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



	<b>H</b> Quilt Block Solids 5069-01 Natural	7/8 YD	(13) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (22) 2" x 10-1/2" strips (22) 2" x 13-1/2" strips
	<b>I</b> Quilt Block Solids 3000H-12 Black	3/4 YD	(2) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (6) 2" x 13-1/2" strips, SASHING (9) 2" x WOF strips; SASHING & BORDER (4) 2" x 57-1/2" strips (2) 2" x 51-1/2" strips
	<b>J</b> Baroque 6540-12 Black (To Rome With Love)	1-1/8 YD	(6) 2-1/4" x WOF strips*, BINDING (6) 3-1/2" x WOF strips*, BORDER

\*SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS, GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY, WOF=WIDTH OF FABRIC

## QUILT BLOCK ASSEMBLY *Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAM.*

**1. Outer Blocks:** Sew (1) **H** 2" x 10-1/2" strip to each side of **A** 10-1/2" square. Then sew (1) **H** 2" x 13-1/2" strip to the top and (1) to the bottom. (Make 2 **AH BLOCKS**) Repeat steps to make 2 **BH**, 2 **CH**, 2 **DH**, 2 **EH**, and 1 **FH** Block. Square all blocks to 13-1/2".

## ROW ASSEMBLY

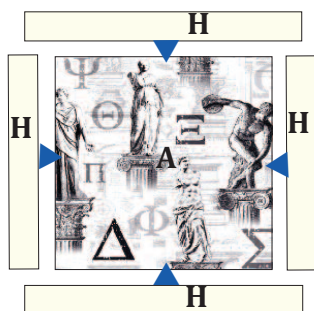
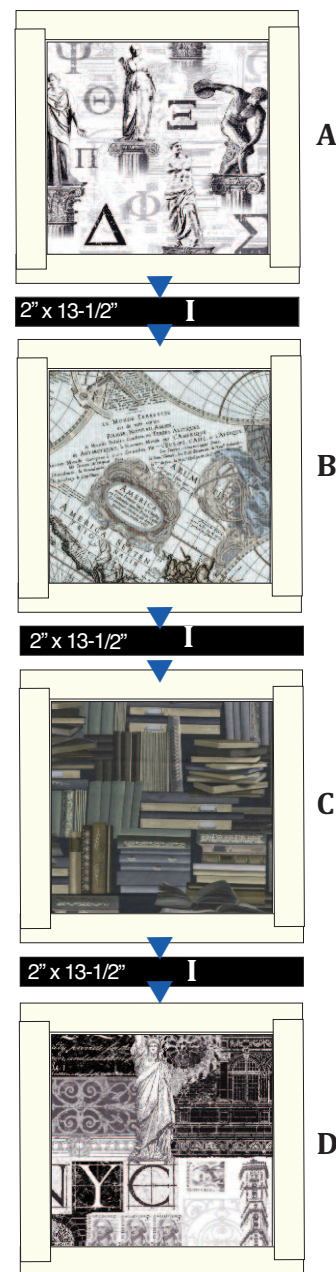
**2. LEFT AND RIGHT ROW ASSEMBLY:** Using **BLOCKS AH, BH, CH, DH**, and (3) **I** 2" x 13-1/2" sashing strips, sew together into two rows as shown in Quilt Diagram. Rows should measure 13-1/2" x 57".

