(2) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips, subcut (84) $7 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
(2) 3-7/8" x WOF strips, subcut (42) $1-1 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 3-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY



1. Unit One: Take (2) A $1-1 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ 2" strips and (1) D 1-1/8" x 2 " and sew together via long edge, USE A SCANT $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ SEAM, see diagram. Make 42 Units Ones. Trim to 2" x 2-1/2".

2. Unit Two: Sew together (1) A and (1) D $1-1 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips via long edge. Trim to $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make 42 Unit Twos. Set aside.
3. Unit Three: Sew (1) A $1-1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square to
$\square$ (1) D 1-1/8" x 2-5/8" strip. Make 42 Unit Threes.

4. Center Block: Take Units One-Three and sew together as shown in CENTER block diagram. Trim to $3-1 / 4$ " x $3-1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$. Make 42 Center Blocks.
5. AD BLock: Sew the following strips, by number order, to CENTER BLOCK.

-1. (1) A 1-1/8" x 3-1/8"
-2. (1) A $1-1 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 3-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
-3. (1) D $1-1 / 8 " \mathrm{x} 3-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
-4. (2) D 7/8" x 4-1/2"
Square block to 4-1/2".
Make 42 AD Blocks.

BORDER ASSEMBLY Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure B and $\boldsymbol{E}$ border sizes. Below are our sizes.
6. A Border: Sew (1) A 3 " $x 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of C $23-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ panel. Then sew (1) A 3-1/2" x 28$1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to top and to bottom of AC-Panel unit.
7. AD Side Border: Sew (12) AD blocks together. Make 2 sets and sew one to each side of PANEL UNIT. NOTE PROPER ROTATION OF AC BLOCKS AND PROPER PLACEMENT OF BLOCK BORDERS. AD SIDE BORDER SHOULD MEASURE 4-1/2" x 48-1/2".

8. AD Top/Bотtom Border: Similar to step 8. sew (9) AD blocks together. note proper rotation of end corners. Make 2 sets and sew one to top and to bottom of PANEL UNIT, NOTE PROPER PLACEMENT OF BLOCK BORDERS. AD BORDERS SHOULD MEASURE $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x 36-1/2". Refer to Quilt Diagram.
9. B Border: Sew (1) B 5-1/2" x (56-1/2") strip to each side of quilt top. Then sew (1) B 5-1/2" x (46-1/2") strip to top and to bottom of quilt top.
10. E Border: Sew (1) E 3-1/2" x (66-1/2") strip to each side of quilt top. then sew (1) E 3-1/2" x (52-1/2") strip to each top and to bottom of quilt top.
FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
FINISHED SIZE: 52" x 72"
