CUT
CUT PIECES VIA WOF
(2) 3-7/8" x WOF strips, sub-cut (15) 3-7/8" squares
(5) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, sub-cut (30) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
(6) $2-1 / 4$ " x WOF strips, BINDING
(2) $3-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips, sub-cut (15) 3-7/8" squares
(5) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips, sub-cut (30) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
(1) $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strip, sub-cut (4) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (1) 6-1/2" square
(1) $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (3) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (2) 6-1/2" square
(1) $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip, sub-cut
(5) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
(1) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub-cut
(3) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
(6) $2-1 / 4$ " x WOF strips*

* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC

Quilt Diagram


BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

## Block 1

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $\mathbf{A}$ 3-7/8" square. Place square right sides together with (1) B 3-7/8" square. Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of drawn line. Cut along drawn line, open and press to yield (2) AB units. Square to 3-1/2". Make (30) AB units.

2. Sew (1) B $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to (1) A $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle together along the short sides to make (1) AB Vertical Unit. Make (12) AB Vertical Units. Square to $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ 12-1/2".
3. Sew (1) B $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to (1) A $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle together along the long sides to (1) AB Horizontal Unit. Make (13) AB Horizontal Units. Square to $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## Quilt Assembly

4. Refer to the Quilt Diagram to sew each vertical strip \#1-10 together using Vertical Units,
Horizontal Units, $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and $6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Refer to Quilt Diagram to sew Strips \#1 - \#10 together in numerical order. Quilt should measure 45-1/2" x 54-1/2".
BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE G BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.
5. Sew (1) G 2-1/4" x ( $54 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) border trip to each side of quilt top. Sew (1) G $2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times\left(49^{\prime \prime}\right)$ border strip to the top and bottom of quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED SIZE: 48-1/2" X 57-1/2"
