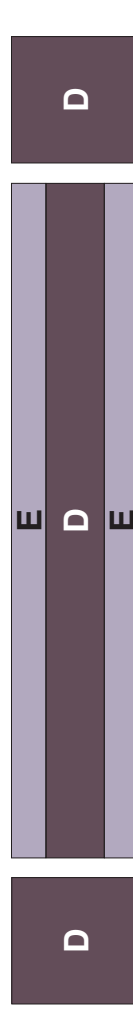
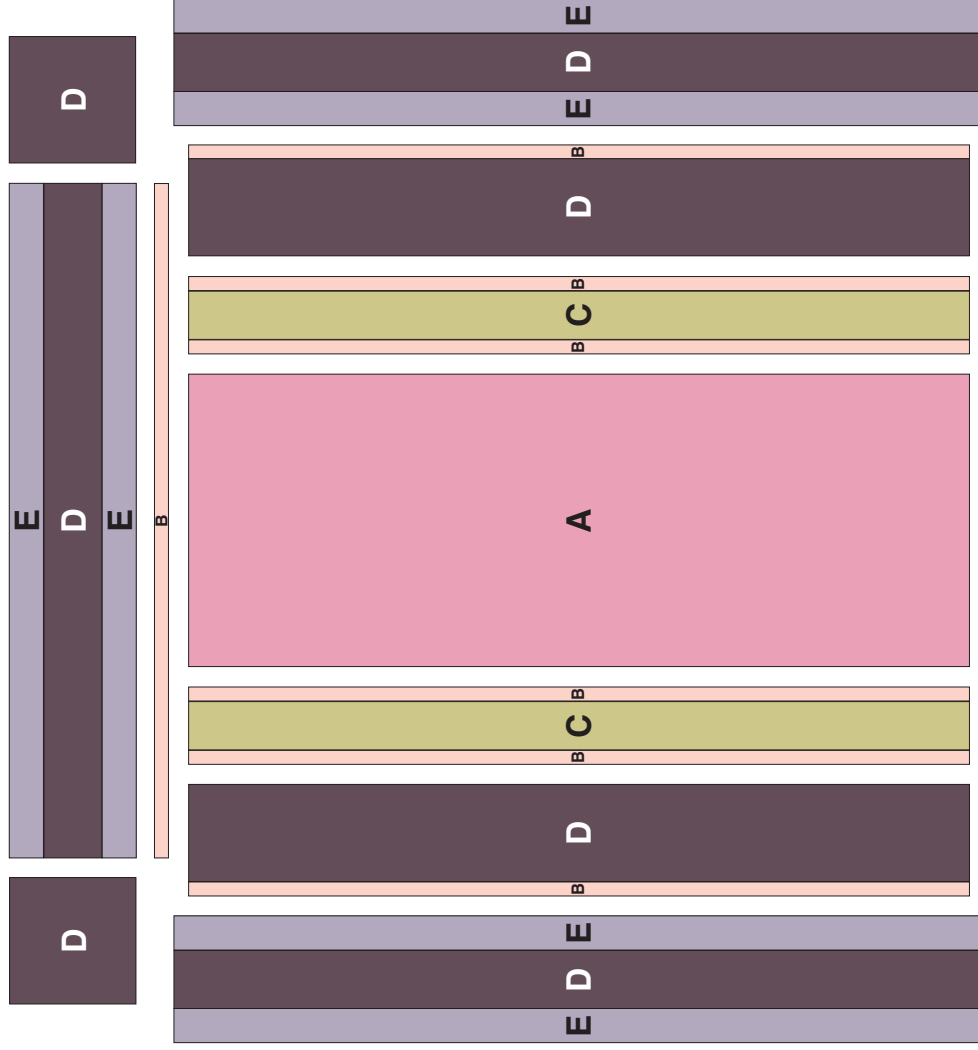

	A Daisy 2310-66 Lilac/Magenta	1 1/4 YDS	(1) 15 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fussy cut vines growing vertically.
	B Paisley 2312-61 Satin Pink	1/3 YD	(8) 1 1/4" x WOF*
	C Bar Code Stripe 2318-66 Purple/Magenta	1/4 YD	(2) 3 1/2" x WOF*
	D Large Vine 2311-66 Purple/Magenta	1 1/2 YDS	(2) 3" x WOF* <i>Top & bottom strips Must cut above first</i> (2) 3" x LOF† <i>Outside border strips</i> (2) 6" x LOF† <i>Quilt center</i> (4) 7" squares. <i>Corners, trim to fit.</i>
	E Peacock 2314-66 Purple/Magenta	2/3 YD	(8) 2 1/2" x WOF* <i>Border strips</i> When sewing these strips to top, all large curves should be in same direction to outside.

Finished size: 49" x 54" • 1/4" seam allowances have been added throughout.
IMPORTANT: Continually refer to photo and diagram for correct color placement and fabric orientation.

- 1) Trim quilt center **A** and vertical strips **C** to 40 1/2". Keep checking length as you assemble to avoid stretching. Pinning often, using fine pins, is very helpful.
- 2) Sew 1 1/4" Paisley strip **B** to each side of Bar Code strips **C**. Press.
Sew to Daisy panel **A**—check stripes to be sure they match each side.
- 3) Sew 1 1/4" Paisley strip **B** to 6" Large Vine strip **D**. Sew to Bar Code strip **C**. Repeat for other side. Press. Sew 1 1/4" Paisley strip **B** to top and bottom. Trim to fit.
- 4) Sew side border strip sets: 2 1/2" x 42" Peacock **E** to 3" x 42" Large Vine **D** and add 2 1/2" x 42" Peacock **E**. NOTE: Make sure the peacock design(s) match(es) up and vine is going in right direction. Repeat for top and bottom border strip sets using large vine strips cut across WOF*. Add 7" Large Vine squares **D** to ends. Trim to fit stripsets. Stitch to top and bottom.
- 5) Cut batting and backing 2" larger than top on all sides. Assemble the quilt "sandwich" by placing the backing, batting and top together in layers and baste or pin with safety pins. Machine quilt as desired. When machine quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with 2 1/2" strips.
- 6) Embellish with buttons and yo-yos if desired.



HOW TO MAKE A YO-YO!

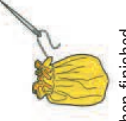
Use a 2" long embroidery needle and double strands of Pearle Cotton Thread.



On the finished side of the yo-yo circle...



sew big, loose stitches around the edges.



When finished, pull thread so it makes a little pouch. Hand press and smooth center until folds are even.
