

## BORDER ASSEMBLY

MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.

**22 Inner Border:** Sew (1) I 2-1/2" x (56-1/2") strip to each side of quilt top.

**23 Inner Border:** Sew (1) I 2-1/2" x (60-1/2") strip to top and bottom of quilt top.

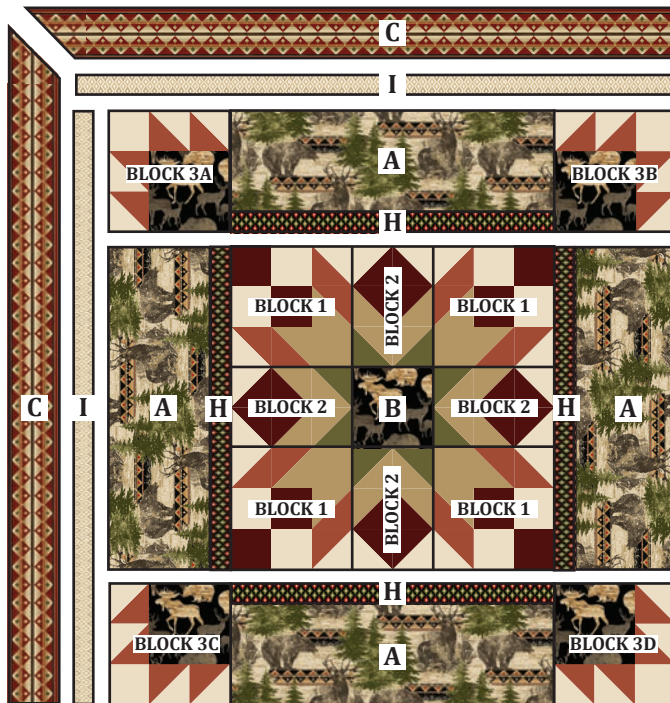
## MITERED BORDER ASSEMBLY

**24** Matching center of top border to center of quilt top, sew (1) C border strip to top of quilt, starting and stopping a generous 1/4" from each corner. Ends of border will extend past quilt edges. Repeat with quilt bottom.

**25** Repeat step 23 sewing to the left and right of quilt center.

**26** Refer to diagram to sew mitered corners on border. Fold the quilt at the corners, right sides together, aligning border seams and raw edges of quilt center sides. Draw a line from the quilt center corner out to the edge of the border strip. Extending the diagonal line of the folded quilt. Sew on that line. Trim excess fabric 1/4" from seam. Open and press border flat. Repeat with remaining border corners.

QUILT DIAGRAM



**FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 70" W X 70" L**

**FINISHING:** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

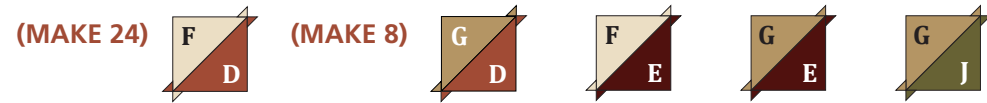
## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF = Width of fabric | HST = Half square triangle  
 \*Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated

	<b>A</b>	<b>WILDERNESS LODGE</b> 1470-99 <i>Multi</i>	1-1/4 yd	(4) 10-1/2" x WOF, subcut (4) 10-1/2" x 32-1/2" strips
	<b>B</b>	<b>RUSTIC WILDERNESS</b> 1471-12 <i>Black</i>	1/2 yd	(2) 8-1/2" x WOF, subcut (5) 8-1/2" squares
	<b>C</b>	<b>CAMP BLANKET</b> 1473-10 <i>Red</i>	2-1/4 yd	(4) 5-1/2" x LOF strips; Outer Border (Fussy Cut)
	<b>D</b>	<b>SNOWFALL</b> 1476-10 <i>Red</i>	1/3 yd	(2) 5" x WOF, subcut (16) 5" squares, cut once on diagonal to make (32) HST
	<b>E</b>	<b>SNOWFALL</b> 1476-19 <i>Burgundy</i>	1/3 yd	(1) 4-1/2" x WOF, subcut (8) 4-1/2" squares (1) 5" x WOF, subcut (8) 5" squares, cut once on diagonal to make (16) HST
	<b>F</b>	<b>BIRCH BARK</b> 1478-70 <i>Natural</i>	5/8 yd	(2) 4-1/2" x WOF, subcut (12) 4-1/2" squares (2) 5" x WOF, subcut (16) 5" squares, cut once on diagonal to make (32) HST
	<b>G</b>	<b>BIRCH BARK</b> 1478-72 <i>Tan</i>	1/2 yd	(1) 4-1/2" x WOF, subcut (4) 4-1/2" squares (2) 5" x WOF, subcut (12) 5" squares, cut once on diagonal to make (24) HST
	<b>H</b>	<b>LODGE BLANKET</b> 1479-12 <i>Black/Multi</i>	1/3 yd	(4) 2-1/2" x WOF, subcut; Quilt Center Border (4) 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" strips
	<b>I</b>	<b>LODGE BLANKET</b> 1479-70 <i>Natural</i>	1 yd	(6) 2-1/2" x WOF, subcut; Inner Border (2) 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" strips (2) 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" strips (8) 2-1/2" x WOF; Binding
	<b>J</b>	<b>LODGE BLANKET</b> 1479-72 <i>Tan/Multi</i>	1/4 yd	(1) 5" x WOF, subcut (4) 5" squares, cut once on diagonal to make (8) HST

