FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. Quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS
BLOCK 1 (make 10, square to 15-1/2"):

1. Sew (1) B HST to each side of (1) D 6-7/8" square to create BLOCK 1 CENTER. Square to $9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
2. Sew (1) G 3-1/2" X $5^{\prime \prime}$ strip to (1) J 3-1/2" X $5^{\prime \prime}$ strip together, then sew to left side of BLOCK 1 CENTER.
3. Sew (1) K 3-1/2" X 5" strip to (1) E 5" $\mathrm{X} 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip together, then sew to right side of BLOCK 1 CENTER.
4. Sew (1) G 3-1/2" X 8" strip to (1) K 3-1/2" X 8" strip together, then sew to top of BLOCK 1 CENTER.
5. Sew (1) J 3-1/2" X 8" strip to (1) E 3-1/2" X 8" strip together, then sew to top of BLOCK 1 CENTER.

BLOCK 2 (make 10, square to 15-1/2") :
6. Sew (1) A HST to each side of (1) C 6-7/8" square to create BLOCK 1 CENTER. Square to 9-1/2".
7. Sew (1) F $5^{\prime \prime}$ X 3-1/2" strip to (1) M 3-1/2" X $5^{\prime \prime}$ strip together, then sew to left side of BLOCK 1 CENTER.
8. Sew (1) L 3-1/2" X 5" strip to (1) H 5" X 3-1/2" strip together, then sew to right side of BLOCK 1 CENTER.
9. Sew (1) F 3-1/2" X 8" strip to (1) L 3-1/2" X 8" strip together, then sew to top of BLOCK 1 CENTER.
10.Sew (1) M 3-1/2" X 8" strip to (1) H 3-1/2" X 8" strip together, then sew to top of BLOCK 1 CENTER.

BLOCK DIAGRAMS



QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to
QUILT DIAGRAM for proper block placement and rotation.
11. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.

ROWS 1, 3 \& 5:
Block 1 - Block 2 - Block 1 - Block 2 ROWS 2 \& 4:
Block 2 - Block 1 - Block 2 - Block 1
