10. H Border: Sew (1) H 4-1/2" $x$ (61-1/2") strip to each side of quilt top. Then sew (1) H 4-1/2" x (54-1/2") strip to top and bottom of quilt top.
FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is done, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

MAKE 2 HJ UNITS

1. DI Unit: Sew (1) I 5-1/2" square to each side of (1) D 4-1/2" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Square to $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
2. DE Unit: Repeat step 1. to make DE unit, using D 5-1/2" squares and E 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles.
3. HJ Unit: Repeat step 1. to make HJ units, using J 5-1/2" squares and H 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles.

QUILT ASSEMBLY Quilt top consists of three rows of five pieces and $\mathbf{K}$ sashing strips.
4. Using DI, DE, HJ units, (2) B, (2) F, (2) G 5-1/2" x 14-1/2" rectangles, (3) A 14-1/2" x 23-1/2" rectangles, and (12) K 1-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips, assemble three rows as shown in DIAGRAMS below.


SQUARE ROWS TO 14-1/2" x 47-1/2"
5. K Sashing: Sew (1) K 1-1/2" x 47-1/2" strip to each side of Row 2. Then sew rows together, see Quilt Diagram.
BORDER ASSEMBLY Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our sizes.
6. K Inner Border: Sew (1) K 1-1/2" x (44-1/2") strip to top and bottom of quilt top. Set aside.
7. BC Border: Sew (1) C 5-1/2" x 20-1/2" rectangle to each side of (1) B 4-1/2" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Square BC unit to 5-1/2" x 44-1/2". Make 2 BC borders and sew one to top and one to bottom of quilt top.
8. K Side Border: Sew (1) K 1-1/2" x (59-1/2") strip to each side of quilt top.
9. K Outer Border: Sew (1) K 1-1/2" x (46-1/2") strip to top and one to bottom of quilt top.
