



SAMPLE KEY/SKU	QTY	CUT WOF = Width of Fabric *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated.
A Dandelion Deep Pink 3999-04	2 yd	(5) 2" x WOF strips; sew together and subcut (2) 2" x 50 ½" strips (5) 2 ¾" x WOF strips; sew together and subcut (2) 2 ¾" x 50 ½" strips (9) 2 3/8" x WOF strips; subcut (3) of these strips into (20) 2 3/8" x 4¾" strips (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips*; border (6) 2 ¼" x WOF strips*; binding
B Rain Persimmon 3994-34	¾ yd	(9) 2 $3/8$ " x WOF strips; subcut (3) of these strips into (20) 2 $3/8$ " x 4 $3/4$ " strips
C Diagonal Stripe Persimmon 3998-31	1 ¼ yd	(13) 2 $7/8$ " x WOF strips; subcut (1) of these strips into (10) 2 $7/8$ " squares
D Small Floral Stripe Persimmon 3996-01	7/8 yd	(5) 5" x WOF strips; sew together and subcut (2) 5" x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
E Large Bloom Persimmon on White 3990	1¾ yd -31	(5) 10" x WOF strips; sew together and subcut (2) 10" x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
F Lingonberry Orange on White 3993-91	¾ yd	(5) 3" x WOF strips; sew together and subcut (2) 3" x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips


BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Knot Block


1. Sew (1) A 2 3/8" x wof strip to each side of (1) C 2 7/8" x wof strip. Then sew (1) C 2 7/8" x wof strip to each side of ACA strip set. Repeat to make (3) CACAC strips. Subcut into (20) A 5 ¼" strip sets.


2. Sew (1) B 2 3/8" x wof strip to each side of (1) C 2 7/8" x wof strip. Repeat to make (3) BCB strip sets. Subcut into (20) B 4 ¾" strip sets.


BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Center Blocks

3. Sew (1) A 2 3/8" x 4 ¾" strip to the top of (1) C 2 7/8" square, stopping seam 1/2" before the end of 2 7/8" square. Sew (1) B 2 3/8" x 4 3/4" strip to the left side of the AC set. Sew (1) A 2 3/8" x 4 ¾" strip to the bottom of the ACB set. Sew (1) B 2 3/8" x 4 ¾" strip to the right side of the ACBA set, making sure to keep A strip clear of seam. Then fold beginning strip A right sides together with sewn unit and finish seam to complete Center Square. Square to 6 ½". Repeat steps to make (10) Center Squares.









4. Sew (1) B 4 ¾" strip set to the top of Center square as shown. Repeat for bottom of Center square.

5. Sew (1) A 5 ¼" strip set to the left side of Center square. Repeat for the right side to complete Knot Block. With Center square on point, square to 10 ½". Make (10) Knot Blocks.



6. Noting placement on quilt diagram, sew (5) Knot blocks together in a row. Repeat to make (2) Knot block rows.

QUILT LAYOUT

7. Following picture of quilt, sew rows together as shown to make quilt top.

A – 2" x 50 ½" strip

D - 5" x 50 ½" strip

E - 10" x 50 ½" strip

F - 3" x 50 ½" strip

 $A - 2 \frac{3}{4}$ " x 50 ½" strip

BORDER ASSEMBLY

Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting size. Below are our measurements.

8. Sew (1) A 1 ½" x (60 ½") border strip to each side of quilt top. Sew (1) A 1 ½" x (52 ½") border strip to the top and to the bottom of quilt top.


FINISHING

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
