FINISHED SIZE: 59" X 72"

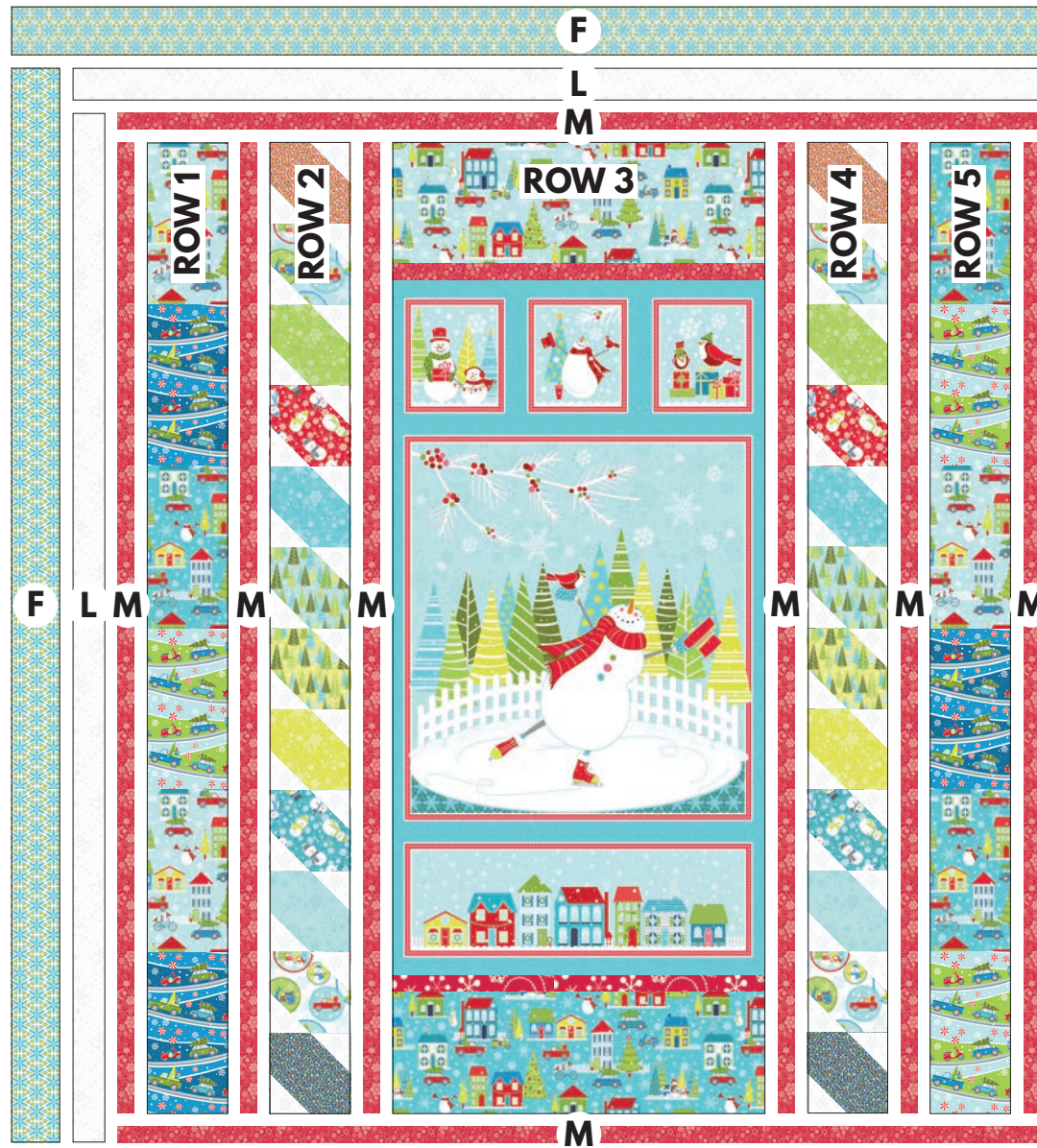
QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

- 8** Sew (1) **M** 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" strip to each side of **Row 3**.
- 9** Sew **Row 2** to left side of Quilt Center and **Row 4** to right side of Quilt Center.
- 10** Sew (1) **M** 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" strip to each side of Quilt Center.
- 11** Sew **Row 1** to left side of quilt center, and **Row 5** to right side of quilt center.
- 12** Sew (1) **M** 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" strip to each side of Quilt Center.
- 13** Sew (1) **M** 1-1/2" x 49-1/2" strip to top and bottom of Quilt Center.

