

# SLEIGHT OF HAND

## 58"×76" napping quilt

by Weeks Ringle and Bill Kerr of  
Modern Quilt Studio

### MATERIALS

**¼ yard or 1 Fat Quarter** each of all  
18 Dot Crazy prints:

6001-23, 6001-40, 6001-50, 6002-23,  
6002-54, 6002-60, 6003-03, 6003-23,  
6003-50, 6004-22, 6004-54, 6004-60,  
6005-03, 6005-22, 6006-03, 6006-54,  
6007-54, 6007-87

**2½ yards** white solid

**¾ yard** for binding (6005-22)

**3½ yards** backing fabric (6004-22)

**62"×80"** batting

*Yardages are based on 42" usable  
fabric width. Cutting sizes include ¼"  
seam allowances.*

### CUTTING

From white solid, cut lengthwise with  
the grain:

2—3"×58½" top & bottom borders

2—71½"×3" side borders

7—53½"×1½" horizontal sashing strips

From remaining white solid, cut:

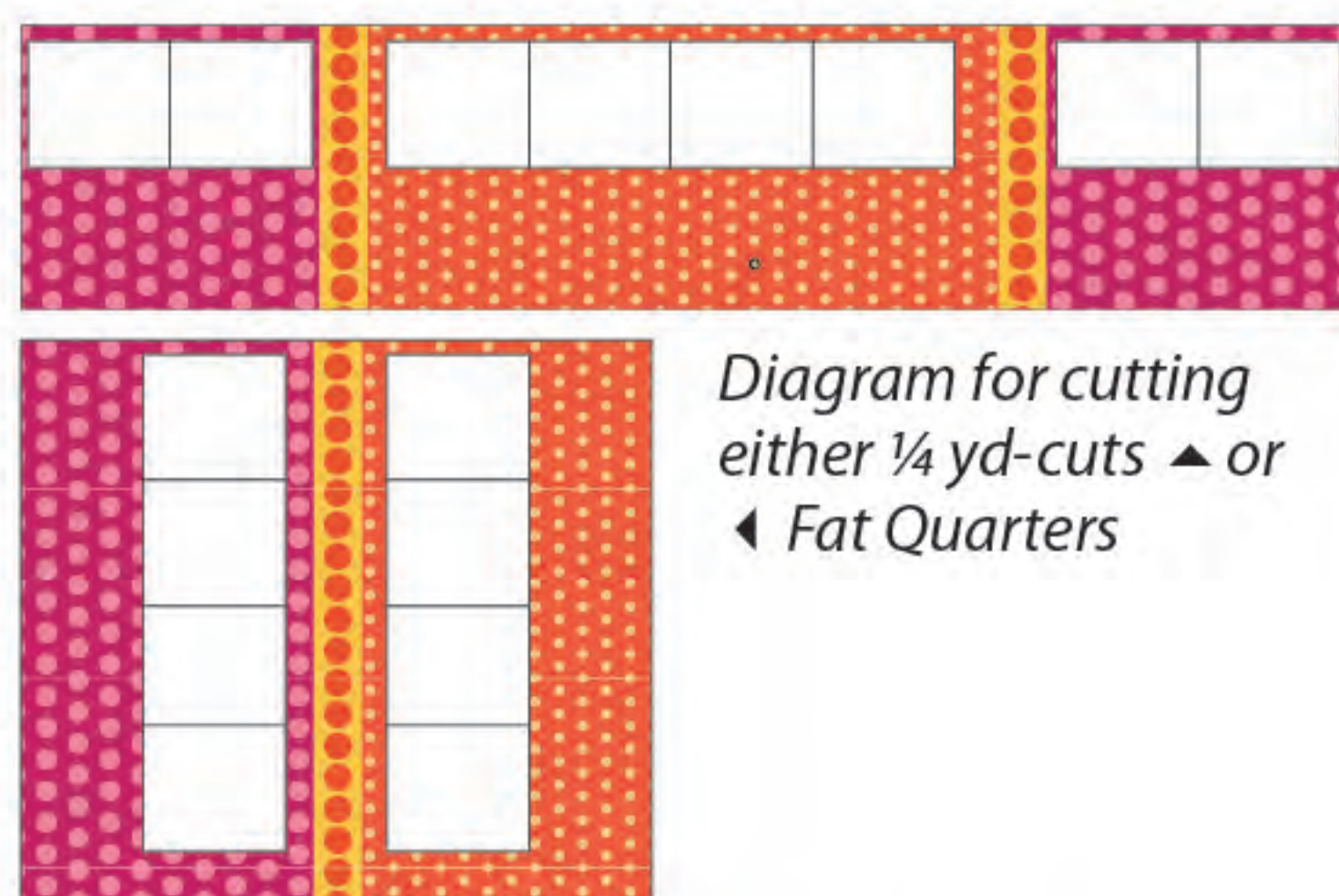
24—4½"×1" strips

42—18"×1" strips

40—1½"×8½" vertical sashing strips

From the 3 multi-dot "Playground"  
fabrics, cut:

