	A Bar Code Stripe 2318-22 <i>Pink/Chocolate</i> Sashing and Borders	2/3 YD	(8) Strips—2 1/2" x WOF 4 strips will be for sashing between rows; the remaining will be for borders—trim to fit for all.
	B Wavy Stripe 2315-22 <i>Dark Coral</i>	1/4 YD	(9) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles
	C Rim Dots 2316-26 <i>Light Coral/Celery</i>	1/4 YD	(6) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles
	D Square Bolts 2317-26 <i>Chocolate/Coral</i>	1/4 YD	(9) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles
	E Square Bolts 2317-22 <i>Coral/Chocolate</i>	1/4 YD	(6) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles
	F Peacock 2314-22 <i>Chocolate/Pink</i>	1/4 YD	(6) 5 1/2" squares
	G Paisley 2312-22 <i>Dark Pink</i>	1/4 YD	(6) 5 1/2" squares
	H Large Vine 2311-22 <i>Chocolate/Pink</i>	1/3 YD	(10) 5 1/2" squares
	I Peacock 2314-49 <i>Celery Green</i>	1/4 YD	(4) 5 1/2" squares
	J Daisy 2310-22 <i>Chocolate/Pink</i>	1/4 YD	(4) 5 1/2" squares

Finished size: 37" x 46"

1/4" seam allowances have been added throughout.

Extra fabric has been allowed for errors and/or fussy cutting.

Use leftover fabrics to personalize your quilt backing.

INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: *Continually refer to photo and diagram for correct color placement.*

- Each row of City Blocks has (6) 5 1/2" squares and (6) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles. Make 5 rows.
- Sew striped sashing (2318-22) between each row.
- Add striped borders (2318-22) to sides of quilt top.
- Add striped borders (2318-22) to top and bottom of quilt top.
- Cut batting and backing 2" larger than top on all sides. Assemble the quilt "sandwich" by placing the backing, batting and top together in layers and baste or pin with safety pins. Machine quilt as desired. When machine quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind in the usual manner.
