BLOCK ASSEMBLY See quilt diagram and photo for reference.

three corners (1c.). Square AB block to 6-1/2". Make 9 CENTER BLOCKS. excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4" seam (1b.). Repeat steps to complete all sew on diagonal line (1a.). Flip B lower right hand corner up, press and trim Place B square on corner of (1) A 6-1/2" square, right sides together, and 1. Center Blocks: Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of (1) B 2-1/2" square



and sew 1/4" on each side of diagonal line. Cut BC unit in hal along drawn diagonal line and fold open. Square BC units to 2-1/2". Make 28 BC HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE SQUARES. Set aside (1) B and (1) C 2-7/8" squares. Place squares right sides together 2. Half-Square Triangle Squares: Draw a diagonal line across



Square EF squares to 4-1/2". Make (16) EF squares E and F 4-7/8" squares. PAY CAREFUL ATTENTION TO THE ORIENTATION OF 3. Similar to step 2. make EF HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE squares using F'S ZIG-ZAG PATTERN WHEN MAKING EF HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE SQUARES.

6. BC Sashing Strip: Sew (1) BC HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE SQUARE between (2) C 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles. Make 4 BC sashing strips. Set aside



8. CEF SPACER UNIT: Sew (1) C 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strip between (1) EF HALF-


7. BCD Sashing Unit: Sew (1) BC HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE SQUARE between (2) D 2-1/2" squares. Make 10 BCD units.



SQUARE TRIANGLE SQUARES. Make 16 CEF SPACER UNITS




Square BLOCK ONE to 10-1/2". Make 4 BLOCK ONES. CENTER BLOCK and (1) BC SASHING STRIP to bottom (10b.). Sashing Units. Then sew (1) BCD Sashing Strip to top of AB CENTER BLOCK (10a.). Please note orientation of BD 9. BLOCK ONE: Sew (1) BD SASHING UNIT to each side of (1)



and BCD SASHING STRIPS (11.). Square to 10-1/2". BLOCK TWOS, using AB CENTER BLOCKS, BCD SASHING UNITS 10. BLOCK Two: Similar to BLOCK ONE assembly make 5

of quilt top. A 6-1/2" x 59-1/2" strip to top and bottom strip to each side of quilt top. Then sew (1) 13. Border A: Sew (1) A 6-1/2" x 47-1/2"
