CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF = Width of fabric | HST=Half Square Triangle | *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated

A	WIND 7521-13 Cloud	1/4 yd	(1) 8-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (3) 8-1/2" squares
B	MANDALAS 7522-11 Pearl	1-7/8 yd	(14) 4-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (120) 4-1/2" squares
C	MANDALAS 7522-22 Romance	2/3 yd	(5) 4-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (36) 4-1/2" squares
D	HONEY SUCKLE 7523-10 Love	2-5/8 yd	(9) 4-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (36) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips (6) 8-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (12) 8-1/2" x 16-1/2" strips
E	HONEY SUCKLE 7523-11 Pearl	1/4 yd	(1) 8-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (3) 8-1/2" squares
F	HONEY SUCKLE 7523-22 Romance	2/3 yd	(5) 4-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (36) 4-1/2" squares
G	THUNBERGIA 7524-11 Pearl	1/4 yd	(1) 8-1/2" x WOF strips (4) 8-1/2" squares
H	THUNBERGIA 7524-13 Cloud	1/4 yd	(1) 8-1/2" x WOF strips (3) 8-1/2" squares
I	ROSE 7526-06 Sweetness	1/2 yd	(7) 2-1/4" x WOF strips*; Binding
J	ROSE 7526-22 Romance	1/3 yd	(2) 4-1/2" x WOF strips (16) 4-1/2" squares

BLOCK 1 ASSEMBLY

1 Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **B** 4-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) **D** 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **B** corner triangle. Repeat with another **B** 4-1/2" square on the opposite side of **D** rectangle to complete BD Flying Geese Unit. *Make 36*.




OPEN AND PRESS




REPEAT STEPS OF

2 Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) C 4-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) A 8-1/2" square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal C corner triangle. Repeat with another C 4-1/2" square on each corner of A square to complete AC Unit. *Make 3*.

TRIM 1/4" AWAY FROM SEWN LINE




OPEN AND PRESS




REPEAT STEPS ON EACH CORNER

- **3** Sew (1) F 4-1/2" square to each side of (1) BD Flying Geese Unit, as shown. *Make 18*.
- 4 Sew (1) BD Flying Geese Unit to each side of (1) AC unit, as shown. Make 9.
- **5** Sew rows together, as shown. Square to 16-1/2". *Make 3*.



6 Repeat Steps 1-5 to make Blocks 1B and 1C. In Step 2, use (3) E 8-1/2" squares and (3) H 8-1/2" squares.





BLOCK 2 ASSEMBLY

7 Repeat Step 2 with (4) **B** 4-1/2" squares and (1) **D** 8-1/2" x 16-1/2" rectangle. *Make 12*.



BLOCK 3 ASSEMBLY


8 Repeat Step 2 with (4) J 4-1/2" squares and (1) G 8-1/2" square. *Make 4*.



QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

9 Sew blocks in rows, as shown. **10** Sew rows together, as shown.

QUILT DIAGRAM (FINISHED SIZE: 64" X 64")



FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