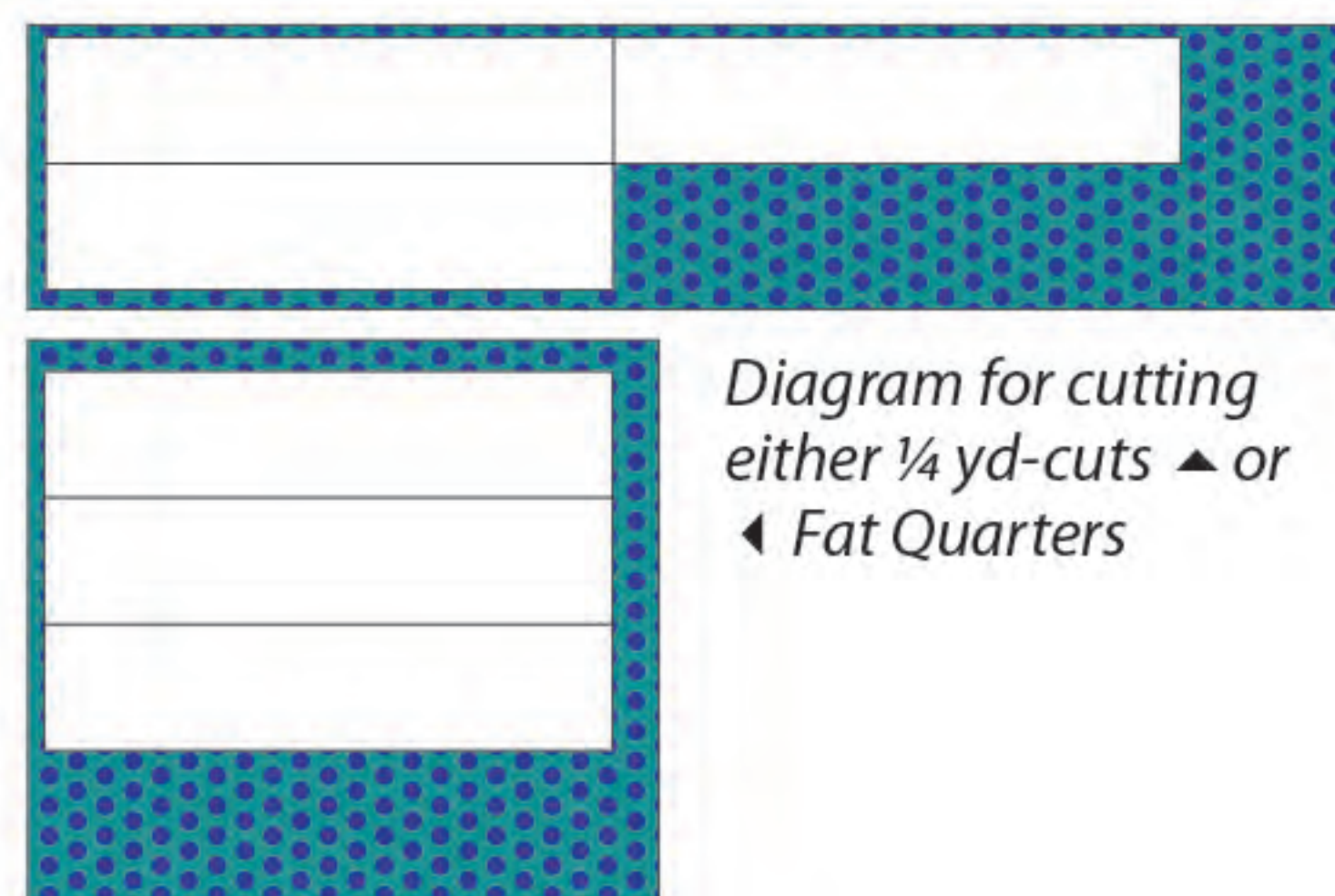
8—4½"×4" pieces



The Playground prints (6002-23, 6002-54,  
6002-60) have different scale dots, so cut 4 pieces  
each of 2 main dots as shown

