CAPRI QUILT DIAGRAM

## FINISHED SIZE: 51-1/2" X 63"



FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. Quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

Note: If this Benartex pattern is included in a kit, any questions about the kit should be addressed to the vendor from whom you bought it.

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A cool combination of turquoise and teal deserves a cool design, and this "Capri" quilt fits the bill. Note the use of the medallion print for a beautiful border. Sew cool!

BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to UNIT and BLOCK DIAGRAMS
UNIT 1: (Square to 3-1/2", make 32)

1. Draw diagonal line on the back of all $\mathbf{G} 2$ " squares.
2. Place (1) $\mathbf{G} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square on the top left corner of (1) C 3-1/2" square. Sew on drawn line, then press open with seam allowance towards $\mathbf{C}$ fabric. Trim excess fabric on back to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat on other 3 corners to complete UNIT 1.

UNIT 2: (Square to 3-1/2", make 32)
3. Draw diagonal line on the wrong side of $\mathbf{D} 4$ " square.
4. Place $\mathbf{D} 4$ " square on top of $\mathbf{F} 4$ " square. Sew seam $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away on both sides of line, then cut on drawn line. Press the (2) half square triangles (HST) open with seam allowance towards the darker fabric to complete UNIT 2.

BLOCK 1: (Square to 9-1/2", make 8. Follow diagram for proper unit rotation)
5. Following diagram, sew UNIT 1s, UNIT $2 s$ and B 3-1/2" square together into rows, then sew rows together.


QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper block placement.
6. Following quilt diagram, sew BLOCK 1s, A 9-1/2" squares and H QSTs together into diagonal rows, then sew rows together.
7. Sew (1) H HST onto each corner of quilt.
8. Trim quilt center to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ beyond block points. Quilt center should measure approximately $26^{\prime \prime}$ X 51-1/2".

SASHING AND BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements
9. Sew (1) E 3-1/2" X (51-1/2") strip to each side of quilt.
10.Sew (1) D 4-1/2" X (51-1/2") strip to each side of quilt.
11.Sew (1) A 6-1/2" X (51-1/2") LOF strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) A $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{X}\left(52^{\prime \prime}\right)$ WOF strip to top and bottom of quilt.
