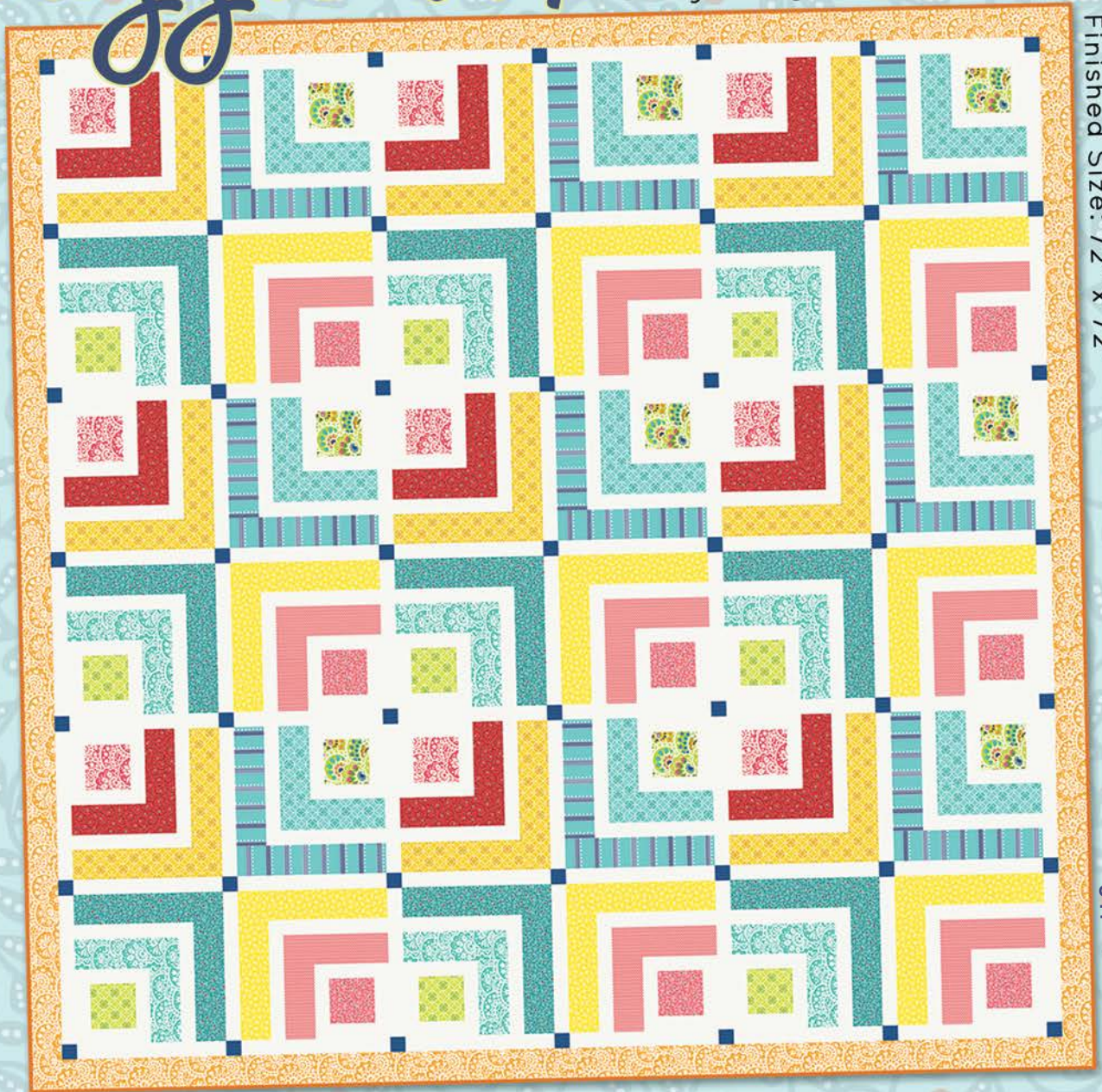



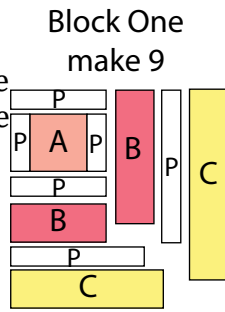

	M Tiny Dot 2137-50 Blue	1/4 yd	(2) 1-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (49) 1-1/2" squares.	
	N Paisley 2133-22 Orange	2/3 yd	(8) 2-1/2" x WOF strips.*	
	O Tiny Dot 2137-22 Orange	2/3 yd	(8) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. BINDING	
	P Colors for Quilters 3000H-09 White	2-1/2 yds	(21) 1-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (84) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips. (9) 1-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (36) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips. (8) 1-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (36) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips. (11) 1-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (72) 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips. (6) 1-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (72) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strips.	

* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY
WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC

BLOCK ASSEMBLY *PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2' WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.*

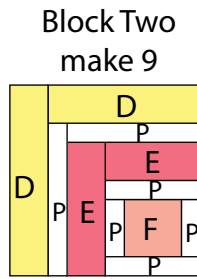
BLOCK 1

1. Sew (1) **P** 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **A** 3-1/2" square. Sew (1) **P** 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A** square to make (1) **PA** square. Sew (1) **B** 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" strip to the bottom of the **PA** square. Sew (1) **B** 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" strip to right side of the **PA** square. Sew **P** 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strip to the bottom of the block. Sew (1) **P** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the right side of the block. Sew (1) **C** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the bottom of the block. Sew (1) **C** 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip to the right side of the block to make (1) **Block One** square. Repeat to make (9) **Block One** squares total.



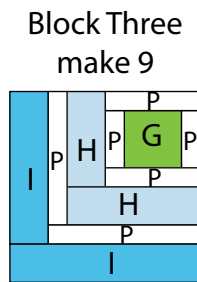
BLOCK 2

2. Sew (1) **P** 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **F** 3-1/2" square. Sew (1) **P** 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **F** square to make (1) **FP** square. Sew (1) **E** 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" strip to the top of the **FP** square. Sew (1) **E** 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" strip to left side of the **FP** square. Sew **P** 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strip to the top of the block. Sew (1) **P** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the left side of the block. Sew (1) **D** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the top of the block. Sew (1) **D** 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip to the left side of the block to make (1) **Block Two** square. Repeat to make (9) **Block Two** squares total.



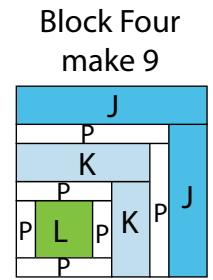
BLOCK 3

3. Sew (1) **P** 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **G** 3-1/2" square. Sew (1) **P** 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **G** square to make (1) **GP** square. Sew (1) **H** 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" strip to the left side of the **GP** square. Sew (1) **H** 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" strip to bottom of the **GP** square. Sew **P** 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strip to the left side of the block. Sew (1) **P** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the bottom of the block. Sew (1) **I** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the left side of the block. Sew (1) **I** 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip to the bottom of the block to make (1) **Block Three** square. Repeat to make (9) **Block Three** squares total.



BLOCK 4

4. Sew (1) **P** 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **L** 3-1/2" square. Sew (1) **P** 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **L** square to make (1) **LP** square. Sew (1) **K** 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" strip to the right side of the **LP** square. Sew (1) **K** 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" strip to top of the **LP** square. Sew **P** 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strip to the right side of the block. Sew (1) **P** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the top of the block. Sew (1) **J** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the right side of the block. Sew (1) **J** 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip to the top of the block to make (1) **Block Four** square. Repeat to make (9) **Block Four** squares total.



SASHING STRIP

5. Sew (7) **M** 1-1/2" squares and (6) **P** 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips together end to end and alternating them to make (1) **Sashing Strip**. Repeat to make (7) **Sashing Strips** total.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

6. Sew (7) **P** 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips, (3) **Block One** squares and (3) **Block Three** squares together, alternating the strips and blocks, to make **Row One**. Repeat to make **Row Three** and **Row Five**.

7. Sew (7) **P** 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips, (3) **Block Four** squares and (3) **Block Two** squares together, alternating the strips and blocks, to make **Row Two**. Repeat to make **Row Four** and **Row Six**.

8. Sew the (7) **Sashing Strips** and (6) pieced rows, in numerical order, together, alternating the strips and rows, to make the quilt top.