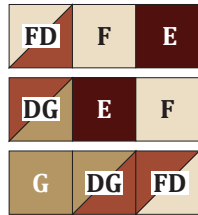
## HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE ASSEMBLY

1 Sew HSTs together according to diagrams.. Square each to 4-1/2".



### BLOCK 1 ASSEMBLY

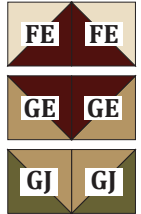
- Sew (1) **FD** HST and (1) **E** 4-1/2" square to each side of (1) **F** 4-1/2" square, to make Row 1. *Make 4.*
- Sew (1) **DG** HST and (1) **F** 4-1/2" square to each side of (1) **E** 4-1/2" square, to make Row 2. *Make 4.*
- Sew (1) **G** 4-1/2" square and (1) **FD** HST to each side of (1) **DG** HST, to make Row 3. *Make 4.*
- Sew Rows 1-3 together, according to Block 1 diagram. Square to 12-1/2". *Make 4.*



### BLOCK 1 (MAKE 4)

### BLOCK 2 ASSEMBLY (Note rotation of HST units.)

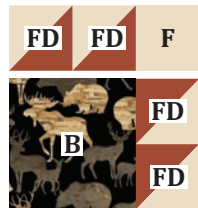
- Sew (1) **FE** HST to another **FE** HST, to make Row 1, according to Block 2 diagram. *Make 4.*
- Sew (1) **GE** HST to another **GE** HST, to make Row 2, according to Block 2 diagram. *Make 4.*
- Sew (1) **GJ** HST to another **GJ** HST, to make Row 3, according to Block 2 diagram. *Make 4.*
- Sew Rows 1-3 together, according to Block 2 diagram. Square to 8-1/2" x 12-1/2". *Make 4.*



### BLOCK 2 (MAKE 4)

### BLOCK 3A ASSEMBLY

- Sew (1) **FD** HST to the side of (1) **FD** HST, according to Block 3 diagram. Sew (1) **F** 4-1/2" square to the right side of the **FD** unit. *Make 4.*
- Sew (1) **FD** HST to the top of (1) **FD** HST. *Make 4.*
- Sew (1) **FD** unit to the right side of (1) **B** 8-1/2" square. *Make 4.*
- Sew the **FD-F** unit to the top of the unit from Step 12. Square to 12-1/2". *Make 1.*
- Repeat steps to make **Block 3D, 3C,** and **3D** referring to the Quilt Diagram for the rotation of the **B** 8-1/2" square. *Make 1 of each block.*



### BLOCK 3A (MAKE 1)

### QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

- Sew (1) Block 1 to each side of Block 2, according to Quilt Diagram. *Make 2.*
- Sew (1) Block 2 to each side of (1) **B** 8-1/2" square.
- Sew rows together. Square to 32-1/2".
- Sew (1) **H** 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" strip to (1) **A** 10-1/2" x 32-1/2" strip. *Make 4.*
- Sew (1) **HA** unit to each side of Quilt Center.
- Sew (1) Block 3 to each side of (1) **AH** unit. *Make 2.*
- Sew pieced border to top and bottom of Quilt Center.
