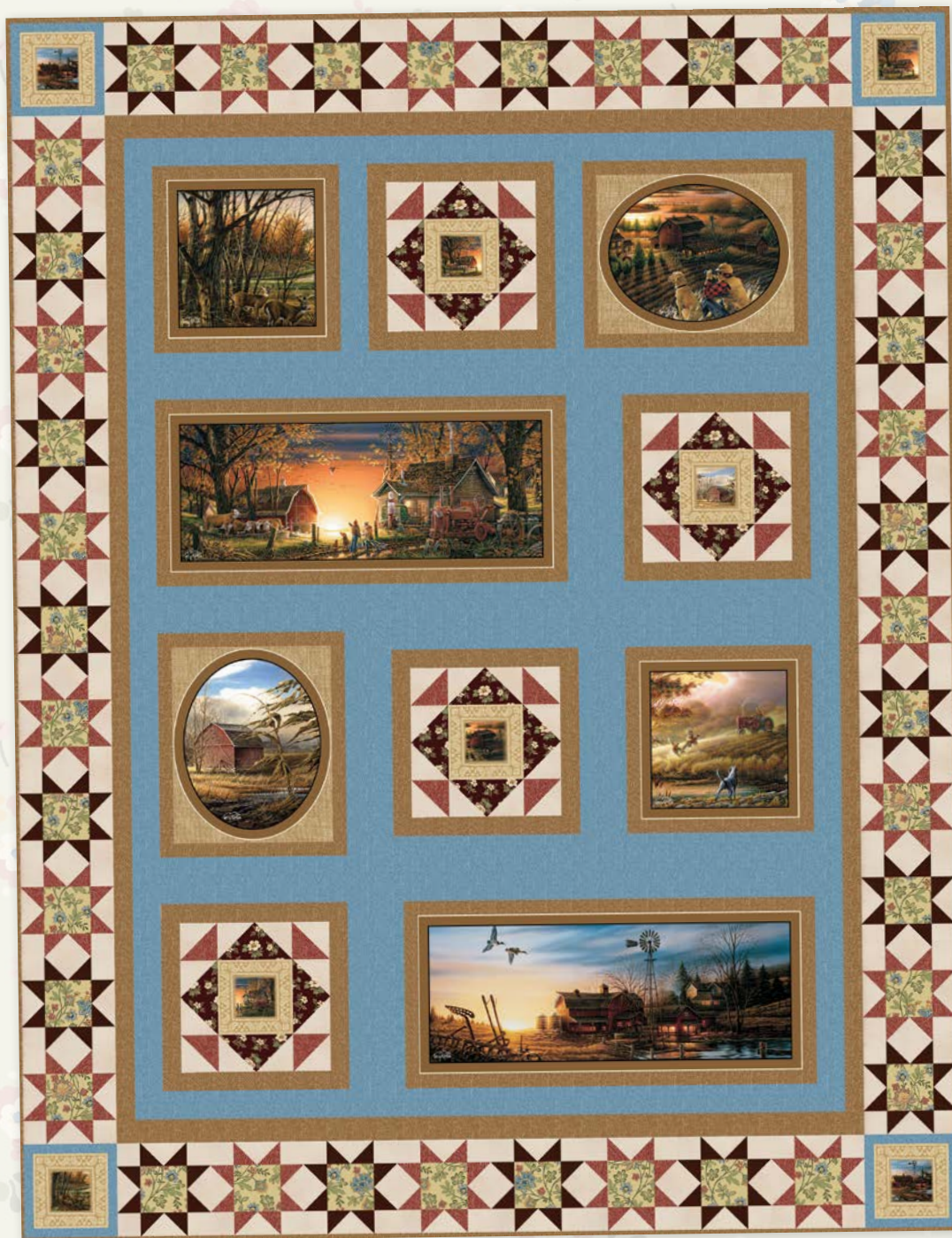

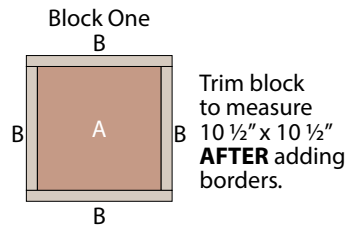

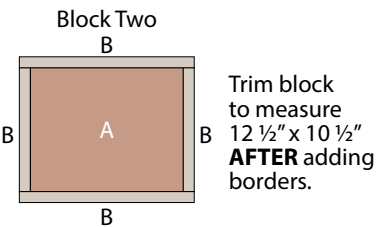
BLOCK ASSEMBLY *PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT*

