BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS . Square all Blocks to 8-1/2".

1. BLOCK 1: Sew (1) C 4-1/2" square and (1) F 4-1/2" square together to create CF Unit, make (8). Sew (2) CF Units together to create BLOCK 1, make (4).
2. BLOCK 2: Sew (1) E 1-1/2" X 8-1/2" strip to each side of (1) G 6-1/2" X 8$1 / 2$ " rectangle to create BLOCK 2, make (8).
3. BLOCK 3: Sew (1) F $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of (1) B 6-1/2" square, then sew (1) F 1-1/2" X 8-1/2" strip to top and bottom to create BLOCK 3, make (4).

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM
4. Sew (1) E 1-1/2" X 40-1/2" sashing strip to each side of A 22-1/2" X 40-1/2" rectangle.
5. Sew the following together to create SIDE UNIT (make 2) then sew to sides of quilt center:

BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 3 - BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 1
6. Sew (1) E 1-1/2" X 40-1/2" sashing strip to top and bottom of quilt center.
7. Sew the following together to create TOP/BOTTOM UNIT (make 2) then sew to top \& bottom of quilt center.

B 8-1/2" square - BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 3 - BLOCK 2 - B 8-1/2" square

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.
8. Sew (1) E 1-1/2" $X\left(58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) E 1$1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ X (42-1/2") strip to top and bottom.
9. Sew (1) D 4-1/2" $X\left(60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt. Sew (1) F 4-1/2" square to each end of (1) D 4-1/2" X (42-1/2") strip. Make (2), then sew to top and bottom.

FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. Quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
