General Directions:

1. Read through full pattern before starting your quilt.
2. All seam allowances are 1/4".
3. This is a 6 month project - after cutting all fabrics you may want to sort them by month (see the "Fabrics Needed" line in each month's instructions).
4. Fabric pieces needed for the **BOY** version of the quilt are in **BLUE**, **GIRL** version in **PINK**, and **NEUTRAL** version in **ORANGE**.



Month 3

... a miracle ... my belly has little you, my little baby, my little one,
a miracle is happening, our journey has just begun ...

FABRIC NEEDED:

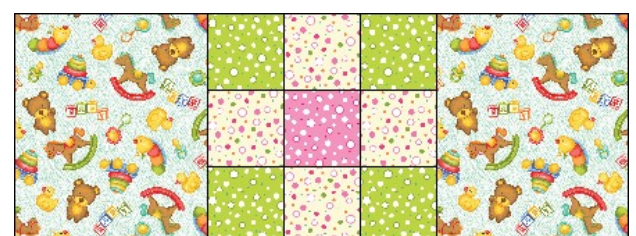
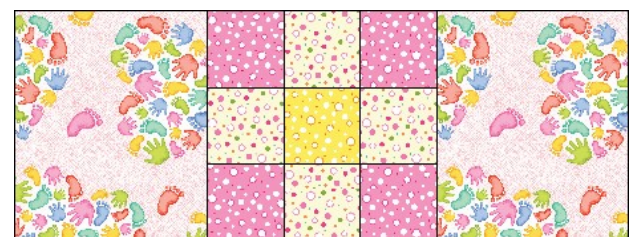
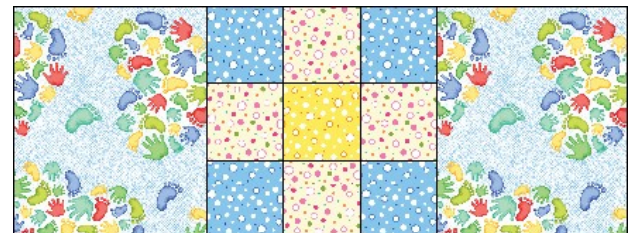
(4) B2, (4) F2, (1) C2, (2) J1

(4) B2, (4) E2, (1) C2, (2) J1

(4) B2, (4) D2, (1) E2, (2) G2



1. Following diagram below and images to the right, sew 3-1/2" squares into rows, then sew rows together to create 9 patch block. Sew 8" X 9-1/2" rectangles to each side to complete Month 3. Square to 9-1/2" X 24-1/2", make (2).





Month 4

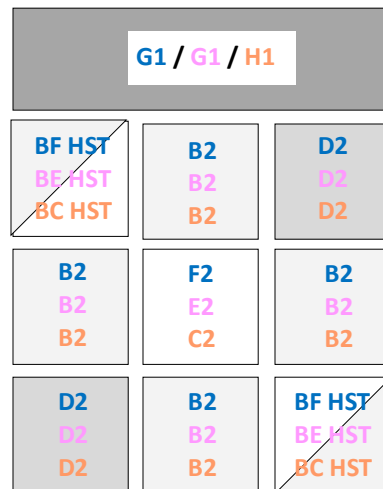
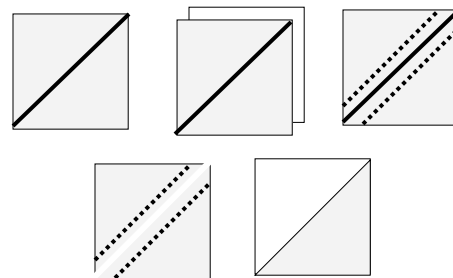
... I am pleasantly reminded that I am not alone ...
You are part of me, my little one, my baby ...

FABRIC NEEDED:

(4) B2, (2) D2, (1) F2, (1) B1, (1) F1, (1) G1
(4) B2, (2) D2, (1) E2, (1) B1, (1) E1, (1) G1
(4) B2, (2) D2, (1) C2, (1) B1, (1) C1, (1) H1

1. Draw diagonal line on the wrong side of **B1** square. Place **B1** square on top of **F1**, **E1**, or **C1** square. Sew seam 1/4" away on both sides of line, then cut on drawn line. Press the (2) half square triangles (HST) open with seam allowance towards the darker fabric. Square to 3-1/2".

2. Following diagrams to the right and images below, sew 3-1/2" squares into rows, then sew rows together to create 9 patch block. Sew 4-3/4" X 9-1/2" rectangle to top to complete Month 4. Square to 9-1/2" X 13-3/4", make (2).



Month 5

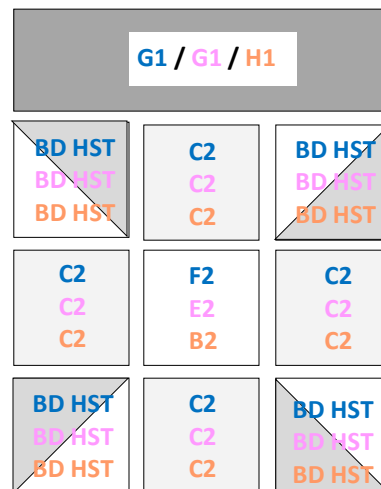
... You're kicking up your little heels ...