BLOCKS

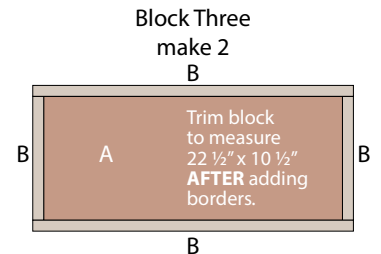
1. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 9" strip to each side of (1) **A** 9" square. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 12" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A** 9" square. Trim the block to measure 10-1/2" square to make (1) **Block One** square.



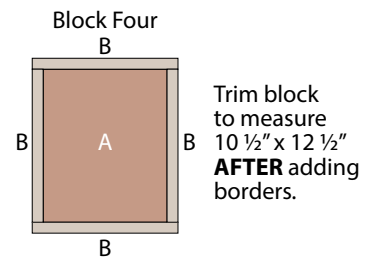
2. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 9" strip to each side of (1) **A** 11" x 9" panel. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 14" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A** rectangle. Trim the block to measure 12-1/2" x 10-1/2" to make (1) **Block Two** rectangle.



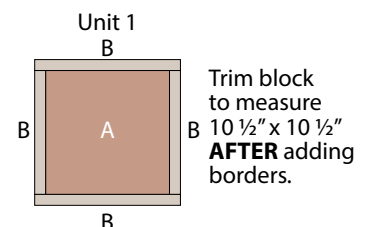
3. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 9" strip to each side of (1) **A** 21" x 9" panel. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 24" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A** rectangle. Trim the block to measure 22-1/2" x 10-1/2" to make (1) **Block Three** rectangle. Repeat to make a second **Block Three** rectangle.



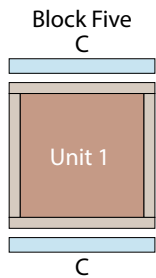
4. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 11" strip to each side of (1) **A** 9" x 11" panel. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 12" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A** panel. Trim the block to measure 10-1/2" x 12-1/2" to make (1) **Block Four** rectangle.



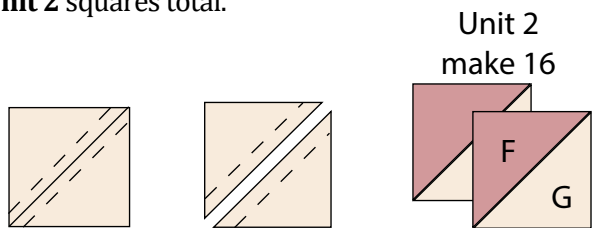
5. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 9" strip to each side of (1) **A** 9" square. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 12" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A** square. Trim the block to measure 10-1/2" square to make (1) **Unit 1** square.



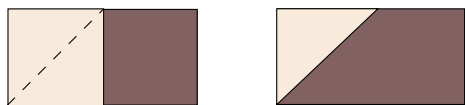
6. Sew (1) **C** 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Unit 1** square to make (1) **Block Five** rectangle.



7. Place (1) **G** 2-7/8" square on top of (1) **F** 2-7/8" square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2-1/2" square to make (2) **Unit 2** squares. Repeat to make (16) **Unit 2** squares total.

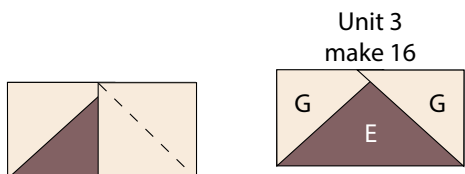


8. Place (1) **G** 2-1/2" square on the left side of (1) **E** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

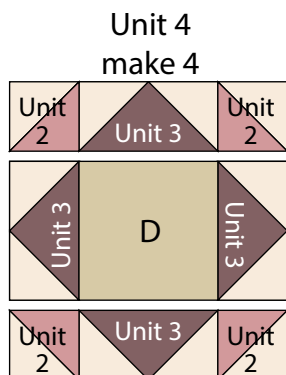


9. Place another **G** 2-1/2" square on the right side of the **E** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) **Unit 3** strip.

