| BLOCK ASSEMBLY 1. AG unit: Sew (1) A and (1) G 2-3/8" HSTs together, see diagram. Open and square unit to $2^{\prime \prime}$. Make 23 AG units. |  |  |  |  |
| 2. AG1 Block: Sew AG units together to make pinwheel block, as shown in diagram. NOTE PROPER ROTATION OF AG UNITS. Square to 3-1/2". Make 5 AG1 pinWheel blocks. |  |  |  |  |

3. Similar to AG1 PiNWHEEL BLock assembly, make small blocks using 2-3/8" HSTs. Make larger blocks using 3-7/8" HSTs, square large blocks to $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

4. Using 1-3 pinwheel blocks, G 6-1/2" squares and G 3-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles assemble Rows 1-6. Then sew rows together.
BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF QUILT TOP TO ENSURE B,D,E AND G BORDER SIZES. BELOW ARE OUR SIZES.
5. G Border: Sew (1) G 1-1/2" x (36-1/2") strip to each side of quilt top. Then sew (1) G 1-1/2" x (32$1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip to top and to bottom of quilt top.
6. E Border: Sew (1) E 1" x (38$1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip to each side of quilt top. Then sew (1) E 1" x (33-1/2") strip to top and to bottom of quilt top.
7. D Border: Sew (1) D 2" x (39$1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip to each side of quilt top. Then sew (1) D 2" x (36-1/2") strip to top and to bottom of quilt top.
8. B Border: Sew (1) B 3" x (42$1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip to each side of quilt top. Then sew (1) B 3" x (41-1/2") strip to top and to bottom of quilt top.
9. H APPLIQuÉ: See your favorite source on how to appliqué to add $\mathbf{H}$ doll panel to quilt top.


FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When done quilting, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual. SIZE: 41 " x 47".