FABRIC NEEDED:

(4) C2, (1) F2, (2) B1, (2) D1, (1) G1
(4) C2, (1) E2, (2) B1, (2) D1, (1) G1
(4) C2, (1) B2, (2) B1, (2) D1, (1) H1

1. As in Month 4, create HSTs using (2) **B1** and (2) **D1** squares. Make (4) **BD HST**, square to 3-1/2".

2. Following diagram to the right and images below, sew 3-1/2" squares into rows, then sew rows together to create 9 patch block. Sew 4-3/4" X 9-1/2" rectangle to top to complete Month 5. Square to 9-1/2" X 13-3/4", make (2).





Month 6

... I think of things you'll want to know ...
I feel you swimming inside my womb,
You stole my breath, embraced my heart.

FABRIC NEEDED:

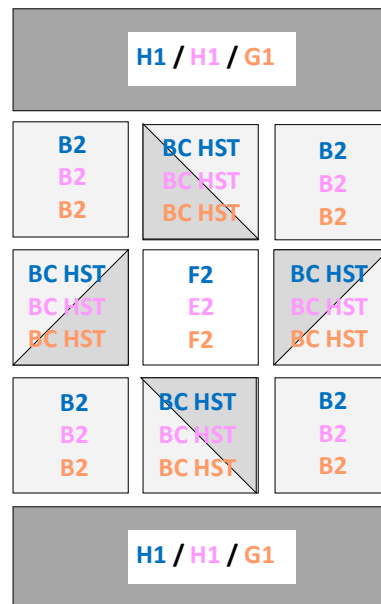
(4) B2, (1) F2, (2) B1, (2) C1, (2) H1

(4) B2, (1) E2, (2) B1, (2) C1, (2) H1

(4) B2, (1) F2, (2) B1, (2) C1, (2) G1

1. As in Month 4, create HSTs using (2) **B1** and (2) **C1** squares. Make (4) **BC HST**, square to 3-1/2".

2. Following diagram below and images to the left, sew 3-1/2" squares into rows, then sew rows together to create 9 patch block. Sew 4-3/4" X 9-1/2" rectangles to top and bottom to complete MONTH 6. Square to 9-1/2" X 18", make (2).



Month 7

... As mom with child,
I'm counting every moment ...
Each day I know my mind
Is filled with thoughts of you ...

FABRIC NEEDED:

(3) D2, (1) C2, (1) F2, (2) B1, (2) F1

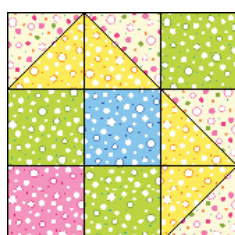
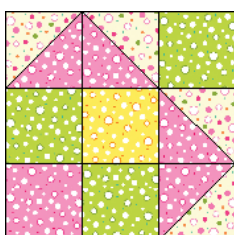
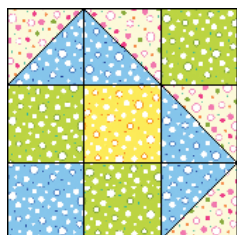
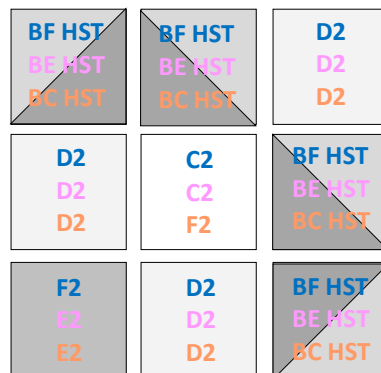

1. As in Month 4, create HSTs using (2) **B1** and (2) **F1**, **E1**, or **C1** squares. Make (4) **BF**, **BE**, or **BC HST**, square to 3-1/2".

2. Following diagram below and images to the left, sew 3-1/2" squares into rows, then sew rows together to create 9 patch block to complete MONTH 7. Square to 9-1/2" X 9-1/2", make (4).





Month 8

... I look forward to your birth ...
I can't wait to cuddle you, my little baby.

FABRIC NEEDED:

Blocks created in Months 3 through 7, K 1-3/4" strip, K 2" strip

Blocks created in Months 3 through 7, K 1-3/4" strip, K 2" strip

Blocks created in Months 3 through 7, K 1-3/4" strip, K 2" strip

QUILT ASSEMBLY: (Note: Diagram below is for **NEUTRAL** quilt - please refer to cover images for **BOY** and **GIRL** quilts.)

1. Cut and sew (1) K 1-3/4" X 41-1/2" strip to each side of A 22" X 41-1/2" rectangle, then cut and sew (1) K 2" X 24-1/2" strip to top and bottom to create **QUILT CENTER**.

2. Sew together the following month blocks to create **ROWS**, then sew to **QUILT CENTER** in order created (see diagram below for proper block placement and rotation).

LEFT ROW: (1) **MONTH 4** block to top of (1) **MONTH 6** block, then sew (1) **MONTH 5** to bottom.

RIGHT ROW: (1) **MONTH 5** block to top of (1) **MONTH 6** block, then sew (1) **MONTH 4** to bottom.

TOP ROW: (1) **MONTH 7** block to each side of (1) **MONTH 3**.

BOTTOM ROW: (1) **MONTH 7** block to each side of (1) **MONTH 3**.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are *our measurements*.

3. Sew (1) K 2" X (62-1/2") strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) K 2" X (45-1/2") strip to top and bottom.

FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. Quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