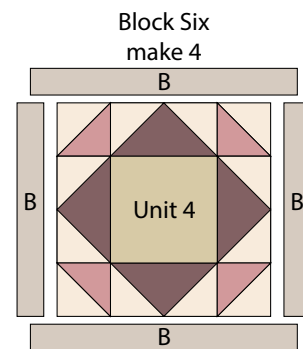
10. Repeat Steps 8-9 to make (16) **Unit 3** strips total.



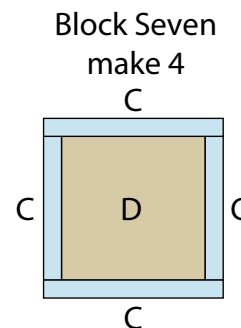
11. Sew (1) **Unit 2** square to each end of (1) **Unit 3** strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) **Unit 3** strip to each side of (1) **D** 4-1/2" square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) **Unit 4** square. Pay attention to the orientation of the units. Repeat to make (4) **Unit 4** squares total.



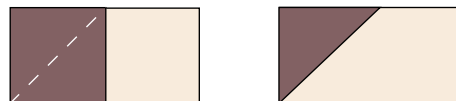
12. Sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **Unit 4** square. Sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Unit 4** square to make (1) **Block Six** square. Repeat to make (4) **Block Six** squares total.



13. Sew (1) **C** 1" x 4-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **D** 4-1/2" square. Sew (1) **C** 1" x 5-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **D** square to make (1) **Block Seven** square. Repeat to make (4) **Block Seven** squares total.



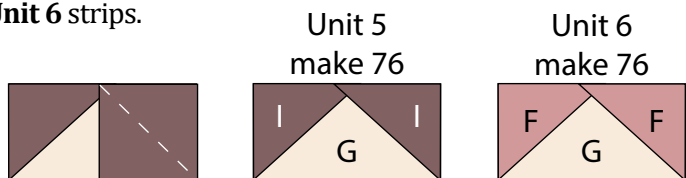
14. Place (1) **I** 1-3/4" square on the left side of (1) **G** 1-3/4" x 3" strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.



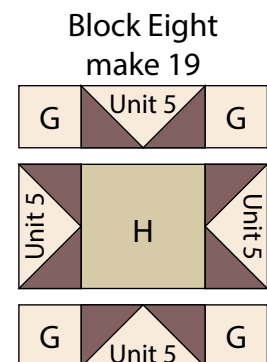
15. Place another **I** 1-3/4" square on the right side of the **G** 1-3/4" x 3" strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) **Unit 5** strip.

16. Repeat Steps 14-15 to make (76) **Unit 5** strips total.

17. Repeat Steps 14-15 and refer to the diagram for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (76) **Unit 6** strips.

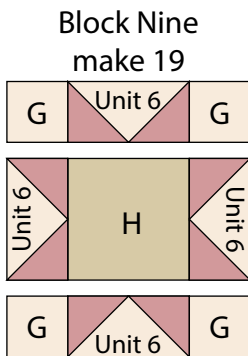


18. Sew (1) **G** 1-3/4" square to each end of (1) **Unit 5** strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) **Unit 5** strip to each side of (1) **H** 3" square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) **Block Eight** square. Pay attention to the unit orientation. Repeat to make (19) **Block Eight** squares total.

