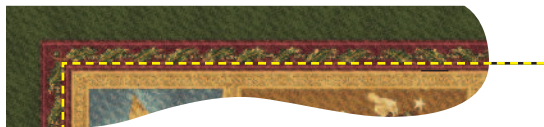


Starting with the *Star of Wonder* Panel, trim border to 1/4" away from gold line, eliminating all but 1/4" seam allowance of the green and red holly border.

Star of Wonder

WALLHANGING

35" x 53"

Choose 30 colors you want to use in the project from the 6" x 9" rectangles. Put aside two additional rectangles for the star appliqué and star center. You will then have 13 pieces leftover.

- 1) Sub-cut the 30 rectangles into six 3" squares for a total of 180 squares. Arrange as you like or follow photo for color layout. You will have 6 unused squares.
- 2) Stitch 15 rows of three 3" squares. Sew together (refer to photo and diagram) and stitch to left side of panel, matching top and bottom panels.
TIP: Place pieced border next to the feed dogs and use the gold border line for an easy stitching guide line.
- 3) Repeat Step 2 for right side.
- 4) Stitch 14 rows of three 3" squares. Sew together and stitch to top of project.
- 5) Repeat Step 4 for bottom.
- 6) Using the two 6" x 9" rectangles you put aside for the star and star center, create appliqué pieces in usual manner. Appliqué to top corner of quilt as shown in photo.
- 7) Layer and quilt as desired.
