
Lovey Buggy


This quilt is going buggy! Take some cool pop-art ladybugs and mix 'em with hearts and paisleys and you have a modern quilt that makes a bold statement. Perfect for Valentine's Day!

Uses Kanvas' Luv Bugs collection by Greta Lynn. Finished Size: 48-1/2" x 57-1/2".

QUILT DIAGRAM

BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

ВLОСК 1

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **A** 3-7/8" square. Place square right sides together with (1) **B** 3-7/8" square. Sew 1/4" away from each side of drawn line. Cut along drawn line, open and press to yield (2) **AB** units. Square to 3-1/2". Make (30) **AB** units.







2. Sew (1) **B** 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle to (1) **A** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle together along the short sides to make (1) **AB Vertical Unit.** Make (12) **AB Vertical Units**. Square to 3-1/2" x 12-1/2".

3. Sew (1) **B** 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle to (1) **A** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle together along the long sides to (1) **AB Horizontal Unit**. Make (13) **AB Horizontal Units**. Square to 6-1/2" x 6-1/2".

QUILT ASSEMBLY

4. Refer to the Quilt Diagram to sew each vertical strip #1 - 10 together using **Vertical Units**, **Horizontal Units**, 6 ½" squares and 6 ½" x 12-1/2" rectangles. Refer to Quilt Diagram to sew Strips #1 - #10 together in numerical order. Quilt should measure 45-1/2" x 54-1/2".

BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE G BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.

5. Sew (1) **G** 2-1/4" x (54 $\frac{1}{2}$ ") border trip to each side of quilt top. Sew (1) **G** 2 -1/4" x (49") border strip to the top and bottom of quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED SIZE: 48-1/2" X 57-1/2"