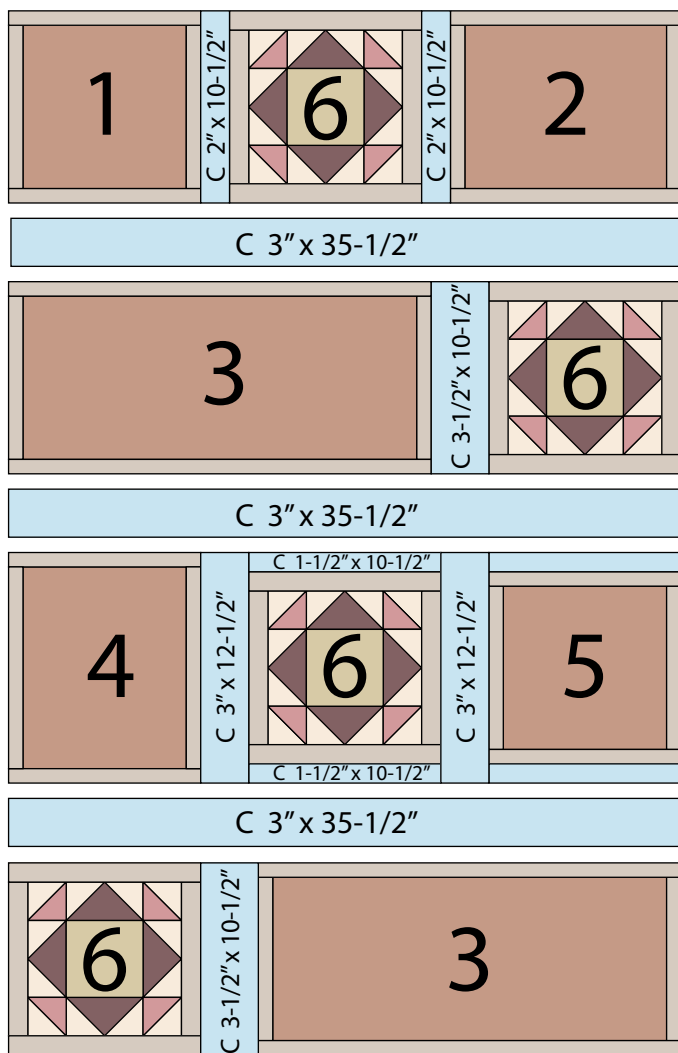


19. Repeat Step 18 and refer to the diagram for component identification, placement and orientation to make (19) **Block Nine** squares.

20. Refer to the diagram below for component identification, placement and orientation to make the **Center Block**.



Center Block



BORDER ASSEMBLY *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE C AND B BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

21. Sew (1) **C** 2" x (50") strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **C** 2" x (38-1/2") strips to the top and bottom of **Center Block**.

22. Sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x (53") strip to each sides of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **B** 1-3/4" x (40-1/2") strip to the top and bottom of **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

23. Sew together (6) **Block Nine** squares and (5) **Block Eight** squares, alternating them, to make the **Left Side Border**. Sew the strip to the left side of the **Center Block**.

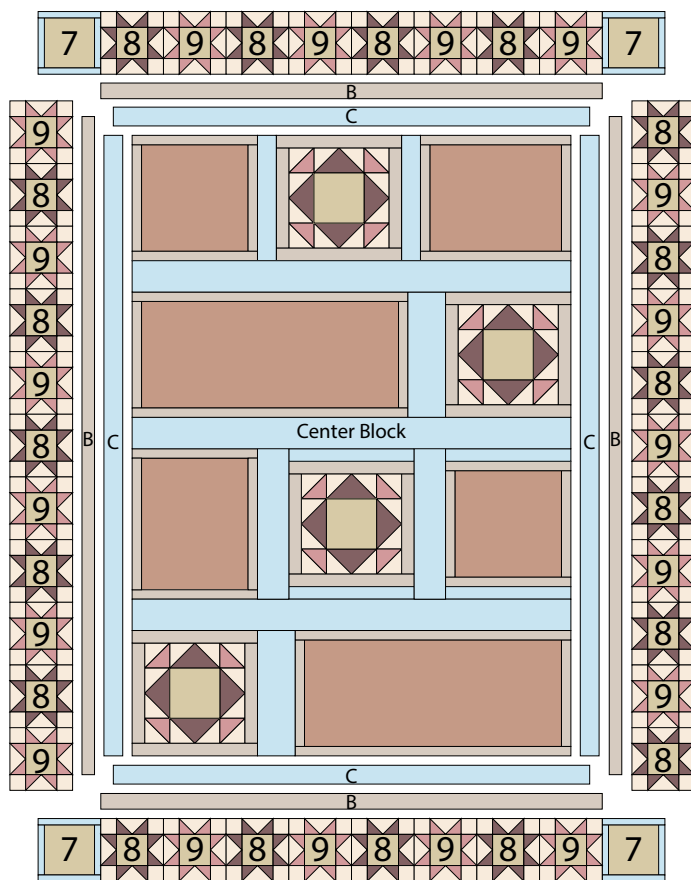
24. Sew together (6) **Block Eight** squares and (5) **Block Nine** squares, alternating them, to make the **Right Side Border**. Sew the strip to the right side of the **Center Block**.

25. Sew together (4) **Block Eight** squares and (4) **Block Nine** squares, alternating them. Sew (1) **Block Seven** square to each end of the new strip to make the **Top Border**. Repeat to make the **Bottom Border**. Sew the **Top Border** and **Bottom Border** to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
