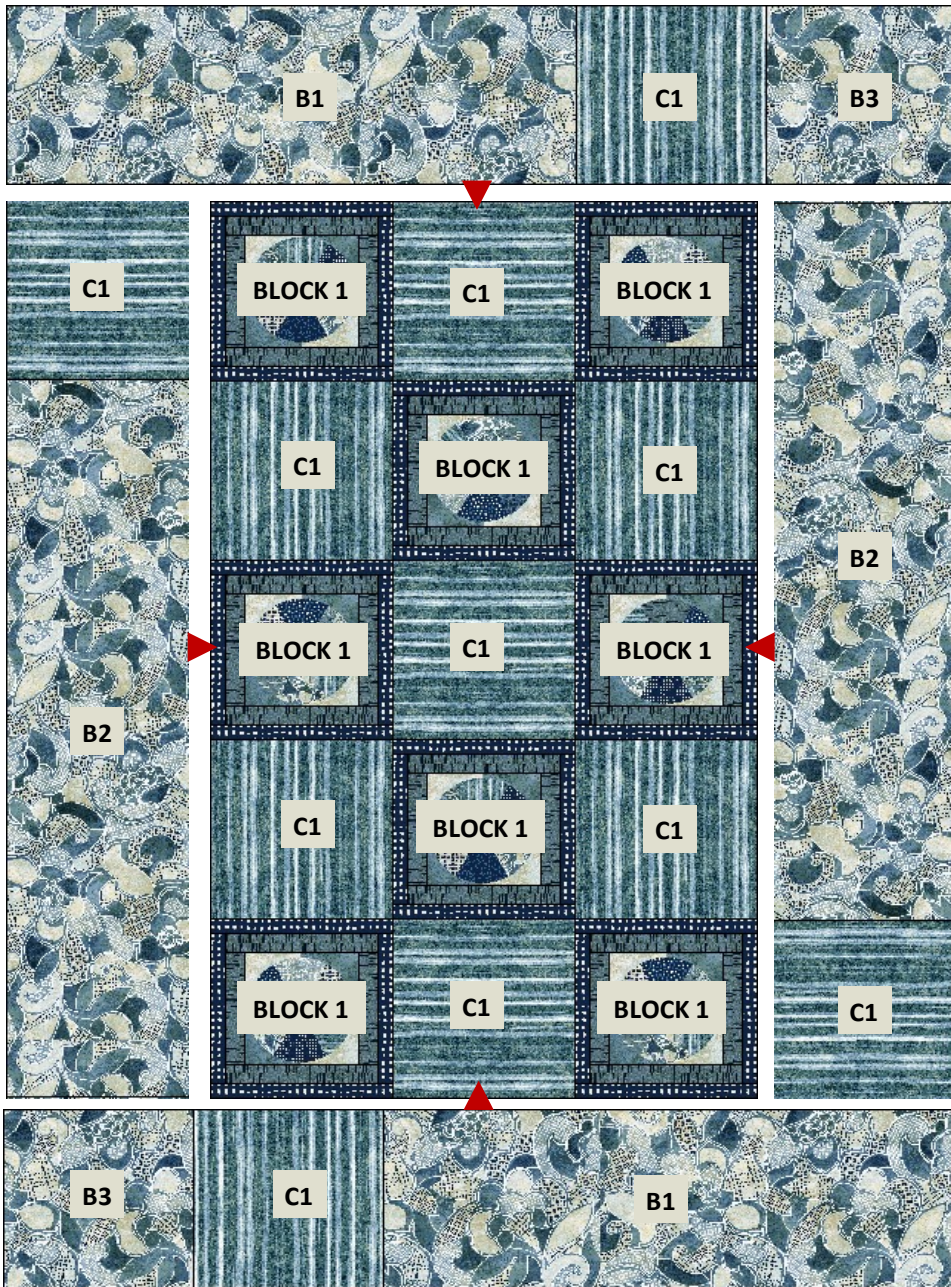

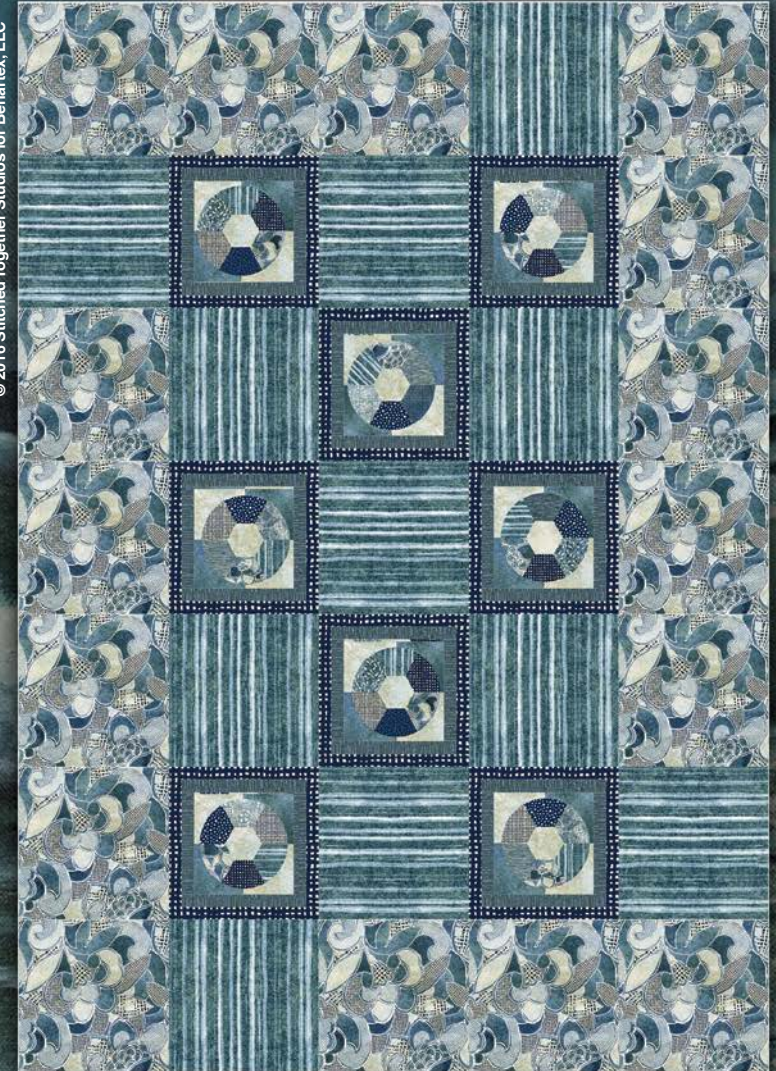

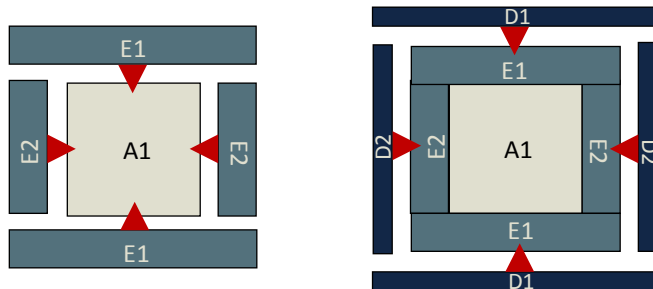

	B 4481-55 Bali Flowers Blue	2-1/4 YD	(3) 12-1/2" X LOF strips, subcut: (2) 12-1/2" X 36-1/2" strips B1 (2) 12-1/2" X 48-1/2" strips B2 (2) 12-1/2" squares B3
	C 4483-55 @ Brush Strokes Blue	1-1/2 YD	(4) 12-1/2" X WOF strips, subcut: (11) 12-1/2" squares C1
	D 4485-50 Netting Navy	1-1/8 YD	(12) 1-1/2" X WOF strip, subcut: (16) 1-1/2" X 12-1/2" strips D1 (16) 1-1/2" X 10-1/2" strips D2 (8) 2-1/4" X WOF strips, BINDING
	E 4487-50 @ Rain Dk. Blue	1/2 YD	(8) 1-3/4" X WOF strips, subcut: (16) 1-3/4" X 10-1/2" strips E1 (16) 1-3/4" X 8" strips E2

WOF=WIDTH OF FABRIC LOF=LENGTH OF FABRIC @=DIRECTIONAL FABRIC  
 +=EXTRA FABRIC ALLOWED FOR FUSSY CUTTING

### BLOCK 1 (make 8)



### BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to **BLOCK DIAGRAM**

1. Sew (1) **E** 1-3/4" X 8" (E2) strip to each side of (1) **A** 8" (A1) square, then sew (1) **E** 1-3/4" X 10-1/2" (E1) strip to top and bottom.
