

BLOCK DIAGRAM









BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to **BLOCK DIAGRAM**

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side all **C1, J1, K1** squares.
- 2. Place (1) **K1** square in top left corner of A1 square and sew on diagonal line. Press **K** open towards **A** corner. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4". Repeat using **K1** on bottom right corner, then **J1** on top right and bottom left corners to complete **BLOCK 1**. Square to 12-1/2", make (2).
- 3. Following chart, repeat step 2 to create remaining blocks.

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM and COVER IMAGE** for proper block placement and rotation.

- 4. Sew (1) **K2** to each side of (1) **H1**, then sew (1) **K3** to top and bottom. Sew (1) **L1** to each side, then sew (1) **L2** to top and bottom to create **QUILT CENTER**.
- 5. Sew the following blocks together in order listed, then sew to quilt.

Left side: (vertical) 5A - 4A - 6A Right side: (vertical) 6B - 4B - 5B
Top: (horizontal) 1 - 3A - 7A - 2 Bottom: (horizontal) 2- 7B - 3B - 1

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.

- 6. BORDER #1: Sew (1) \mathbf{J} 2" \mathbf{X} (60-1/2") to each side of quilt, then sew (1) \mathbf{J} 2" \mathbf{X} (51-1/2") strip to top and bottom.
- 7. BORDER #2: Sew (1) L 2" X (63-1/2") to each side of quilt, then sew (1) L 2" X (54-1/2") strip to top and bottom.
- 8. BORDER #3:Sew (1) **K** 4-1/2" X (66-1/2") to each side of quilt, then sew (1) **K** 4-1/2" X (62-1/2") strip to top and bottom.

FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. Quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

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
