

QUILT DIAGRAM



FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

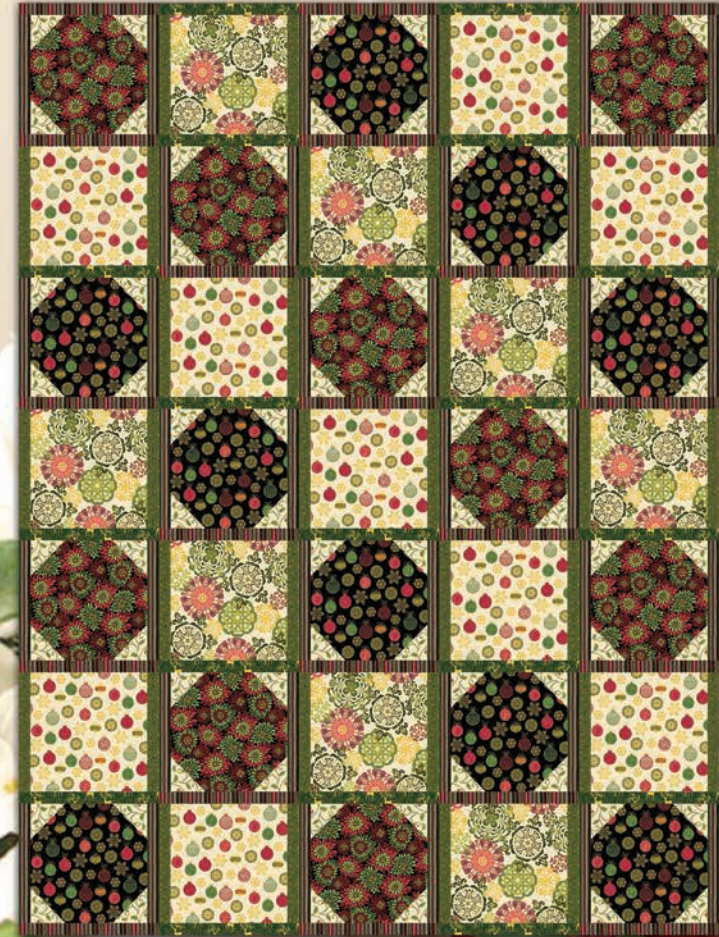

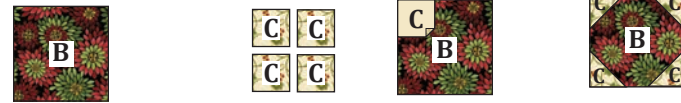

	A Snowflake Medley 10020M-07 <i>Cream/Ivory</i>	1 YD	Subcut into (8) 10-1/2" squares
	B Poinsettia Burst 10021M-10 <i>Red/Green</i>	1 YD	Subcut into (9) 10-1/2" squares
	C Holly Vine 10022M-07 <i>Cream</i>	1 YD	(8) 4" x WOF strips; subcut (72) 4" squares
	D Ornament 10023M-07 <i>Cream</i>	1 YD	Subcut into (9) 10-1/2" squares
	E Ornament 10023M-12 <i>Black</i>	1 YD	Subcut into (9) 10-1/2" squares
	F Reindeer Scroll 10024M-44 <i>Green</i>	1/3 YD	(7) 1-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (19) 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips
	G Ornament 10025M-44 <i>Med Green</i>	1 YD	(12) 1-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (34) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips (7) 2-1/4" x WOF strips*; binding
	H Festive Stripe 10027M-99 <i>Multi</i>	1 YD	(2) 10 1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (36) 10-1/2" x 1-1/2" strips (7) 1 1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (21) 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC

*SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS, THEN SUBCUT AS INDICATED

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **C** 4" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) **B** 10-1/2" square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **C** corner triangle. Repeat with another **C** 4" square on each corner of **B** square to complete **BC UNIT**. *Make 9.*

Repeat steps to make (9) **EC UNITS**.

QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

2. Refer to Quilt Diagram to sew Units and squares together in rows, with **F**, **G**, and **H** 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" sashing strips in between.