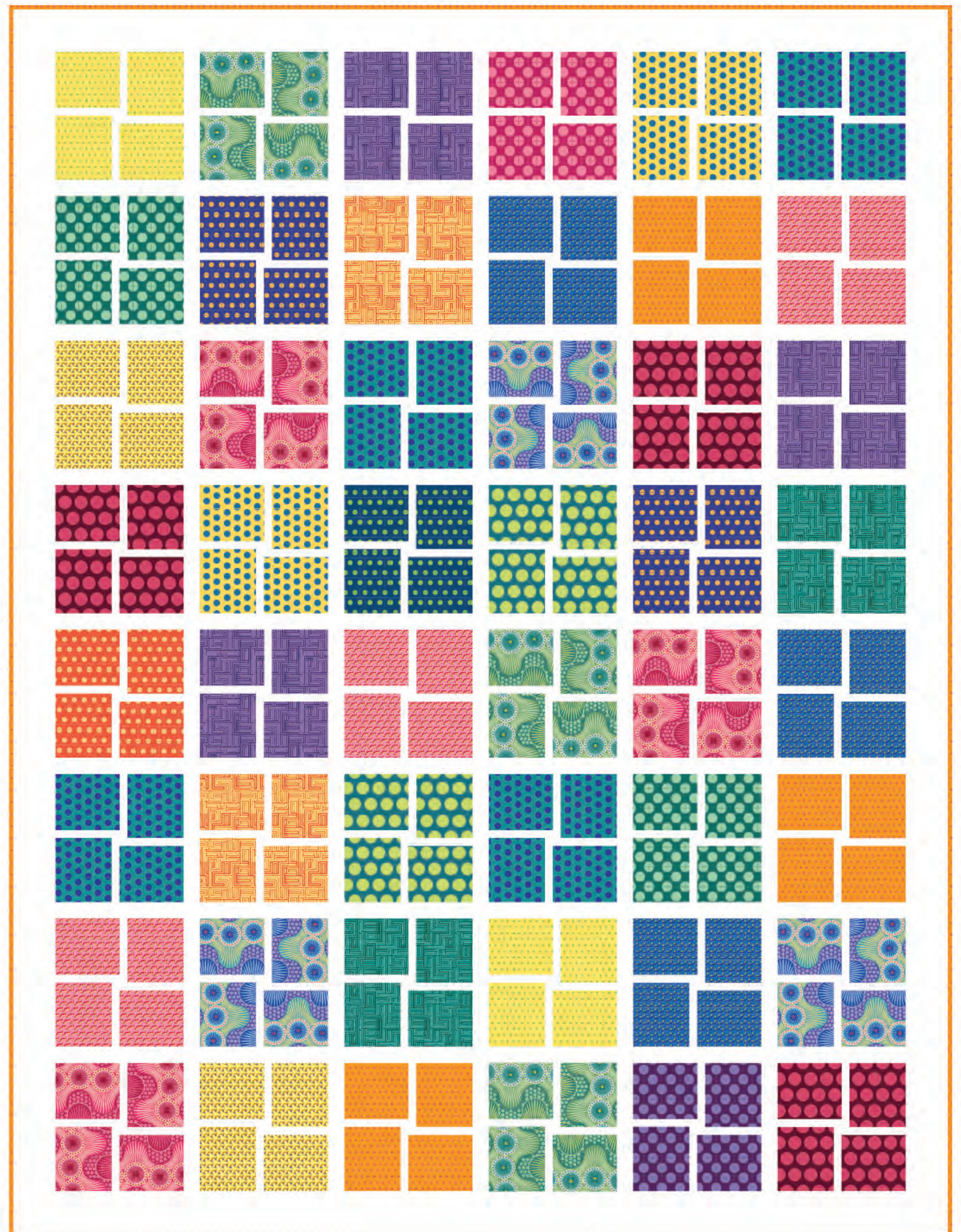
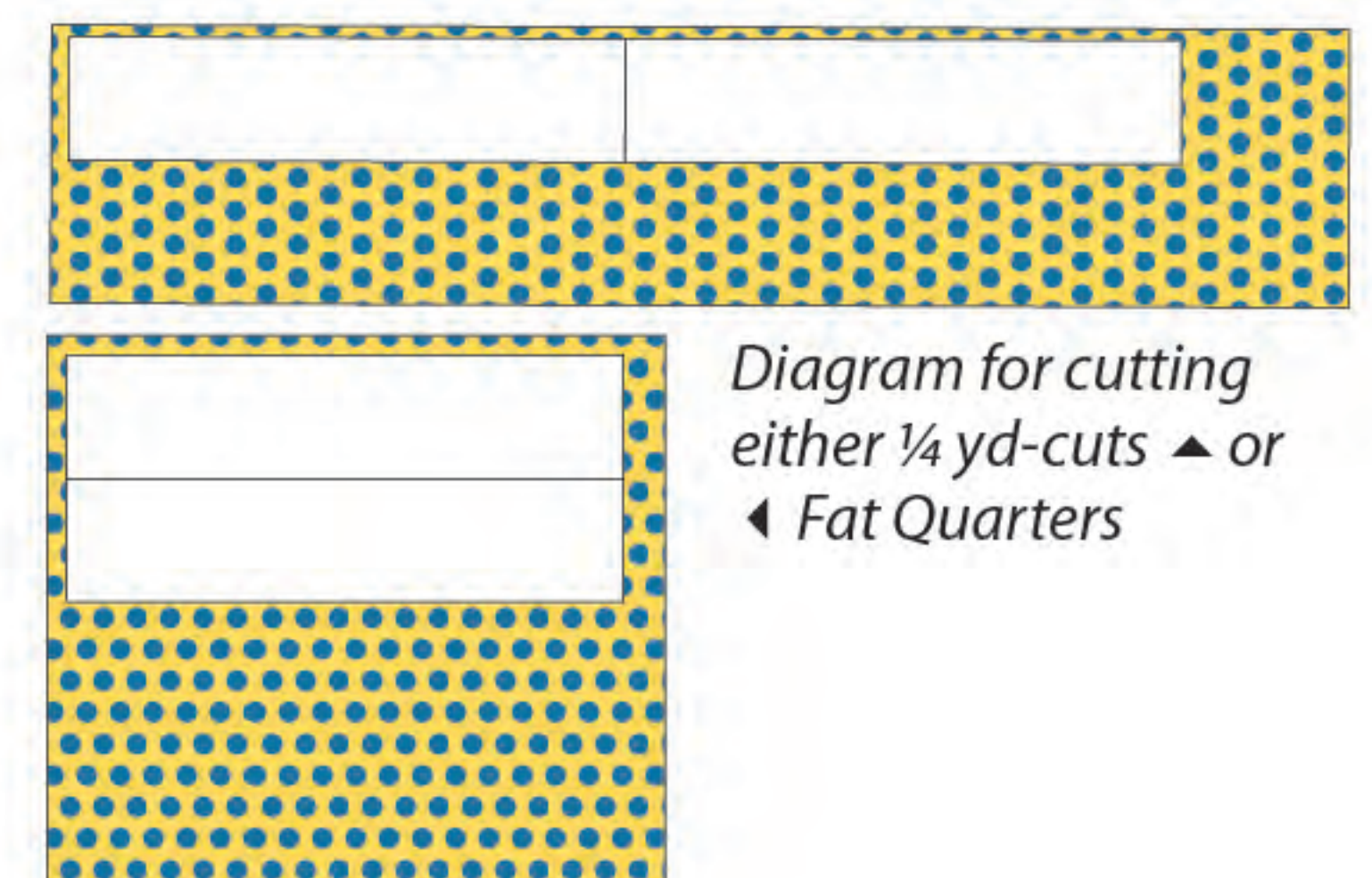
From 12 of the remaining Dot Crazy  
fabrics, cut:

3—18"×4" pieces



From the 3 remaining Dot Crazy  
fabrics, cut:

2—18"×4" pieces

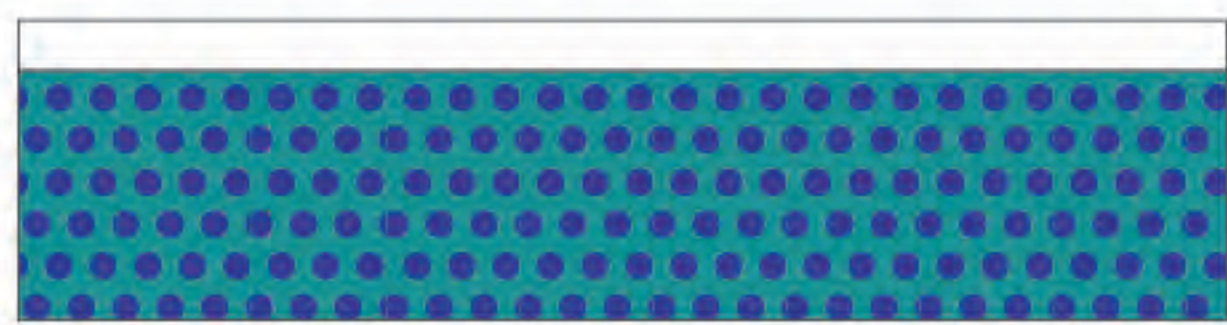




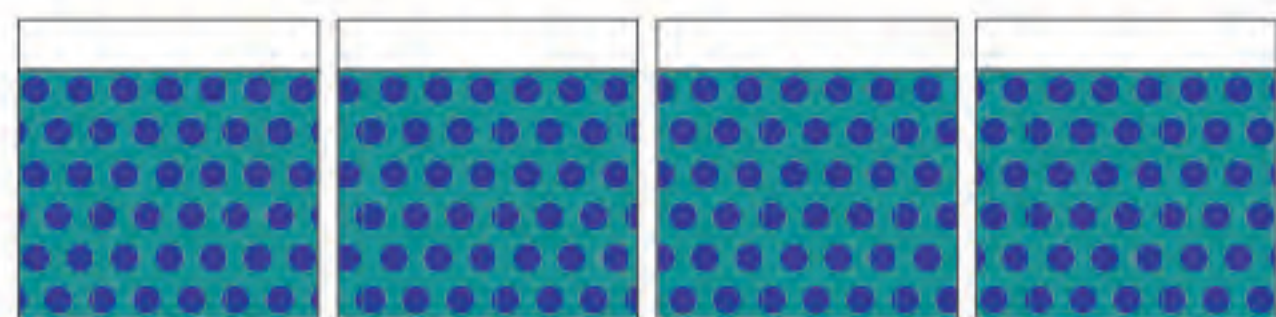
## MAKE THE BLOCKS

We suggest pressing all seams open to reduce bulk and give a crisp, graphic look.

