a quilt "sandwich" by layering backing, batting and top. Baste or pin with safety pins.
- Quilt following the lines of the Hills & Valleys motifs.
- Bind using bias binding cut from Hills & Valleys fabric.