BORDER ASSEMBLY *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE N BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

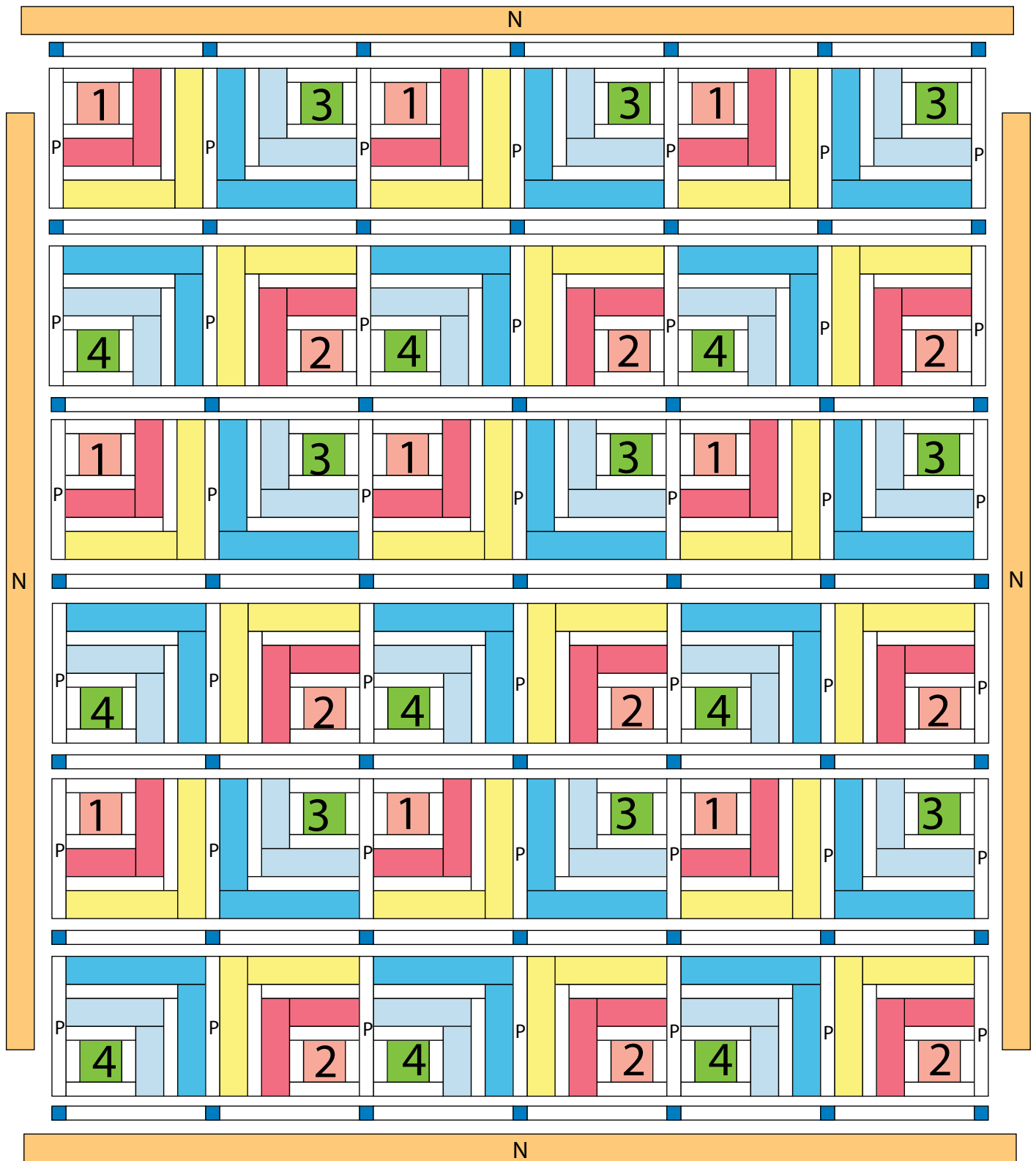
9. Sew (1) **N** 2-1/2" x (67-1/2") strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) **N** 2-1/2" x (71-1/2") strips to the top and bottom of quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED SIZE: 71" x 71"
