

**BORDER ASSEMBLY**

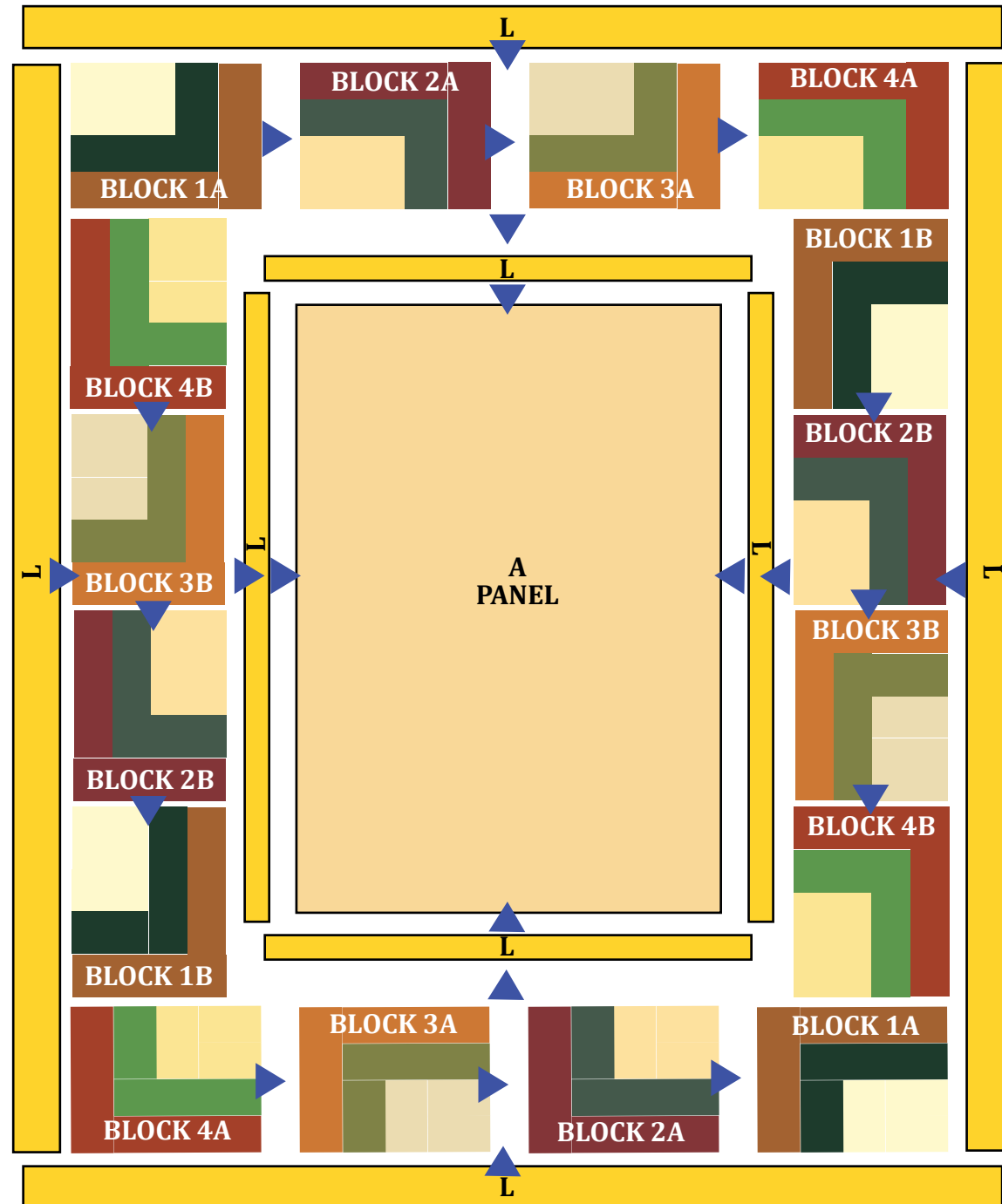
*MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

**10. L BORDER:** Sew (1) L 2-1/2" x (56-1/2") border strip to each side of quilt top. Then sew (1) 2-1/2" x (44-1/2") border strip to the top and to the bottom of quilt top.