## 5. LEFT AND RIGHT ROW ASSEMBLY

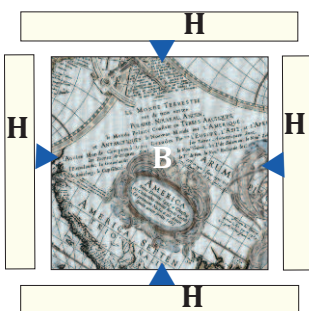

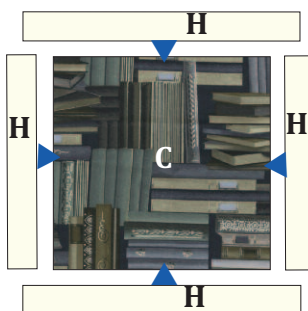

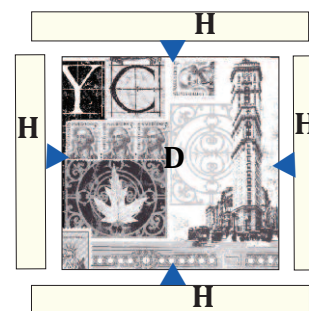
**A BLOCK (Make 2)**

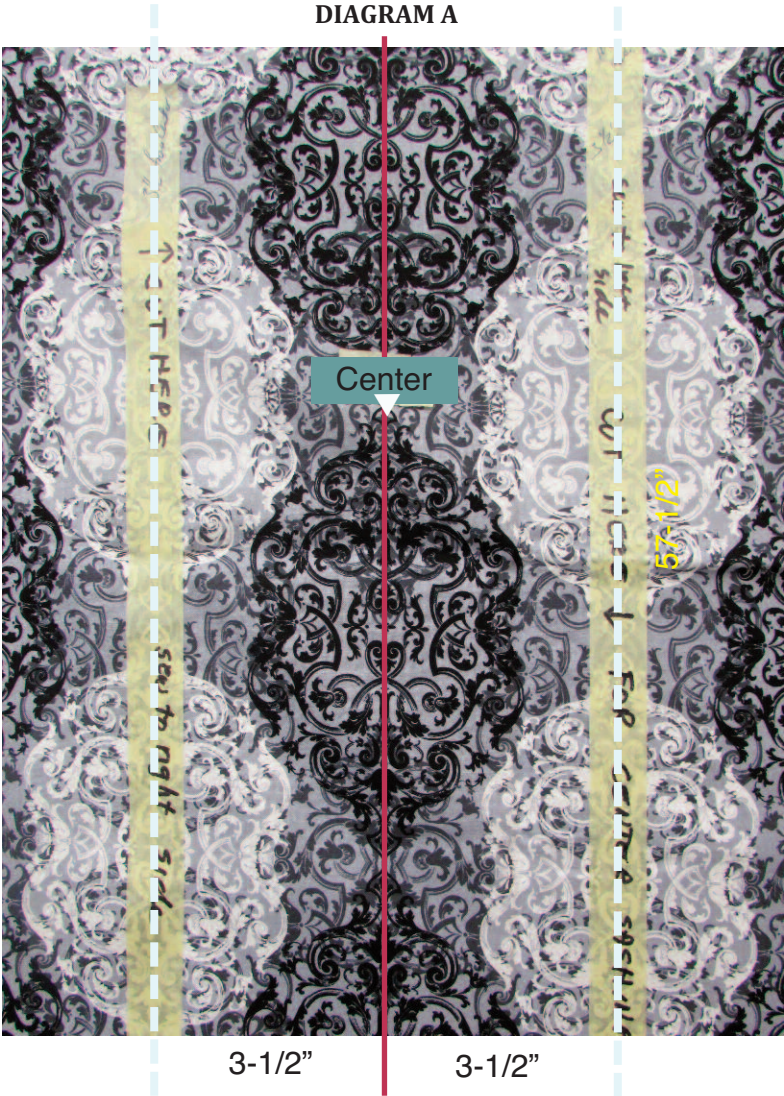

3. CENTER ROW ASSEMBLY:

Using **BLOCKS EH, FH,** and (4) **G** 5" x 13-1/2" fussy cut sashings\* (*see cutting diagram*) sew together into one row. Trim row to measure 13-1/2" x 57".

