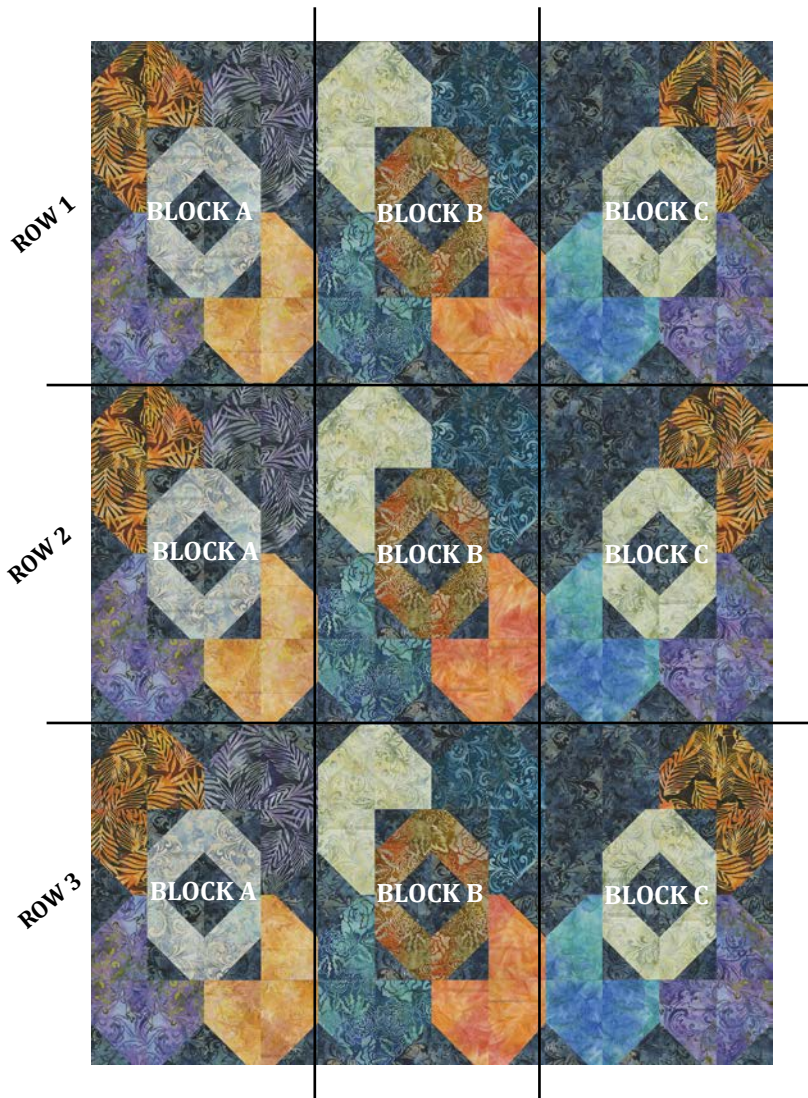


5. Assemble in rows following the Quilt Diagram below...

### QUILT DIAGRAM



**FINISHING :** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

*Finished Quilt Size: 48" W x 72"L*

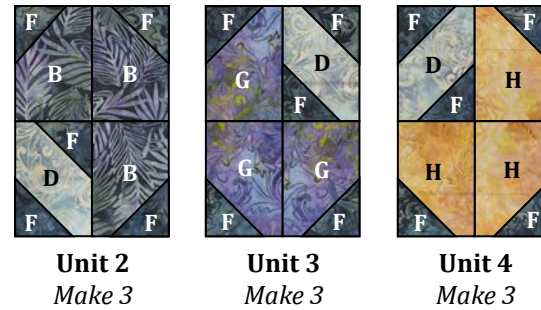

	<b>C</b> Vine Scroll 7051-04 <i>Pale Sage</i>	5/8 YD	(4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (21) 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
	<b>D</b> Vine Scroll 7051-05 <i>Blue/Pearl</i>	1/3 YD	(2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (12) 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
	<b>E</b> Vine Scroll 7051-52 <i>Peacock</i>	1/3 YD	(2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (9) 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
	<b>F</b> Vine Scroll 7051-55 <i>Navy</i>	1-2/3 YDS	(11) 2 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (161) 2 1/2" squares (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (9) 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips*, <i>Binding</i>
	<b>G</b> Vine Scroll 7051-64 <i>Violet/Lime</i>	1/2 YD	(3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (18) 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
	<b>H</b> Tropical Rose 7052-03 <i>Sunrise</i>	1/3 YD	(2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (9) 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
	<b>I</b> Tropical Rose 7052-33 <i>Orange/Moss</i>	1/3 YD	(2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (12) 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
	<b>J</b> Tropical Rose 7052-54 <i>Blue/Green</i>	1/3 YD	(2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (9) 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
	<b>K</b> Marble 7053-33 <i>Tangerine</i>	1/3 YD	(2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (9) 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
	<b>L</b> Marble 7053-33 <i>Lagoon</i>	1/3 YD	(2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (9) 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

WOF/LOF = WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC | \*SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS



2. Following the same technique, sew 3 more units' using the fabrics indicated on the diagrams on the next page.

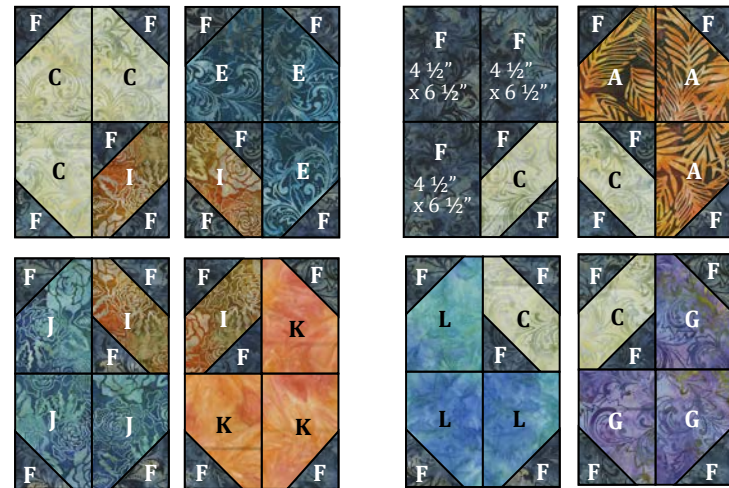


3. Sew Units 1,2,3 & 4 together as shown in diagram to make one "BLOCK A". Square to 16-1/2" x 24-1/2". Make 3.

### BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Place F 2-1/2" squares in corners of 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles right sides together as shown above, and sew along diagonal line. Fold back, press and trim. Sew blocks together. Square to 8-1/2" x 12-1/2".
