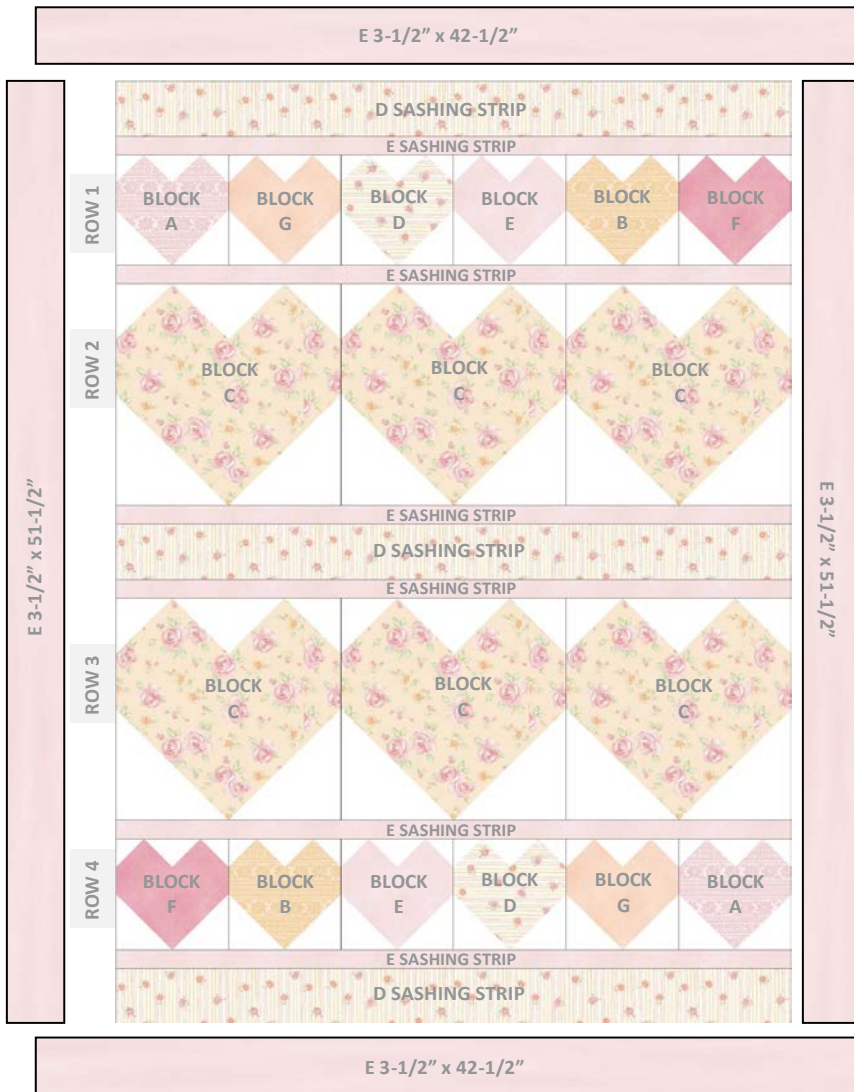


ANNALIESE QUILT DIAGRAM
FINISHED SIZE: 42" X 57"



FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. Quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

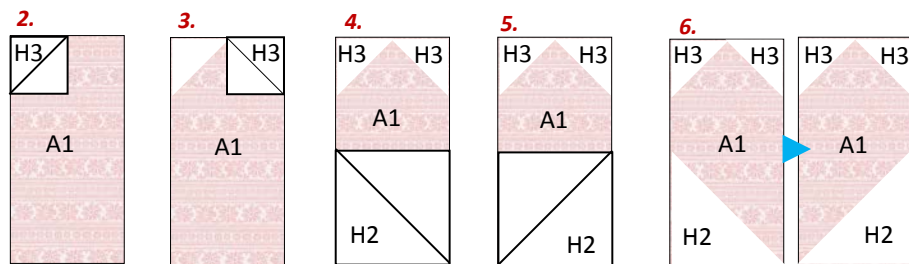

BLOCK DIAGRAMS



BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to **BLOCK DIAGRAMS**

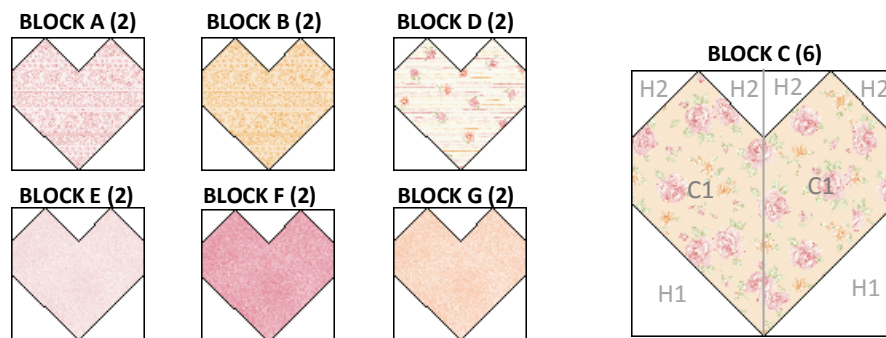
1. Draw diagonal line on the back of all **H1**, **H2**, and **H3** squares.

BLOCKS A, B, D, E, F, G: (make 2 each, square to 6-1/2")

- Place (1) **H3** square on the top left corner of (1) **A1** rectangle. Sew on drawn line, then press open with seam allowance towards **A** fabric. Trim excess fabric on back to 1/4".
- Repeat on top right corner with another **H3** square. Make (4) **AHA UNITS**.
- As in step 2, sew (1) **H2** square to bottom left side of **AHA UNIT** to make **LEFT UNIT**. Make (4).
- As in step 2, sew (1) **H2** square to bottom right side of **AHA UNIT** to make **RIGHT UNIT**. Make (4).
- Sew **LEFT UNIT** and **RIGHT UNIT** together to create **BLOCK A**.
- Repeat steps 2 - 6 using **B1**, **D1**, **E1**, **F1**, and **G1** rectangles with **H3** and **H2** squares to create remaining blocks.

BLOCK C: (make 6, square to 12-1/2")

- Repeat steps 2 and 3 using **C1** rectangles and **H2** squares. Make (12) **CHC UNITS**.
- Repeat steps 4 and 5 using **H1** rectangles. Make (6) each **LEFT** and **RIGHT UNITS**.
- Repeat step 6 to create **BLOCK C**.



QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper block placement.

- Sew blocks together as shown on diagram to create **ROWS 1, 2, 3** and **4**.
- Measure rows (ours measured 36-1/2"), cut (6) **E 1-1/2"** SASHING strips and (3) **D 3-1/2"** SASHING strips.
- Sew **ROWS** and **SASHING STRIPS** together.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements

- Sew (1) **E 3-1/2"** X (51-1/2") strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) **E 3-1/2"** X (42-1/2") strip to top and bottom of quilt.
