
# Shimmering Designed by Wendy Sheppard Constellation

### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

**1. CORNER BLOCKS:** Sew together (1)**A** 3 ½" x 3 ½" square and (1)**F** 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle. *Make 2*.

- **2.** Sew (1)**F** 3 ½" square to each side of (1)**A** 3 ½" square.
- **3.** Sew the units made in steps 1 and 2 to complete **1 CORNER BLOCK**. Repeat to make a total of 4 corner blocks. Square to 9 ½".









**CORNER BLOCK** Make 4


**4. BLOCK A (NINE PATCH):** Sew (1)C, (2)F, (3)B and (3)G 3 ½" squares together as shown to create (1) NINE PATCH BLOCK A. Square to 9 ½". *Make 2.* Repeat steps to make the following Nine Patch Block A. (PLEASE NOTE THE DIRECTIONAL STRIPED FABRIC IN THE BLOCKS.)



**5. BLOCK B:** Sew (1)**B** 3 ½" square to each side of (1)**F** 3 ½" square. Sew to the bottom of (1)F 6 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangle. Square to 9 1/2". Make 10.







### **STAR BLOCK:**

7. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1)C 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1)B 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another C 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " square at the other corner of the same B 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" rectangle to complete 1 CB UNIT. Square to 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5". *Make 4.* 









BC UNIT (Make 12)

- **8.** Sew (1)BC flying Geese unit to each side of (1)**C** 5" square.
- 9. Sew (1)B 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " square to each end of remaining flying geese units. Sew (1) unit to the top and bottom of block center to complete (1) BC STAR BLOCK. Square to  $9\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 1. Repeat steps to make the following Star Blocks:



- **10.** Sew (1)**J** 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangle to each side of (1)**A** 2 ½" square.
- **11.** Sew (1)**J** 4" x 9 ½" rectangle to the top and bottom of **AJ UNIT** to complete Square Block. Square to 9 ½". *Make 2.* Repeat steps to make the following Square Blocks:






## **QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY:**

**12.** Arrange and sew blocks into rows as shown in quilt diagram below. (*Pay close attention to the Nine Patch Block placement.*) Then sew Row 1 to Row 2 and so on.

# **13.** Sew rows together to complete quilt center.

### **BORDER ASSEMBLY**

MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.

**14.** Sew (1)F 4 ½" x (81 ½") border strip to each side of quilt center. Sew (1)F 4 ½" x (71 ½") border strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.

**FINISHING:** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

Finished Quilt Size: 71" W x 89"L