2. Sew (1) **D** 1-1/2" X 10-1/2" (D2) strip to each side, then sew (1) **D** 1-1/2" X 12-1/2" (D1) strip to top and bottom to complete **BLOCK 1**. Square to 12-1/2", make (8).

### QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper block placement and fabric rotation.

3. Sew **Block 1s** and **C** 12-1/2" (C1) squares together into rows, then sew rows together.  
Rows 1, 3, & 5: BLOCK 1 - C1 - BLOCK 1  
Rows 2 & 4: C1 - BLOCK 1 - C1
4. Sew (1) **C** 12-1/2" (C1) square to the top of (1) **B** 12-1/2" X 48-1/2" (B2) strip, then sew to left side.
5. Sew (1) **C** 12-1/2" (C1) square to the bottom of (1) **B** 12-1/2" X 48-1/2" (B2) strip, then sew to right side.
6. Sew together (1) **B** 12-1/2" X 36-1/2" (B1) strip, (1) **C** 12-1/2" (C1) square and (1) **B** 12-1/2" (B3) square, then sew to top of quilt.
7. Sew together (1) **B** 12-1/2" (B3) square, (1) **C** 12-1/2" (C1) square and (1) **B** 12-1/2" X 36-1/2" (B1) strip, then sew to bottom of quilt.

**FINISHING:** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. Quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