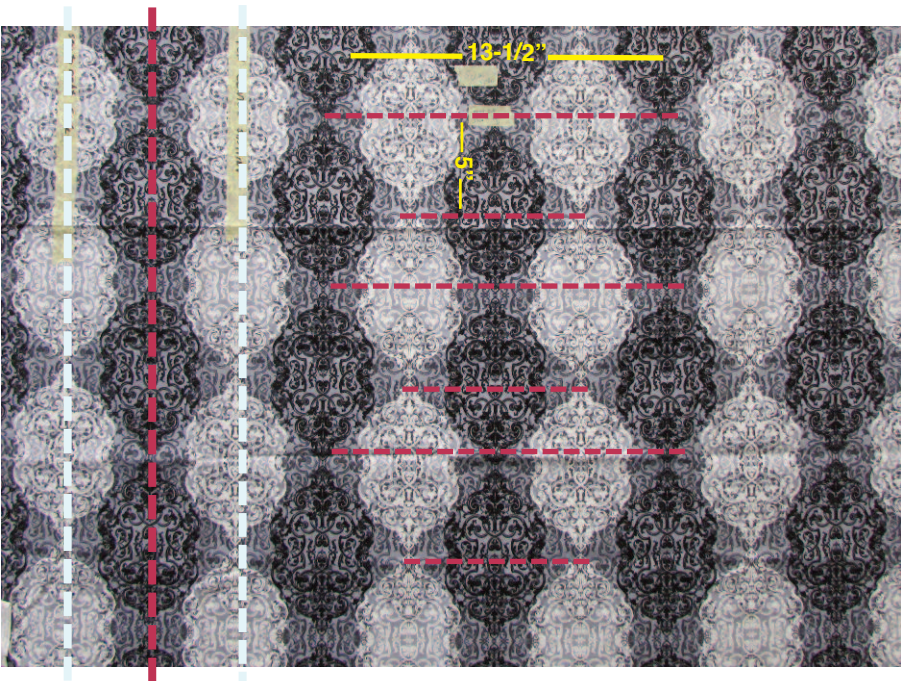

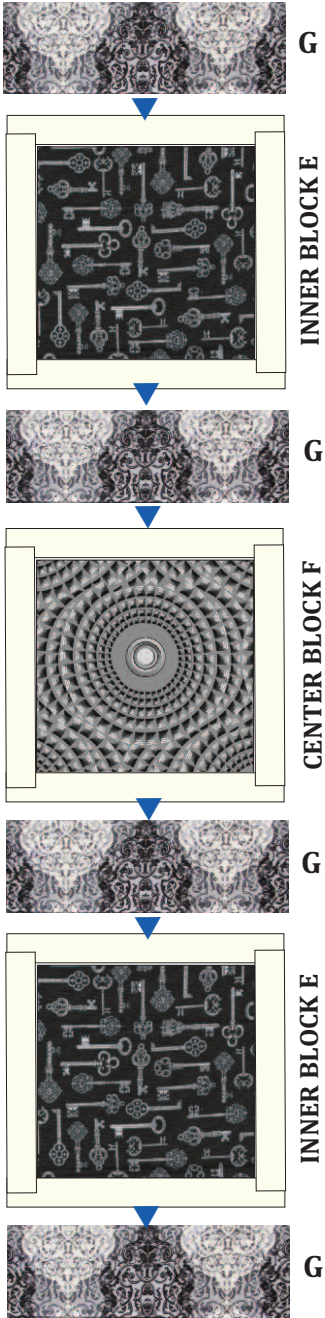
Measure 13-1/2" across and 5" down



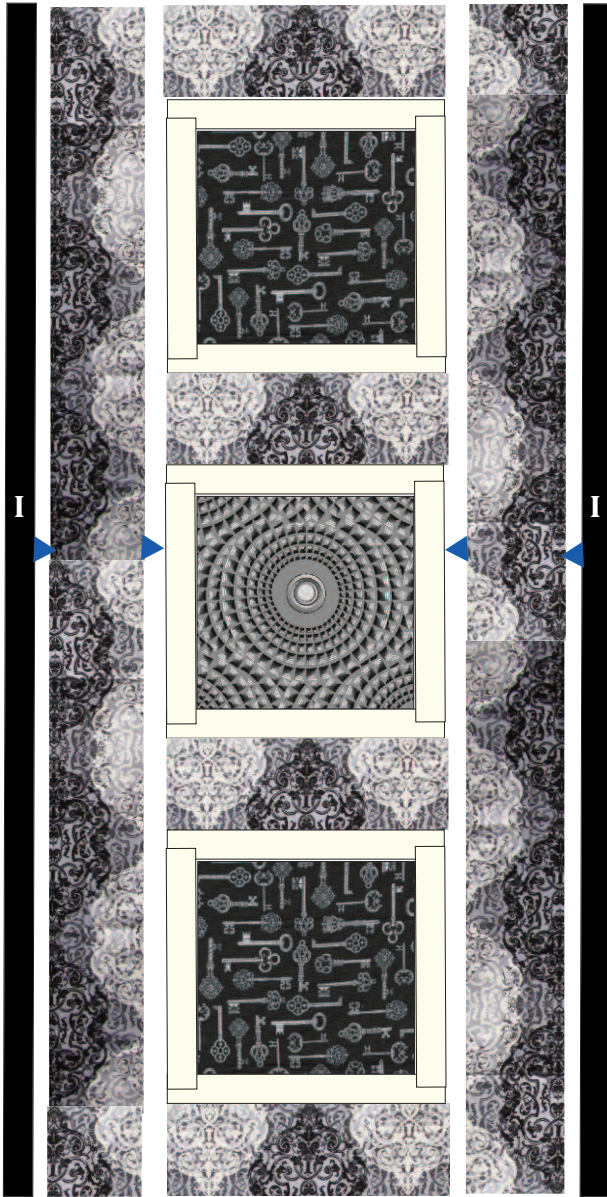
4. CENTER SASHING STRIPS

Following diagram, cut lengthwise (2) **G** 3-1/2" x 57" fussy cut sashing strips. Sew (1) **G** 3-1/2" x 57" sashing strip to each side of Center Row matching filigree designs at top as shown in diagram. Then sew (1) **I** 2" x 57" strip to each side to create **CENTER UNIT**. **CENTER UNIT** should measure 22-1/2" x 57".

#### QUILT ASSEMBLY *Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM.*

5. Sew (1) Left Row to left side of **CENTER UNIT**. Then sew Right Row to right side of **CENTER UNIT** as shown in Quilt Diagram.

**BORDER ASSEMBLY** *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF QUILT TOP TO ENSURE I & J BORDER CUTTING SIZES. BELOW ARE OUR MEASUREMENTS.*

**6. I BORDER:** Sew (1) I 2" x (57") border strip to each side of quilt. Then sew (1) I 2" x (51-1/2") border strip to the top and to the bottom of quilt.

**7. J BORDER:** Sew (1) J 3-1/2" x (60") border strip to each side of quilt. Then sew (1) J 3-1/2" x (57-1/2") border strip to the top and to the bottom of quilt.

#### FINISHING

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 57" W X 66" L