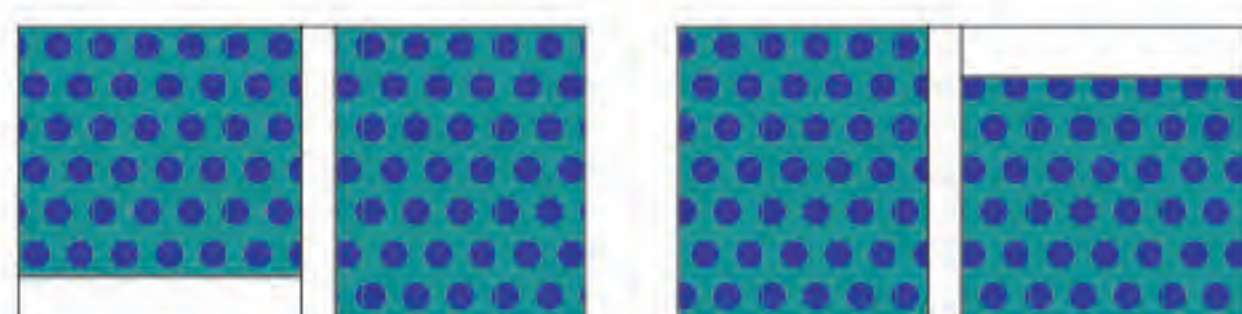
1. Sew a 18"x1" white strip to each of the 42 individual 18"x4" pieces.



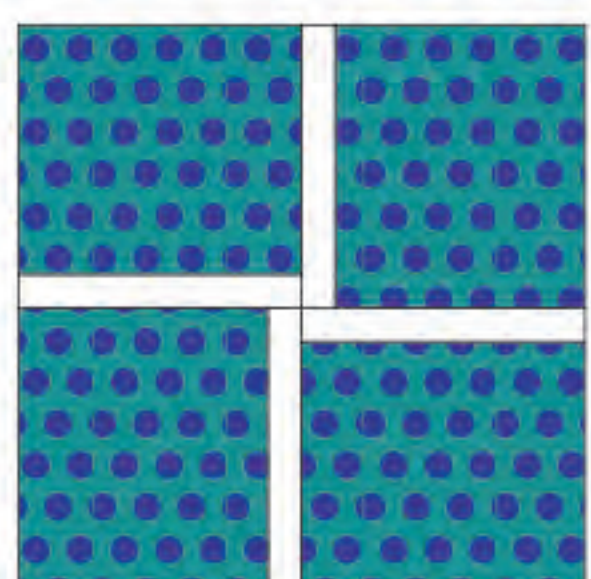
2. Cut each set into 4—4½"-wide pieces.



3. Sew pieces in pairs as shown.



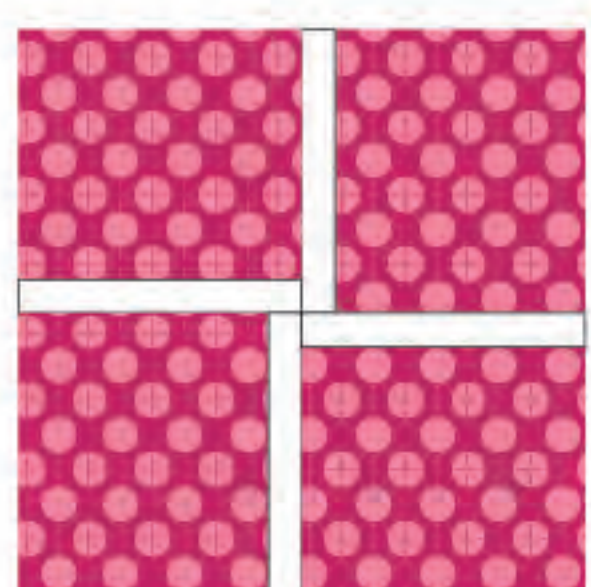
4. Sew pairs together to make 42 blocks.



5. Sew a 4½"x1" white strip to the long side of the 24 individual 4½"x4" pieces.



6. Sew matching pieces in blocks as in steps 3–4 above to make 6 blocks.



## ASSEMBLY

1. Using the assembly diagram as a guide, lay out blocks to achieve a pleasing distribution of colors and patterns.
2. Sew blocks and vertical sashing strips together in rows.
3. Sew rows and horizontal sashing strips together.
4. Sew on side borders.
5. Sew on top and bottom borders.

## FINISHING

1. Layer pieced top, batting and backing.
2. Quilt. We quilted ours with a freehand wave pattern.



3. Make binding, then bind using your preferred binding method.
