6. Sew (1) A $5^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to (1) $\mathbf{E}(\mathbf{F}) 5^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 2 "$ strip as shown. (Make 2 strip sets.)
7. Following diagram for proper rotation, sew (1) Corner Block to each end of (1) $\mathbf{A E}(\mathbf{F})$ strip set. (Make 2). Sew (1) to bottom and (1) to top of quilt.

## FINISHING

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 54" w x 58-1/2"L

## HEART BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Draw diagonal line on wrong side of (1) $\mathbf{E} 6$ " square and place right sides together with (1) ${ }^{*} \mathbf{D}\left({ }^{*} \mathbf{F}\right) 6$ " square. Sew $1 / 4$ " on both sides of drawn line and cut apart. Press the (2) HST blocks open with the seam towards $\mathbf{E}$ fabric to make (2) *ED (*EF) HST Blocks. Square to 5". Make (16) *ED(*EF) HST Blocks.
2. Using *ED(*EF) HST units, ${ }^{*} \mathbf{D}\left({ }^{*} \mathbf{F}\right) 5$ " squares and (1) B 9 $1 / 2$ " squares, sew together as shown in diagram to complete Heart Block. Square to 18 12". (Make 2)

3. Create horizontal rows as follows:

Row 1:A5"x $181 / 2$ " strip $>G 181 / 2$ " square $>$ Heart Block $>A 5$ "x $181 / 2$ " strip Row 2: ${ }^{*} \mathbf{D}\left({ }^{*} \mathbf{E}\right) 5$ " square > A $5 " \times 361 / 21$ strip > ${ }^{*} \mathbf{D}\left({ }^{*} \mathbf{E}\right) 5$ " square Row 3 :A 5 " $\times 181 / 2$ " strip $>$ Heart Block $>G 181 / 2$ " square $>A 5$ "x $181 / 2$ "strip

## BORDER ASSEMBLY

MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF QUILT TOP TO ENSURE E AND F, BORDER CUTTING SIZES. BELOW ARE OUR MEASUREMENTS.
4. BORDER 1 - Sew (1) *E (*F) 5" x (41") to each side of quilt.
5. BORDER 2/CORNER BLOCKS - Take (1) ${ }^{*}$ D ( ${ }^{*}$ ) 5" square and either fold diagonally and press with iron or draw diagonal line on the wrong side. Place ${ }^{*} \mathbf{D}\left({ }^{*} \mathbf{E}\right)$ square right sides together in one corner of (1) C $91 / 2$ " square and sew on diagonal line. Press open towards the darker fabric. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Make (4) Corner Blocks.
