(4) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut

2/3 yd (16) 2" x 8-1/2" strips.
(6) 2 " x WOF strips, sub-cut (16) $2^{\prime \prime}$ x 11-1/2" strips.
(4) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, sub-cut
$1 / 2$ yd (14) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
(4) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips, sub-cut (14) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
$7 / 8$ yd (9) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, sub-cut (60) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
$1 / 3$ yd (3) 3 " x WOF strips, sub-cut (30) 3 " squares.
(3) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, sub-cut (30) 3 " squares.
(3) $3^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips, sub-cut (30) 3 " squares.
(3) 3 " x WOF strips, sub-cut

1 yd (30) 3 " squares.
(8) $2-1 / 2$ " x WOF strips, BINDING
$1 / 2$ yd (7) 2 " x WOF strips.*

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

 PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2"X ${ }^{\prime \prime}$ RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5"LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT,MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

Note: If this Benartex pattern is included in a kit, any questions about the kit should be addressed to the vendor from whom you bought it.

## Blocks

1. Sew (1) C $2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of (1) A $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ block. Sew (1) C 2" x 11-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-Block. Trim the block to measure
$10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to make (1) Block One. Repeat to make (8) Block Ones total.
2. Sew (1) D $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of (1) B $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew (1) D 1-1/2" $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the B square to make (1) Block Two. Repeat to make (7) Block Twos total.
3. Sew (1) F 3" square, (1) G 3" square, (1) H 3" square and (1) I 3" square together to make (1) 4-patch block. Sew (1) E 3" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of the 4-patch block. Sew (1) I 3" square to the left end of (1) E 3" x $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Sew (1) H 3" square to the right end of the strip. Sew the strip to the top of the 4-patch block. Sew (1) G 3 " square to the left end of (1) E $3^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Sew (1) F 3" square to the right end of the strip. Sew the strip to the bottom of the 4 -patch block to make (1) Block Three. Repeat to make (15) Block Threes total.


## Quilt Assembly

4. Sew (1) Block One, (1) Block Three, (1) Block Two, (1) Block Three and (1) Block One together in that order to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three and Row Five.
5. Sew (3) Block Threes and (2) Block Twos together, alternating them, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four. 6. Sew (3) Block Threes and (2) Block Ones together, alternating them, to make Row Six.
6. Sew the (6) rows together to make the quilt top.

BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE I AND K BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.
8. Sew (1) J 2" $x\left(60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) J 2" $\mathbf{x}\left(53-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strips to the top and bottom of quilt top.
9. Center (1) K 8-1/2" x 83 " strip on (1) side of the quilt top and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the top edge of the quilt top and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
10. Repeat Step 9 to sew (1) K $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ 73 " strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ " away from each end of the quilt top. To miter each corner, fold
 the quilt top on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides.
11. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in the figure), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.
FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
