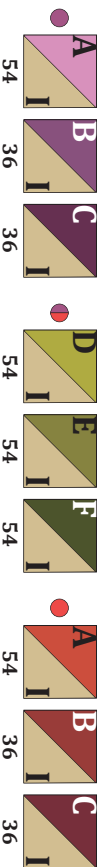

	B Ditsy 1793-66 Purple 1793-22 Medium Red	1/4 YD	(2) 2-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut (18) 2-7/8" squares.
	C Tulip Vine 1795-69 Dark Purple 1795-29 Dark Red	1/4 YD	(2) 2-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut (18) 2-7/8" squares.
	D Ditsy 1793-04 Light Green	1/4 YD	(2) 2-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut (27) 2-7/8" squares.
	E Ditsy 1793-44 Medium Green	1/4 YD	(2) 2-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut (27) 2-7/8" squares.
	F Tulip Vine 1795-45 Dark Green	1/4 YD	(2) 2-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut (27) 2-7/8" squares.
	G Tossed Tulips 1794-66 Purple 1794-10 Red	1/2 YD	(2) 6-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut (9) 6-7/8" squares.
	H Tulip Scroll 1791-66 Purple 1791-33 Red Multi	1 YD	(3) 10-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut (9) 10-7/8" squares.
	I Tulip Vine 1795-07 Cream	1-3/8 YDS	(2) 6-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut (9) 6-7/8" squares. (11) 2-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut (144) 2-7/8" squares.
	J Ditsy 1793-76 Purple Multi 1793-07 Red Multi	1 YD	(3) 10-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut (9) 10-7/8" squares.
	K Tulip Stripe 1792-66 Purple 1792-10 Red Multi	2-1/2 YDS	FUSSY CUT: TULIP ROW (4) 6-1/2" x LOF strips. FUSSY CUT: GREEN VINE ROW (4) 2-1/2" x LOF strips; BINDING.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY USE A PERFECT 1/4" SEAM THROUGHOUT.

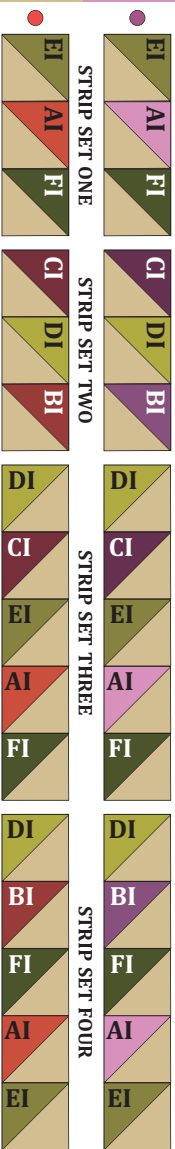
1. HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLE BLOCKS: Place right sides together (1) **A** and (1) **I** 2-7/8" squares, draw a diagonal line on wrong side of **I**. Sew a 1/4" seam on each side of drawn line. Then cut on drawn line and open **AI** blocks. Square to 2-1/2". Repeat steps for HST BLOCKS below, make:



2. Similar to step 1, take **G and **I** 6-7/8" squares to make **GI** HST BLOCKS.**
Square to 6-1/2". Make 18 **GI** blocks.



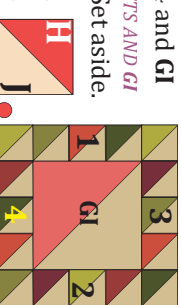
3. HST STRIPS: Sew following 2-1/2" HST BLOCKS in four strip sets, as shown below. Make 18 of each.



4. BLOCK ONE: Assemble Block ONE using STRIP SETS 1-4 and **GI** HST BLOCK. *NOTE PROPER ROTATION AND PLACEMENT OF STRIP SETS AND GI BLOCK.* Square block to 10-1/2". Make 18 BLOCK ONES. Set aside.



5. BLOCK TWO: Take **H** and **J** 10-7/8" squares to make 17 **HJ** HST BLOCKS. Square to 10-1/2".



QUILT ASSEMBLY REFER TO QUILT DIAGRAM.

6. Sew Blocks ONE and TWO as follows:

NOTE PROPER ROTATION OF BLOCKS ONE AND TWO

ROW 1,3,5,7: B1 - B2 - B1 - B2 - B1

ROW 2,4,6: B2 - B1 - B2 - B1 - B2

Then sew Row 1 to Row 2 and so forth.

BORDER ASSEMBLY Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure **K** border sizes. Below are our measurements. For **K** border use your favorite quilting source on "how to" for mitered corners.

7. BORDER K (TULIP): Center and sew

(1) **K** 6-1/2" x (84-1/2") strip to each side of quilt top. Next center and sew (1) **K** 6-1/2" x (64-1/2") strip to top and bottom of quilt top. Miter the corners and trim excess overlapping fabric.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When done quilting, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual. FINISHED SIZE: 63" x 83".
