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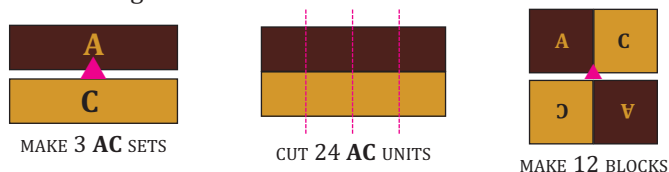

	<b>A</b> Floral Silhouettes 4407-78 <i>Cocoa</i>	1-2/3 YD (3) 5" x WOF strips. (6) 1-3/4" x WOF strips. (6) 5" x WOF for outer border.
	<b>B</b> Daisy Texture 4412-26 <i>Mauve</i>	1/2 YD 3-3/4 YD* (3) 1-3/4" x WOF strips. (5) 1-1/2" x WOF strips for inner border. *optional for backing
	<b>C</b> Medallion 4410-33 <i>Yellow</i>	1/2 YD (3) 5" x WOF strips.
	<b>D</b> Flock of Paisleys 4408-26 <i>Mauve</i>	5/8 YD (3) 7" x WOF strips.
	<b>E</b> Zig-Zag Stripe 4411-33 <i>Yellow</i>	1 YD (6) 1-3/4" x WOF strips. (6) 2-1/2" x WOF for binding.

WOF=WIDTH OF FABRIC

**BLOCK ASSEMBLY** This quilt consists of two main blocks.

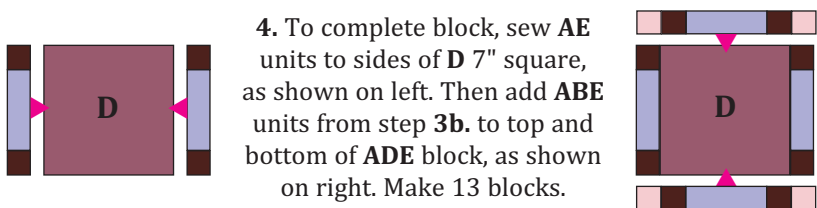
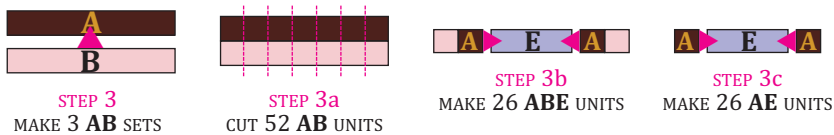
**BLOCK ONE: FOUR PATCH BLOCKS**

1. Sew 3 **A** and **C** 5" strips together lengthwise (making 3 sets), press to **A** fabric. Subcut (24) 5" x 9-1/2" units. Sew 2 units together to make 12 four patch blocks as shown in diagram on left.



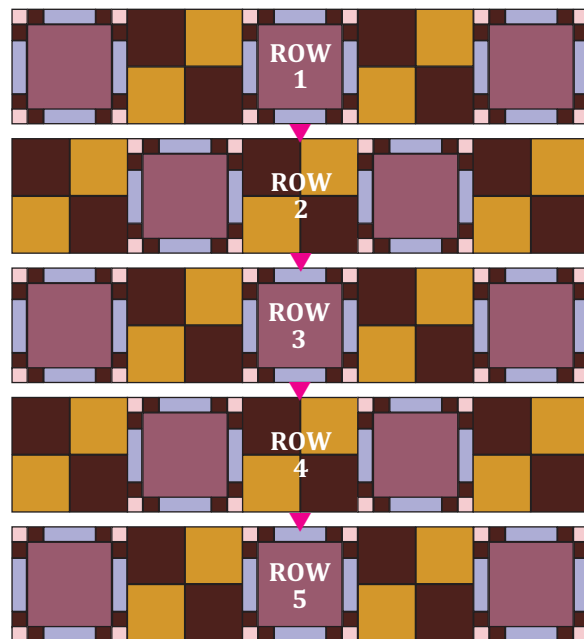
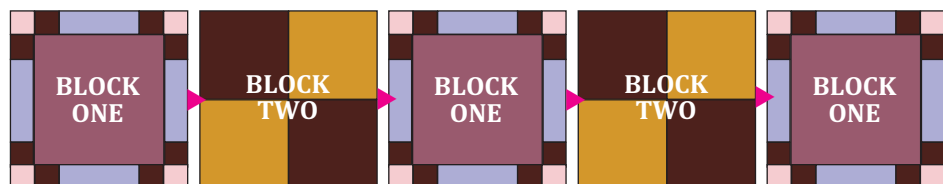
**BLOCK TWO: ALTERNATE BLOCKS**

1. From 3 **D** 7" x WOF strips, subcut (13) 7" squares for block centers. Set aside.  
 2. From 6 **E** 1-3/4" x WOF, subcut (52) 1-3/4" x 4-1/2" rectangles. Set aside  
 3. Sew 3 **A** and **B** 1-3/4" strips together lengthwise to make 3 strip sets.  
 a. Subcut **AB** strip sets into (52) 1-3/4" x 3" units.  
 b. Sew **AB** units to each end of 26 **E** rectangles, with **A** side to **E**. See diagrams below.  
 c. Subcut (52) 1-3/4" squares, from remaining (3) **A** 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Then sew **A** squares to the 26 **E** remaining rectangles.



**ROW ASSEMBLY** Follow quilt diagram or photo for block placement.

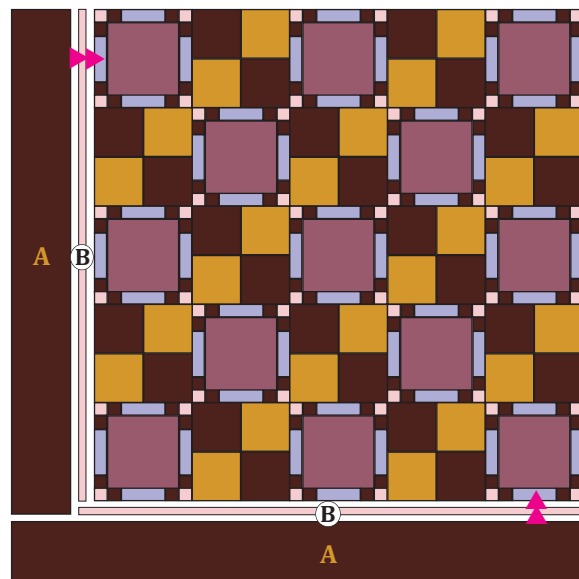
Sew Block One and Block Two together in horizontal rows of 5. See diagram below. Make 5 rows. Then sew Row 1 to Row 2 and so forth.



**BORDER ASSEMBLY**

**INNER BORDER:** Sew **B** strips end to end, then subcut (2) 45-1/2" lengths. Sew to sides of quilt top. Cut (2) 47-1/2" lengths and sew top and bottom of quilt top. See quilt diagram below.

**OUTER BORDER:** Sew **A** strips end to end, then subcut (2) 47-1/2" lengths, sew to sides of quilt top. Cut (2) 56-1/2" lengths and sew to top and bottom of quilt top. See quilt diagram below.



FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 56" SQUARE

**FINISHING**

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Assemble the quilt sandwich by placing the backing, batting and top together in layers and baste or pin with safety pins. Machine quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind in the usual manner.