**FINISHING** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

**FINISHED SIZE: 44" X 60"**

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

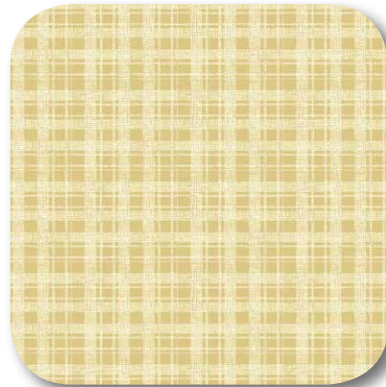

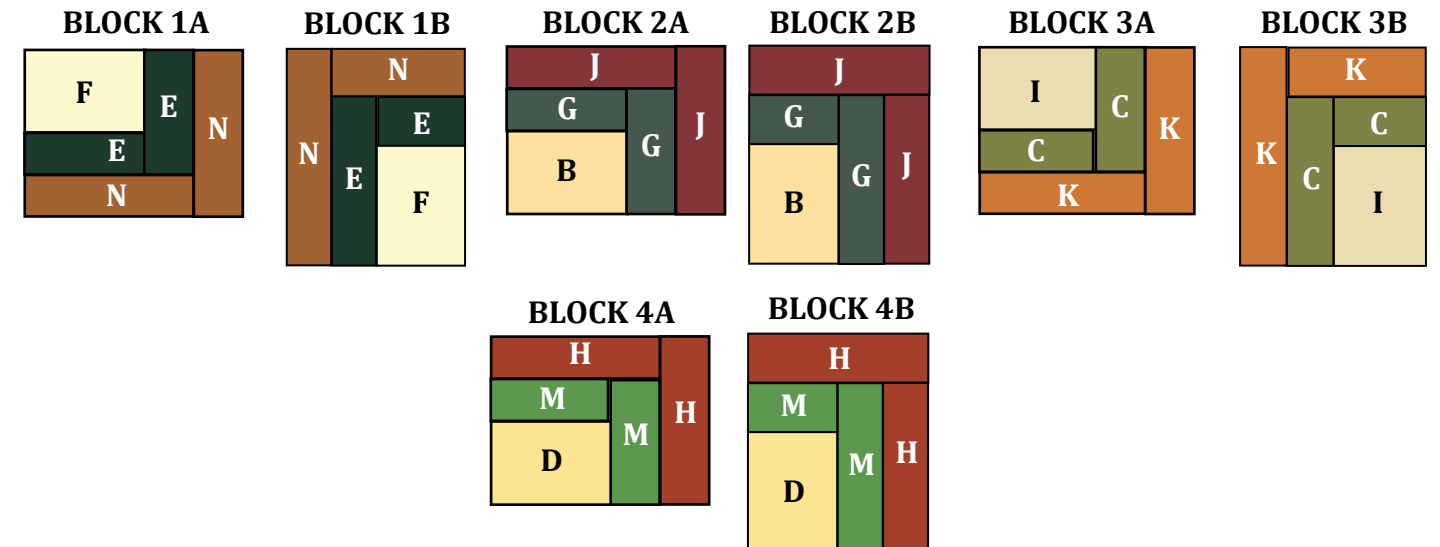

### BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

- BLOCK 1A:** Sew (1) E 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle to the bottom of (1) F 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle, then sew (1) E 3" x 6-1/2" rectangle to the right side of F rectangle to create **EF Unit**.
- Sew (1) N 2-1/2" x 8" rectangle to the bottom of **EF Unit**, then sew (1) 3" x 8-1/2" rectangle to the right side of **EF Unit** to create **BLOCK 1A**. Square to 8-1/2" x 10-1/2". *Make 2.* Repeat to create **BLOCKS 2A, 3A, and 4A**, as shown in diagrams below.
- BLOCK 1B:** Sew (1) E 3" x 4-1/2" rectangle to the top of (1) F 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle, then sew (1) E 2-1/2" x 8" rectangle to the left side of F rectangle to create **EF Unit**.
- Sew (1) N 3" x 6-1/2" rectangle to the top of **EF Unit**, then sew (1) N 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle to the left side of **EF Unit** to create **BLOCK 1B**. Square to 8-1/2" x 10-1/2". *Make 2.* Repeat to create **BLOCKS 2B, 3B, and 4B**, as shown in diagrams below.



- Sew (1) L 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" strip to each side of A 22-1/2" x 38-1/2" panel. Then sew (1) L 1-1/2" x 24-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of A Panel.
- LEFT BORDER STRIP:** Sew the following blocks into a vertical row. (Refer to Quilt Diagram on next page for proper rotation.) Then sew to left side of quilt.  
**BLOCK 4B > BLOCK 3B > BLOCK 2B > BLOCK 1B.**
- RIGHT BORDER STRIP:** Sew the following blocks into a vertical row. (Refer to Quilt Diagram on next page for proper rotation.) Then sew to right side of quilt.  
**BLOCK 1B > BLOCK 2B > BLOCK 3B > BLOCK 4B.**
- TOP BORDER STRIP:** Sew the following blocks into a horizontal row. (Refer to Quilt Diagram on next page for proper rotation.) Then sew to top of quilt.  
**BLOCK 1A > BLOCK 2A > BLOCK 3A > BLOCK 4A.**
- BOTTOM BORDER STRIP:** Sew the following blocks into a horizontal row. (Refer to Quilt Diagram on next page for proper rotation.) Then sew to bottom of quilt.  
**BLOCK 4A > BLOCK 3A > BLOCK 2A > BLOCK 1A.**