BORDER ASSEMBLY

Measure width and length of the quilt top to ensure border sizes, below are our cutting sizes.

- 14 INNER BORDER:** Sew (1) **L** 2-1/2" x (62-1/2") to each side of Quilt Center.
- 15 INNER BORDER:** Sew (1) **L** 2-1/2" x (53-1/2") to top and bottom of Quilt Center.
- 16 OUTER BORDER:** Sew (1) **F** 3-1/2" x (66-1/2") to each side of Quilt Center.
- 17 OUTER BORDER:** Sew (1) **F** 3-1/2" x (59-1/2") to top and bottom of Quilt Center.



FINISHING

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

*Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated



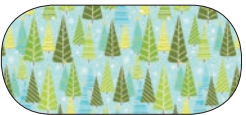

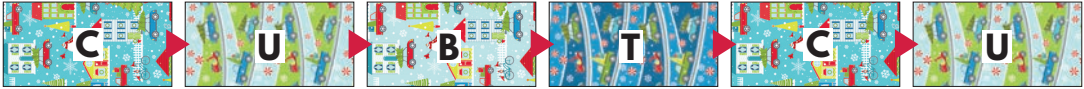
ROW 1 & 5 ASSEMBLY

1 Sew the following 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips together, as shown in diagrams below. *Note direction of fabric in Quilt Diagram.*

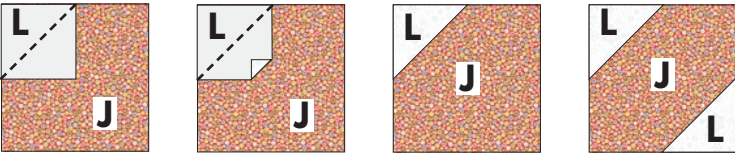

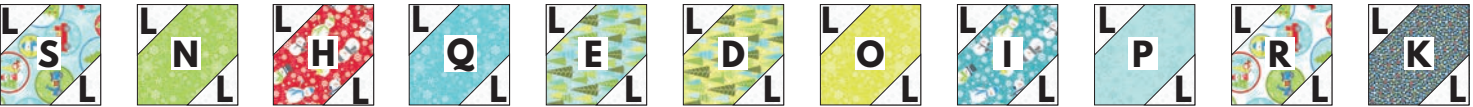


ROW 2/4 ASSEMBLY

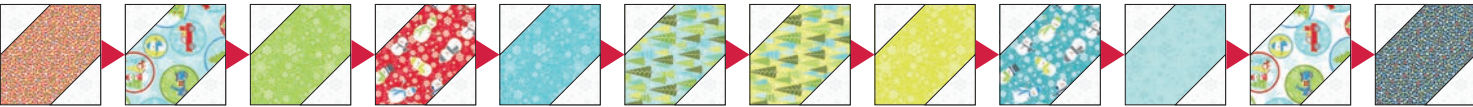
2 Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) L 2-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) J 5-1/2" square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal L corner triangle. Repeat with another L 2-1/2" square on opposite corner of J square to complete JL unit. *Make 2.*



3 Repeat Step 1 to make the following units. *Make 2 each.*



4 Sew one of each sewn unit together in a row, as shown in Quilt Center Diagram. *Make 2.*



ROW 3 ASSEMBLY

5 Sew (1) M 1-1/2" x 23-1/2" strip to each side of (1) A Panel.

6 Sew (1) B 23-1/2" x 8" strip to top of sewn unit.

7 Sew (1) C 23-1/2" x 8" strip to bottom of sewn unit.
